



Graph 1: Number of Graduates













Graph 2: Number of ISCED 6 Undergraduate Graduates



Graph 3 shows the number of postgraduate graduates from ISCED 7 (postgraduate graduates).














Graph 4 shows the number of doctoral graduates from ISCED 8 (Doctoral Level).










Graph 5: Total Number of Graduates Who Have the Right to Obtain Primary Education Teaching Qualification

1. 6th International Middle East Symposium was held.

Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) will host 6th International Middle East Symposium this year. Many local and foreign scientists will come together within the scope of the symposium on "Searching for Stability in the Middle East".

Prof. Dr. Senol Durgun, IGU Head of Political Science and International Relations Department, who provided information about the symposium, also evaluated the processes in the Middle East and said: "The Middle East region is in the focal point of international politics due to ongoing conflicts as a result of the global power struggle. In addition to hegemonic struggle between regional and global powers, problems such as 'ethnic and sectarian conflicts', 'terrorism and refugee crisis' have become the main characteristic of the region. On the other hand, theoretical perspectives based on western perceptions such as 'nation-state' and 'modernization' cause scientists working on the region to overlook the unique dynamics and political breaking points of the region. In order to reveal approaches that have the potential to bring peace and stability to the region, there is a need for researches taking the unique characteristics of the region into account.

Durgun stating that 6th symposium, which was held this year is growing, indicated that it has become an organization closely followed by those working on the Middle East and continued his speech as follows: "In this context, VI. International Middle East Symposium to be realized in Istanbul Gelisim University in spring semester in 2019-2020 academic calendar, aims to focus on 'instability in the Middle East' within the framework of a solution-oriented approach with the contributions of distinguished researchers and academics from different countries. In this direction, it is aimed to reveal new perspectives that will help to establish permanent peace and sustainable development in the region by examining the causes of instability in the region in political, economic, historical and cultural dimensions.













2. Black Sea and Caspian Basin Countries Symposium was held.

Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) hosted 1st International Symposium of Black Sea and Caspian Basin Countries (KARHAZ). Prof. Dr. Şenol Durgun, regarding the symposium to be held, said, "We aim to present solutions for welfare of the Black Sea and Caspian basin countries and the establishment of regional stability at the symposium."

Many local and foreign scientists came together within the scope of the symposium held between 21 - 22 April 2020 on 'Establishing Stability in the Black Sea and Caspian Basin'. The symposium was organized in partnership with Istanbul Gelisim University, Caucasus Strategic Research Center (KAFKASSAM) and IGU Political Research Center (IGUSAM).

Prof. Dr. Senol Durgun stating that the Black Sea and Caspian Basin, which has witnessed many turbulent periods throughout history, can be stabilized by getting rid of the problems originating from the recent past, said, "Ensuring political and social stability in this geography is important not only for the countries in the region, but also for the whole international system. In this regard, it is important to identify both intra-regional and extraregional factors that cause instability in the region and to propose comprehensive solutions."

Prof. Dr. Senol Durgun, Head of the Department of Political Science and International Relations at IGU, said, about the symposium: The development of political, economic, cultural, commercial and touristic relations, which is likely to contribute to the maintenance of stability in the region, requires a comprehensive and detailed analysis of regional issues at the academic level.











We will present productive ideas that will contribute to the establishment of peace, tranquility and stability in the region by utilizing different perspectives of various disciplines within the social sciences in the 1st International Symposium of Black Sea and Caspian Basin Countries, decided to be held within this context. We aim to present solutions for the establishment of prosperity and stability in the region by eliminating the instability and violence that have become widespread in the Black Sea and Caspian basin countries today."



3. A 'Holiday Academy' was organized for the University Elections of High School Students.

A 'holiday academy' was organized for high school students to their university selection process. As the times comes closer for Higher Education Institutions Exam (YKS), students are doing researches for university and department selection. Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) welcomes high school students who are in the process of setting goals, on its campus, with various applied courses between January 20-24. 11th and 12th grade high school students participated in the program named IGU 2020 High Schools Semester Holiday Academy.

