AGREEMENT FOR SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION AND STUDENT MOBILITY

BETWEEN

ISTANBUL GELISIM UNIVERSITY, a legally constituted entity, with headquarters at Cihangir Mahallesi, Şehit Jandarma Komando Er Hakan Öner Sk. No:1 Avcılar / Istanbul, Turkey, represented herein by its Rector, Mr. Burhan AYKAC, who is legally authorized to act on its behalf,

hereinafter referred to as the "IGU"

AND

UNIVERSITÉ DU QUÉBEC À TROIS-RIVIÈRES, a legal entity constituted under the terms of chapter U-1 of Revised Statutes of Quebec, located at 3351 boulevard des Forges, C.P. 500, Trois-Rivières, Province of Quebec, Canada, G9A 5H7, herein represented by its Rector, Mr. Daniel MCMAHON, who is legally authorized to act on its behalf,

hereinafter referred to as "UQTR"

hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Partners"

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS it is of mutual interest to the partners to establish scientific cooperation links in the field of Engineering;

WHEREAS it is the wish of the partners to have a framework agreement for scientific cooperation and student mobility;

THE PARTNERS HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS

1. OBJECT OF THE AGREEMENT

The object of the present agreement is to define the cooperation activities of the partners in the field of Electrical Engineering as well as their respective responsibilities with respect to these activities.


- 4.1.2 Students wishing to undertake a research internship or practicum at the host university must obtain a letter of invitation from a professor at that university. Research practicums shall be subject to a practicum agreement between the home university, the host university and the student involved;
- 4.1.3 Exchange students shall pay their tuition fees at their home university. Based on the regulations in force in each partner institution, students may be required to pay, at the host institution, any non-tuition fees applicable at the host university. These fees may include general fees (admission, tuition and internships), technology fees, student service fees, student-life fees, copyright fees, sports and recreation fees and student association fees. The partners shall consult each other annually with respect to the imposition of these fees;
- 4.1.4 The host university shall provide exchange students with assistance in finding accommodation;
- 4.1.5 Cost of accommodation, transportation, and living expenses for exchange students shall be borne entirely by the students themselves;
- 4.1.6 All exchange students at UQTR, if they are nationals of a country that has signed a reciprocity agreement with Quebec with respect to social security must register for the Health Insurance Plan through the Régie d'assurance maladie du Québec (RAMQ), and provide UQTR with proof to this effect;
- 4.1.7 Exchange students who are not entitled to Quebec Health Insurance (RAMQ), must be insured under the UQTR Insurance Plan for foreign students, and pay the corresponding premium;
- 4.1.8 Exchange students shall complete immigration and administrative formalities before arrival in the host country (entry visa, student visa for those admitted and wishing to take courses, work permits for research interns, etc.);
- 4.1.9 Exchange students shall conform to the administrative regulations of the two partner institutions and the laws in force in the host country as well as the home country.

5 ENTRY INTO FORCE AND DURATION OF THE AGREEMENT

- 5.1 The present agreement shall enter into force as soon as it is signed by both partners.
- 5.2 The present agreement shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years.

6 MODIFICATION AND CANCELLATION

- 6.1 The partners agree that no modification to the present agreement shall be valid unless it is done in writing and countersigned by the authorized representatives of the partners.
- 6.2 Any partner may terminate the present agreement at any time, by providing written notice six (6) months prior to the expiration of the period.







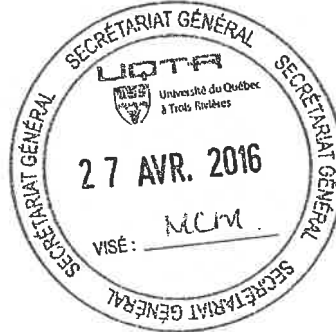
