Istanbul Gelisim University Said “Do It Yourself”

Public Relations and Publicity Program Students Organized Four Activities as part of Do It Yourself (DIY)

Istanbul Gelisim University Vocational School Public Relations and Publicity Program students organized seminars, interviews, workshops and aid campaigns with the theme of Do It Yourself in the 2020-2021 Academic Year.

The students, who first set out with the slogan of #doityourselfwithscientificapproach, held a seminar on DIY philosophy with Merve Çaşkurlu on 22.04.2021. With this seminar, “How should we perceive the concept of DIY, what are its limits, what are the reasons for the popularity of this approach, and how does it relate to the concept of sustainability?” questions answered.

In the second project, which continues on the concept of DIY, the students who said #doityourselfathome held an interview on 04.05.2021. Vegan Life Nutrition Specialist Kevser Başkara and Fitness Trainer Tuğrul Çağrı Yılmaz participated in the interview, and a conversation took place within the framework of how to carry out sports and nutrition at home and how to ensure its sustainability. During the conversation, the students asked all their questions to the guests.

The students, who organized an aid campaign in the third step, rolled up their sleeves to support TEGV’s “Don’t Throw, Forgive” social responsibility project. For the first time, on 06.05.2021, TEGV Corporate Communications Specialist Ebubekir Türk was hosted at IGU and an awareness conversation was held on the benefits and methods of e-waste collection. Then,



e-waste was collected with the slogan #doityourselfwithtechnology. It is planned to donate to TEGV in order to contribute to the education of students.

The students, who set out with the theme of do it yourself, completed their last project with a workshop. They produced ornaments using materials from the home and nature, with the motto of #doityourselfwithcreativity. At the end of this workshop, which was held with Designer Kübra Sevindi on 27.05.2021, students gained skills on how to recycle waste.

The projects carried out under the consultancy of Lecturer Meltem İşler Sevindi, Lecturer Atilla Akalın and Lecturer Sevgi Kavut were prepared by the students of the Public Relations and Publicity Program. During the 2020-2021 Fall Semester, research was done by students on DIY culture, which is gaining importance day by day. In the light of the findings, a four-step project was prepared with the theme of DIY. The

students, who set out to emphasize recycling, less consumption, environment and sustainability, stated that they gained awareness and skills about these concepts after the project was completed. Assistant Professor Merve Çaşkurlu, Vegan Life Nutrition Specialist Kevser Başkara, Fitness Educator Tuğrul Çağrı Yılmaz, TEGV Corporate Communication Specialist Ebubekir Türk, Designer Kübra Sevindi, who supported the students in the project, said that they were pleased to be a part of such a project and they would always provide the necessary support to contribute to the education of university students.

BEING a STUDENT in IGVS

ARE THE ACCIDENTS EXPERIENCED BY THE INTERN AT WORK OCCUPATIONAL ACCIDENT?

Occupational accident is defined in the Social Insurance and General Health Insurance Law No. 5510 as “an event that immediately or subsequently injures the insured person physically or mentally. When we think of the concept of Occupational Accident, although the necessity of the accident to occur in the workplace comes to mind, the essential thing is that there must be an appropriate causal link between the accident and the result.

“Health insurance” is provided by the school/university for students who are subject to internship or who receive vocational training in enterprises. Even if the interns are not insured by the workplace where they do their internship, the accident they experience in this process is considered as an occupational accident.

There are also judicial decisions that the accident experienced by the intern while he/she is at the workplace is considered as an occupational accident.

In a decision given by the 21st Civil Chamber (2019/5063 E. , 2020/902 K.)

“ In the case subject to the case: the intern was found dead in the pool of the outbuilding allocated to him. The Supreme Court stated in its decision that the incident should be considered an occupational accident.”

WHO WILL MAKE THE NOTIFICATION OF OCCUPATIONAL ACCIDENT: IS IT THE WORKPLACE WHERE THE INTERNSHIP IS DONE? UNIVERSITY?

In accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety Law No. 6331, it is obligatory for the employer to report an occupational accident to the Social Security Institution (SSI) within three working days after the accident.