Abdulkadir Gayretli, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of IGU, who stated that the students cannot distinguishment between the departments they wanted and the departments they targeted, said, "It is necessary to turn requests into goals. In order to do this, it is important to take action. Young people should set goals that they can reach with the talents they have. As IGU, we pay attention on helping students to determine their goals and to be by their side and support them while planning their careers."

Gayretli who addressed that parents should not ignore their children's goals, said, "Families should not direct their children to goals they cannot reach, and they should not try to impose dreams they cannot reach on their children. Children should determine their own future. Children should be given the right to choose, and they should be allowed to rule their lives."

Abdulkadir Gayretli, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of IGU, said, "We have prepared a program that will help students to determine their career maps. 11th and 12th grade high school students can attend the applied courses of the department they are considering studying at university, have ideas and have fun."

Liselilerin üniversite seçimleri için 'tatil akademisi' düzenleniyor

Yükseköğretim Kurumları Sınavı (YKS) yaklaşırıkan öğrenciler de üniversite ve bölüm seçimli için araştırmalar yapıyor, İstanbul Gelişim Üniversitesi (İGÜ) 20-24 Ocak tarihleri arasında çeşitli uygulamalı derslerle, hedef belilireme sürecinde olan ilse öğrencilerini kampüsünde ağırlıyor, İGÜ 2020 Liseler Sümestr Tatil Akademisi adı verilen programa 11'inci ve 12'nci sinif ilse öğrencileri katılabiliyor.



Öğrencilerin istedikleri bölümler ile hedefledikleri bölümlerin ayrımını çok iyi yapamadığını ifade eden İGÜ Mütevelli Heyeti Başkanı Abdulkadır Gayretli, "İstekleri hedeflere dönüştürmek gerekiyor. Bunun için de eyleme geçmek önemli. Gençler sahip oldukları yeteneklerle ulaşabilecekleri hedefler belirlemeli. İGÜ olarak öğrencilerin hedeflerini belirlemelerinde yardımcı olmaya ve onların kariyerlerini planlarken yanlarında olmaya, destek olmaya önem veriyoruz" dedi.

Ebeveynlerin, çocuklarının hedeflerini yok saymaması gerektiğine vurgu yapan Gayretli, "Aileler ulaşamadıkları hedeflere çocuklarını yönlendirmemeli, ulaşamadıkları hayalleri çocuklarına dayatmaya çalışmamalı. Çocuklar kendi geleceklerini kendileri belirlemeli. Çocuklara seçme haklarını tanınmalı, hayatlarını yönetmelerine izin verilmeli" diye konuştu.

İGÜ Mütevelli Heyeti Başkanı Abdulkadir Gayretli, "Öğrencilerin kariyer haritalarını belirlemede yardımcı olacak bir program hazırladık. 11'inci ve 12'nci sınıf lise öğrencileri, üniversitede okumayı düşündüklerini bölümün uygulamalı derslerine katılabiliyor, fikir sahibi oluyor ve eğleniyor" diye konuştu.

Many local and foreign scientists gathered within the scope of the "sustainability" themed congress held between 12-13 March 2020. It has been reported that the congress is planned to be held in a different geography every year where communication and cooperation exist traditionally. Dr. Instructor Member Hilal Kılıç speaking about the importance of the congress, said, "We aim to create an interdisciplinary discussion and study platform by gathering scientists who conduct research in this field, with the belief that social sciences should be emphasized along with technical sciences for the development and improvement of our country."

Academic Member Dr. Hilal Kılıç, Istanbul Gelisim University School of Applied Sciences (UBYO) Director stated that "We aim to share original academic studies and applications in the field of Social Sciences with scientists, to enable emergence of creative idea, and to create working environments within the framework of cooperation with International Applied Social Sciences Congress (IGU-CON USBK)."

Kılıç continued her speech as follows:

"It is thought that it is important to deal with all economic, social and environmental factors closely related to human life from a scientific point of view within the framework of the 'sustainability' phenomenon. It takes place among our goals to discuss the concept of 'Sustainability', one of the important paradigms of the 21st century, under wide range of applied social sciences, and to create awareness by forming consortium at national and international level."

