Theme

The theme of the 2nd AE International Conference focuses on the concept of "Co-Architecture" which identifies new dialogues in architectural education and practice. After the breaking point created by the Covid-19 pandemic, the situation of distance has brought up different types of collaborative platforms. New approaches in architectural education and practice have resulted in diverse concepts while increasing the need for dialogue between interdisciplinary actors. Dialogues among architects, engineers, psychologists, educators, researchers, etc. not only enable the sharing of threats, opportunities and responsibilities in education and professional practice, but also identifies influential links in a holistic way of design thinking. The development of co-related themes reveals various issues in different scales: New methods and related collaborative approaches in education, collaborative design studies, co-housing and new paradigms in the urban scale, co-reflections on disasters, and co-links between architecture and industry. Within the co-related themes of this conference, contributors from various fields related with architecture and other disciplines (education, health, psychology, law, economy, engineering, etc.) in different parts of the world are welcomed to share their experiences. The process and outcomes of different approaches that are shared will create new visions. We invite proposals for paper presentations addressing one of the following themes under the main topic of dialogue.
