Armenia is waging a dirty war

Sociologist and International Relations Expert Behlul Aliyev (PhD) pointed out that the Azerbaijani side was fighting a virtuous war against the dirty provocations of Armenia and said: "Armenia's attacks are against the ethics of war as well as international law. Armenia shows how dirty it is waging a war with it."

"THE MYTH FICTIONALIZED FOR YEARS IS DISTORTED"

Emphasizing that Armenia's appetite has increased with the failure of the 30year search for a peaceful solution in Azerbaijan, which is under occupation of 20 percent of its territory, Dr. Bahlul Aliyev, Sociologist and International Relations Expert from Istanbul Gelişim University, said: "During this period,

myths of "invincibility", "hero nation chosen by God" were formed in the Armenian administration and the Armenian people. With the support of the international community, the constant breakdown of the ceasefire regime that had existed since 1994 and the impunity had further fueled these feelings. With the coming to power of Nikol Pashinyan in 2018, the emergence of domestic and foreign policy problems and the Pashinyan regime's desire to cover the discontent arising from the grassroots with the Karabakh issue were inadvertently strengthening these myths."

How did technology affect our lives during the coronavirus process?

Research was conducted on how technology affects family lives during the coronavirus process. In the research conducted with in-depth interviews with families, it was concluded that people are physically imprisoned in homes but go out through social media and this situation will negatively affect psychology in the future.

With the coronavirus epidemic, perhaps the technological transformation that will take place in 10 years has been experienced rapidly within 6 months. Two sisters Asst. Prof. Dr. Özge Gürsoy Atar and Asst. Prof. Dr. Şebnem Gürsoy Ulusoy carried out a study about how technology affects family life. The research was carried out through in-depth interviews with married families

and families with children. Giving information about the research, Asst. Prof. Dr. Atar said: "In in-depth interviews, we saw that families were negatively affected by the technological process and benefited from technology in areas such as education and shopping". Asst. Prof. Dr. Ulusoy added: "Due to the advancement of technology, people have closed their homes in a way that blends with technology. The convenience provided by this technological transformation has turned us into home-dependent, real-life independent people without realizing it."

WTHINGS TO KNOW

ABOUT NEW CORONAVIRUS

All necessary measures are taken for the **coronavirus** revealed in Turkey and the World at **istanbul Gelisim University. Things to know about coronavirus are as follows:**

What are the new coronavirus symptoms?

- The most common symptoms are fever, cough and respiratory distress.
- In severe cases, pneumonia, severe respiratory failure, kidney failure and death may occur
- Incubation period is between 2 and 14 days.

How is the virus transmitted?

It can be transmitted by the contact of the droplets caused by coughing and sneezing with the contact of the mouth, nose and eyes of other individuals in certain environment and by touching the surfaces where the droplets adhere and taking hands into the mouth, nose or eyes.

What to do to be protected from the virus?

When **coughing or sneezing**, the mouth and nose should be covered with a **disposable tissue**, if there is no handkerchief, the mouth should be closed with the **upper sleeve or elbow**, not with the palms.

- Handshaking and hugging should be avoided.
- Mouth, nose and eyes should not be touched with dirty hands.

Hands must be washed for **at least 20 seconds** in accordance with the **Handwashing Instructions** found in the toilets. In the absence of water and soap, **alcohol-containing hand antiseptics** should be used. **Cologne of 70-80 degrees** also serve as disinfectants.

Offices and classrooms must be ventilated hourly.

Places frequently used by many people such as common areas and door handles should be disinfected every 2 hours.

Hands must be washed after using public transportation.

Because the virus progresses faster in people with low immune system; a balanced and healthy diet is required. Foods must be washed thoroughly before consumption.

What to do if there are symptoms?

- If you have come from countries with infections in the past 14 days, apply to the nearest healthcare facility by wearing a surgical mask.
- If you are **coughing, have a fever and have difficulty at breathing**, apply to the **nearest healthcare facility** by wearing **a surgical mask**.
- Always wear your mask when you are in the same room with a person who is recommended insulation at home.