I believed that this endless material should be embraced and appropriately interpreted and transferred by young people. I have full confidence in my young friends with whom I set out, who believe in this project and want to be a part of it. If our project is approved and receives the necessary support, I believe that this first study of ours will pave the way for such studies."











"A WAY TO SHOW THE CITY THE VALUE IT DESERVES"

Aykut who indicated that they plan to get the opinions of students studying at different faculties of Istanbul Gelisim University, through interviews on Istanbul, said that "I think that the project has also of great importance in terms of the correct promotion of Istanbul Gelisim University. "Istanbul for Us" is a project to explain the meaning, and keep alive this city, which has different meanings for each of us, as the city where we were born/live/study in, through the eyes of university students. In a sense, perhaps it is a way to show the city the value and respect it deserves through the help of young people."

Aykut who mentioned that Istanbul for Us Team adopted the principle keep moving to its goal in all projects realized and aimed to be realized, without compromising its goals and without deviating from its principles, listed the principles and basis as follows: "Equality, openness, entrepreneurship, paying value to knowledge, developing together, open source, learning while performing works, creating synergy and common power, acting with a collective mind understanding, constantly improving and developing, protecting universal and human values."

"WE HAVE DETERMINED TEN REGIONS"

Dr. Faculty Member Pelin Aykut stating that the aim of her team is to constantly contribute to itself and the environment that it can reach, also gave information about the work plan of the project. Aykut ended her speech as follows:

"As a result of our research, believing the power of the image and the rise of visual culture, we determined ten regions whose architecture, culture, art, entertainment life, food culture and bazaar are the ones we want to talk more about. Starting from January 2020 until the end of May, we planned to present the places we have chosen by producing content during our fall and spring semesters in Taksim, Beşiktaş, Sarıyer, Üsküdar, Balat, Karaköy, Sultanahmet, Eminönü, Kadıköy and Adalar, as a vlog on Youtube, every fifteen days. Each vlog will consist of several episodes of three to four minutes and will not exceed twenty minutes in total.

Sevilay Kaygalak Urban Studies Article Award, organized for the first time this year by Praksis magazine, found its owner with a ceremony held on the online platform yesterday. The award was given to Academic Member Leyla Bektaş Ata was with his article "Intergenerational Approach to Education in Shanty House: Boundaries, Expectations, Preferences".









Winner of the Sevilay Kaygalak Urban Studies Article Award, organized by Turkey's leading academic journal Praksis, became Istanbul Gelisim University, Dr. Academic Member Leyla Bektaş Ata with her article titled "Intergenerational Approach to Education in Shanty House: Boundaries, Expectations, Preferences" which deals with intergenerational education and vocational preferences in a shanty house in İzmir. The ceremony was held on the online platform yesterday for precautionary purposes due to the coronavirus pandemic. Dr. Academic Member Ata who shared her feelings before the ceremony, said, "It is a pleasure for me to be worthy of this award. Such awards in the social sciences are very limited. It is very valuable to me that the qualitative research I do is rewarded."

Shanty house was examined over two generations.

Ata, who provided information about the research, said, "In the shantytown that I worked on, I considered the people who migrated from Eastern Anatolia, Central Anatolia and Southeastern Anatolia, Central Aegean as the first generation. This group consists of people who have limited involvement with education, many of whom are primary school graduates. I named the children of this group, mostly between the ages of 20 and 40, as the second generation and carried out my work over two generations. In the study, I discussed the relationship of the second generation with education, their access to education opportunities as the urban poor from the slums, and the opportunities for class action through education.