In the circular dated 10.07.2018 and numbered 2018/26; It has been stated that “In case of internship students have an occupational accident, the notification should be made by the workplace where the internship is performed, not by the school that pays the insurance premium”. However, it was emphasized that the

rest reports received by the student after the accident should be processed by the relevant higher education institution.

For this reason, we would like to remind you that if our students experience an occupational accident during their internship, they have to inform the Vocational School Directorate.

However, it should be noted that it is not correct to define the voluntary work of students who study in a department where there is no internship obligation to complete their higher education, as an internship.

In this case, since the relationship between the student and the employer is defined as a “work relationship”, it is necessary to accept that the students working in this way have the qualifications of “employee”, not “intern”.

DOES EVERY REPORT OF OCCUPATIONAL ACCIDENT CAUSE CRIMINAL LIABILITY?

Considering an incident as an occupational accident and making a legal notification as an occupational accident does not mean that the criminal responsibility is always on the employer. Whether the employer is responsible or not may vary depending on whether he/she takes the necessary measures in terms of occupational health and safety in the workplace. In other words, whether there is a causal link between the event and the conditions in the workplace (working order, mobbing, stress, heavy workload, risk assessments, etc.) will be decisive. Undoubtedly, the determination of the situation will also require an expert examination.

A seminar on “Speed Reading Techniques” was held on Thursday, 24.06.2021 by the Food Technologies Club with the supervision of Kübra SAĞLAM, who is the Head of Food Processing Department of Istanbul Gelişim Vocatioanal School. Serkan EKMEN took place as a speaker in the seminar which was moderated by Food Technology Program Instructor Lect. Eda ŞENSU. During the seminar, EKMEN explained practically 6 techniques related to brain and eye coordination in speed reading. With these techniques taught at the beginning of the activity, it was

determined that the speed of the participants increased by 50-60 words on average in the readings that were tried during the activity. It has been emphasized that if the techniques are continued for 63 days, time management can be made more effective with lifelong speed reading with the development of eye muscles and the increase in perception level.

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THINGS TO KNOW



ABOUT NEW CORONAVIRUS



All necessary measures are taken for the **coronavirus** revealed in Turkey and the World at **Istanbul Gelisim University**. **Things to know about coronavirus are as follows:**

What are the new coronavirus symptoms?

- The most common symptoms are **fever, cough and respiratory distress**.
- In severe cases, **pneumonia, severe respiratory failure, kidney failure and death** may occur.
- Incubation period is between **2 and 14 days**.

How is the virus transmitted?

- It can be transmitted by the contact of the droplets caused by **coughing and sneezing** with the contact of the **mouth, nose and eyes** of other individuals in certain environment and by touching the surfaces where the droplets adhere and taking hands **into the mouth, nose or eyes**.

What to do to be protected from the virus?

- When **coughing or sneezing**, the mouth and nose should be covered with a **disposable tissue**, if there is no handkerchief, the mouth should be closed with the **upper sleeve or elbow**, not with the palms.
- **Handshaking and hugging** should be avoided.
- **Mouth, nose and eyes** should not be touched with dirty hands.
- Hands must be washed for **at least 20 seconds** in accordance with the **Handwashing Instructions** found in the toilets. In the absence of water and soap, **alcohol-containing hand antiseptics** should be used. **Cologne of 70-80 degrees** also serve as disinfectants.
- Offices and classrooms must be **ventilated hourly**.
- Places frequently used by many people such as common areas and door handles should be **disinfected every 2 hours**.
- Hands **must be washed** after using **public transportation**.
- Because the virus progresses faster in people with low immune system; **a balanced and healthy diet** is required. Foods **must be washed thoroughly** before consumption.

What to do if there are symptoms?

- If you have come from countries with infections **in the past 14 days**, apply to the **nearest healthcare facility** by wearing a **surgical mask**.
- If you are **coughing, have a fever and have difficulty at breathing**, apply to the **nearest healthcare facility** by wearing a **surgical mask**.
- **Always wear your mask** when you are in the same room with **a person who is recommended insulation** at home.
