4. Termination of the agreement

The inter-Institutional agreement is terminated at the end of the contractual period or by mutual understanding of the partners. In the event of unliateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