"The choice of profession is not based on their interests and skills"

Ata who addressed the data she obtained in the research, said that "Second generation individuals think that they participate in education opportunities unequally due to living in a shanty house area. They are not satisfied with the quality of the institutions providing education in the shanty house areas. Even if they deserve to go to more prestigious schools, they are afraid to be students in these schools. These schools do not have the socioeconomic opportunities required by socialization. This situation causes young people to question their school preferences while participating in education life. In addition, families want their children to have an office job in a short way. For this reason, they often direct their children to vocational high schools. In vocational high schools, the choice of department is for the professions that are at the forefront of the period. As a matter of fact, the accounting department is dominant for those born in the 80s and 90s. Then computer and informatics departments came to the fore. In addition, in career choices, a path is followed to capture the spirit of the period, not according to the interests and skills of the individuals in the second generation. Because these groups struggle with poverty and care about their children's being able to have a job without the need for a university education. Their budgets for education are also limited. However, in general, we witness that the individuals in this group live a not very successful high school life and are not employed in the fields where they are educated. Since their education does not coincide with business life, serious conflicts arise."











13. Educational Book for Turkish Cuisine Lovers: 120 Flavors Have Been Gathered.

Approximately 120 kinds of dishes reflecting the tastes of Turkish cuisine, along with their history, recipes and nutritional values, were included in the Turkish Culinary Culture book. The book is also expected to be a good resource for high school and university students who are just starting their education.

Many classic dishes of Turkish cuisine, such as lentil soup, stuffing, meatballs, meat stew, and pilaf, will be selected by Istanbul Gelisim University lecturers and published in a book. The book, whose works have begun, will include 120 kinds of food, along with their recipes, dates and nutritional values. Dr. Lecturer Serdar Garb expressing that they are continuing their work to become a guidebook, the general secretary of the university, said that "We will try to explain how food has continued from past to present in the context of Turkish culture. We see that modern cuisine has been shaped since the Ottoman period. Prehistoric times are among the factors affecting Turkish cuisine. With the book, we plan to contribute to the industrialization of Turkish cuisine." To enrich the content of the book, 120 dishes cooked in the kitchen are photographed in the studio by the students of the university.

OUR MISSION IS TO PROMOTE TURKISH CUISINE TO THE WORLD

Academic Member Dr. Çöp said that "The book will be a guidebook. We have plans to translate it into English after publishing it in Turkish in our country. We have a mission to introduce Turkish cuisine to the world. We are planning our book to be released in about 3 months. We have students and many contributing companies for the book. In the book named "Turkish Cuisine Culture", we plan to bring together all the elements that make up the cuisine and make it available to people."











THE BOOK CONTAINS TASTE EVERYONE NEEDS TO KNOW

University Culinary Program Instructor Erkan Kıyıcıoğlu stated that it was difficult to choose the flavours to be included in the book, which includes nearly 120 recipes, and said that "It was actually a bit difficult for us to be limited to 120 recipes while examining Turkish cuisine. If we look at the regional diversity, Turkish cuisine is a very wide one. We wanted to highlight the flavours that students should know in Turkish cuisine, especially the flavours that they should know about techniques. You will find almost all the flavours you need to taste when you go to a classic Turkish restaurant in this book. There will be information such as lentil soup, ezogelin soup, stuffing, meatballs, meat stew and how to prepare a good pilaf."

THERE WILL ALSO BE GEOGRAPHICAL MARKED TASTES

Kıyıcıoğlu who addressed that Turkish cuisine is best known in the world for its kebabs, said that "We also included kebabs in our book. Especially while choosing recipes, we examined geographical products in great detail. We examined the recipes of the geographically indicated dishes in the patent applications and tried to revise our own recipes accordingly. We think it will be a good resource, especially in terms of education. It will be a good resource for high school and university students who are just starting their education."

BOOK SERIES WILL CONTINUE

Kıyıcıoğlu who indicated that the videos of the book will be published simultaneously after it is published, and those who wish can watch these videos, said that "We have only included meals in this book. Especially pastries and desserts are a much broader subject. A second book will be devoted to the subject of pastries and desserts. We are thinking of doing another book about local tastes. In this book, we would like to include lesser-known local dishes. We are in the age of introducing Turkish cuisine to the world. We can also do a modern Turkish cuisine study about the place of fusion cuisine (the cuisine that combines elements of different culinary traditions) in Turkish cuisine practices."













14. Student-Personnel Mobility Started with Azerbaijan and Ukraine Universities.

Istanbul Gelisim University, which carries out many EU projects, announced that this year it applied for Erasmus KA-107 program, which is student-staff mobility between program countries and partner countries, for the first time and received funding from the EU. In this context, Istanbul Gelisim University will be able to carry out student-staff mobility with the leading universities of Azerbaijan and Ukraine from outside Europe.

Erasmus Coordinator Alisa Usubova who expressed that they would be very pleased to share the knowledge of Istanbul Gelisim University with Azerbaijan and Ukraine, said, "The relations between Azerbaijan and Turkey have developed in all fields and continue to develop more and more every day. Especially in the field of education, very important progress has been observed in bilateral relations. It is aimed to bring Azerbaijan, which was determined as the target and focus country in the YÖK internationalization strategy document, to a better point in the Turkish higher education system by the end of 2022. In addition, Azerbaijan is the second country that sends the most international students to Turkey, as well as the second country with the most mobility within the scope of the Mevlana exchange program.

"AS PREJUDICES ARE REMOVED, TOLERANCE INCREASES"
Usubova, listing the universities where student-staff exchange will take place, said:

"Student-staff exchange will be possible with Azerbaijan State University of Economics, Azerbaijan Diplomacy University and Poltava University of Economics and Commerce, one of the deep-rooted universities of Ukraine. Students will have the opportunity to get to know other cultures and their awareness will increase. Followings can be stated as benefits of the projects; to remove prejudices and increase tolerance on issues such as racism, ethnic and religious discrimination, to expand the communication and information networks of the students, to improve their language skills as well as their personal skills, to improve their communication skills with individuals and institutions by studying in a different education-training system, to increase their self-confidence and employability.

"THEY CAN IMPROVE THEIR WORKING SKILLS"

Usubova making statements about the contribution of the change to the academic and administrative staff, said that "The staff can improve their professional skills in the field they work. In a new academic environment, they can increase their connections, increase the number of scientific studies and R&D activities by improving their researcher aspects, increase the chance of publishing scientific research articles in international peer-reviewed journals with high impact factor, and improve their ability to work with joint projects that bring together staff from different cultures and education systems."











"INCREASING RECOGNITION"

Usubova concluded her speech with:

"During the student-staff mobility period, they will gain experience and knowledge from the host country and institution, and then they will carry these skills and knowledge to the country's economy and business life. The project will contribute to the development of internationalization by adopting and disseminating the concept of mobility, increasing the number of incoming and outgoing students and staff, the capacity of bilateral cooperation, the common values between the two institutions, recognition and prestige."



15. Photo Recognition and Production Competencies of Preschool Children aged 60-72 months were examined.

Academic Member İbrahim Tarkan Doğan who examined the photo recognition and production competencies of pre-school children aged 60-72 months, shared the results of his research. According to the research, 75 percent of the children state that they have taken pictures before, while 66 percent of the children say that they take the picture with mobile devices, and 63 percent of them say that they take better pictures with mobile devices.











Istanbul Gelisim University Academic Member İbrahim Tarkan Doğan who stated that only 8 percent of the children use the camera of their families, said that "Even though 47 percent of the children gave their own reasons for taking the photograph, only 2 percent of them state that the photograph was taken to remember. While 75 percent of the children stated that they had taken pictures before, 66 percent of the children said that they took the photograph with mobile devices, and 63 percent said that they took better pictures with mobile devices.

Doğan speaking about the workshop program applied to children within the scope of the research, said, "The success rate of the children reached 87.2 percent. This ratio shows that with the photography workshop in preschool, children can gain the power to distinguish the images and photographs they are exposed to in terms of quality, and they can become a producer as well as a consumer. Increasing the number of studies on photography and photography education in preschool will also contribute significantly to increasing the quality of pre-school education.

Doğan continued his speech as follows:

"31.9% of children take their photos with a camera; 94.1 percent of the children who stated that they had never taken a photograph before, want to take a photograph; 27.5 percent think that the photograph could be taken better with a camera; 34.8 percent of them know how to use a camera; 74.0 percent stated that their elders, with whom they live, take photos with their mobile phones. 23.0 percent of the children stated that they took pictures "to look better", "10.0 percent to look", "9.0 percent to show", "5.0 percent to be happy". 91.3 percent of the children stated that they wanted to take lessons in order to take better pictures."

"NEW RESEARCH"

Doğan stating that there is almost no research on photograph and photography in Turkey in preschool, said, "When we look at the examples abroad, there are various studies that will contribute to the relevant literature. In this sense, it can be ensured that the domestic literature in this field can be improved in terms of quality and quantity, starting with the examination of the effect of photography education to be given in preschool on the cognitive, affective and behavioural gains of children. Differences in social skills or awareness of social-environmental problems between children who attend and do not attend photography workshops can be the subject of research.

"IT CAN BE EXAMINED AS A PEDAGOGICAL TOOL"

Academic Member Doğan stating that photography and photography can be examined as a pedagogical tool in preschool and making suggestions, concluded his statements as follows: In addition to the ability to design activities in the curriculum development courses of associate and undergraduate programs in Turkey, scope on how to design art workshops can be added. Photography workshop curriculum can be added to the curriculum of pre-school education institutions by differentiating them at basic and advanced levels according to interest.











Within the scope of family education, photo awareness and simple photography trainings can be organized for the caregivers of preschool children."





16. Economy, Finance And Management Conference Held Online.

17. Research has been Conducted on How Technology Affects Family Lives During the Coronavirus Period and Families were Trained.

Research has been conducted on how technology affects family lives during the coronavirus process. In the research conducted with in-depth interviews with families, it was concluded that people are physically imprisoned at home, but go out through social media, and this will negatively affect psychology in the future.

With the coronavirus epidemic, the technological transformation that will take place in maybe 10 years, has been experienced rapidly in 6 months. Academic Member Dr. Özge Gürsoy Atar and Academic Member Dr. Şebnem Gürsoy Ulusoy, two sisters, conducted a research On how technology affects family life. The research was carried out by conducting in-depth interviews with married families with children. Commenting on the research, Academic Member Dr. Atar said, "During the in-depth interviews, we saw that families were negatively affected by the technological process and benefited from technology in areas such as education and shopping." Academic Member Dr. Ulusoy said, "Due to the advancement of technology, people have locked themselves in their homes, blended with technology. The convenience provided by this technological transformation has turned us into people who are dependent on home and separated from real life without being noticed."

"WE ARE WHO WE ARE AT HOME, BUT OUTSIDE, WE SHOW OUR AVATARS"

Academic Member Dr. Özge Gürsoy Atar who conveyed her findings regarding the interviews, said, "In in-depth interviews, it was stated that families were negatively affected by the technological process; We have seen that they benefit from areas such as education and shopping. It has been revealed that the communication with the elders of the family through online communication channels leaves the children incomplete at some points.











She said that we have seen that the communication within the family has been interrupted a little more for face-to-face during the coronavirus process. As in the movie named Avatar, we live in houses ourselves, but we send our avatar out through social media. We have found that people are physically confined to their homes, but they go out through social media, and that a situation such as negatively affecting their psychology may arise."

IT HAS BEEN SEEN AS A DIGITAL CAREER: PARENT RELATIONS HAVE BEEN DESTROYED

Atar who attracted attention on strengthening communication with the activities by families with each other at home by limiting virtual communication a little more, said, "We see that social media and digital media tools are used by children very intensively in this period. The parents started working from home. The mother cannot take care of the child; that's why social media and digital games have started to be used often. Families began to see them as caregivers. Therefore, communication is limited. We should distance them from digital and social media with more family games. Families should also limit themselves, because we observed that parents tend to social media too much as a result of being overwhelmed as an escape, and we have seen that parents' relationships are deteriorated."

WE ARE AFFECTED BOTH POSITIVELY AND NEGATIVELY

Academic Member Dr. Şebnem Gürsoy Ulusoy from Istanbul Gelisim University School of Applied Sciences addressing that they see people locked in their homes, blended with technology, said, "This process has reflected positively in many ways for us to continue our work and for the continuation of children's education. People did not remain unemployed; children were able to continue to receive education from home. The convenience provided by this technological transformation has transformed us into people who are dependent on home and separated from real life without noticing it. This is where the research came out. While this process continued our daily routines, it also caused us to be a mother 24/7 and to continue our own work."

ARE LARGE FAMILIES IN THE PHASE OF FALLING APART?

Ulusoy who attracted attention that there has been change and transformation in family communication with the epidemic, said, "Large families are very important in our social structure. Those big families are falling apart right now. With the process of getting together big families, being grandparents and big family structure have evolved into virtual grandparents with the corona period and technology. In this period, we cannot predict how the children in the small age group and children who spend 1-2 years in this way will be affected by this, whether they will overcome it later on, and what kind of social mass will come. We can predict that this unpredictable mass will experience limitations in family communication. This was a preliminary study, the work on it continues."

EVENTS MUST BE ORGANIZED WITH TECHNOLOGY

Pointing out that technology causes people to confuse their business and private lives, Ulusoy concluded her words as follows:

"Families need to spend time with each other spiritually. For an elementary family; It is important to stay away from social media, do their work on the internet by arranging hours, and spend productive hours with children.











90% of grandparents use technology. They can communicate face-to-face with their grandchildren, especially in certain days, and can be involved in their time. We must direct the digital environment in a way to keep our communication within the family alive. It will be much more beneficial for families to carry out activities that can continue to be together by using digital technology. Especially in mother- father-child triangle, open space activities and puzzles can be solved in which the mother and father will actively spare time for the child. Printed activities, book reading activities, which they can produce at home using digital technology, can be done. I believe that this process will be overcome, and we will return to normal. It is inevitable that this will have a social impact, especially on children in the 2-10 age group."

Res. Ass. Safiye Top, Istanbul Gelisim University School of Applied Sciences, who entered the top 30 with her work for students in the competition, entitled to participate in the entrepreneurship camp. In addition, at the end of the entrepreneurship camp, five successful project owners (in case of receiving support from national and international support programs within a year) will be awarded with 25 thousand TL.

"I WAS MAKING MARBLING ART TO ATTRACT CUSTOMERS TO THE SHOP"











Res. Ass. Safiye Top describing the first steps she took to become a woman entrepreneur, said that "During my working time, I attended many entrepreneurship trainings. Leaving the job in 2015, my brother and I opened a shop that is big for us but physically small; We opened a store selling women's clothes, we were selling the products we bought by making small changes, at the same time I was doing marbling at the entrance of the store to attract attention of customers to the store. This is where my first dialogue with customers – my entrepreneurial story – started."

"THE AIM OF THE PROJECT IS TO MEET THE NEEDS OF STUDENTS WITH A SMALL COST"

Safiye Top, who was entitled to receive education on entrepreneurship with her project for students, said, "As of 2020, there are approximately 7 million university students in Turkey. Every year, millions of students buy materials such as textbooks, stationery, clothes, and household goods. One of the most common problems in student life is that they do not have the financial power to meet these needs, my project will ensure that these needs are met with less cost. While the project is being carried out, special attention will be paid to ensure that everyone working within the framework of social responsibility is a female student.

"I WANT WOMEN TO PARTICIPATE IN SUCH PROGRAMS"

Top indicating that every woman should have an entrepreneurial story of her own, also said, "I want all women to participate in programs such as 'I have an idea, I want to bring it to life'. If that idea is really going to meet people's needs, it will definitely be accepted into a program. Every failure shows what we did wrong and will help us to fill in the gaps that will exist in future projects. For this reason, it will contribute to the economy, especially if women address the needs they see in their inner circles instead of talking to the masses."

HOW DID I JOIN THE 'WOMEN IN INNOVATION' PROJECT?

Lastly, Top who also provided information about the project application and content to women who want to participate in projects such as "Women in Innovation", said that she applied to

"Women in Innovation 5th Entrepreneurship Camp" on https://www.inovasyondakadin.org. This application form requires filling detailed information about the project such as definition of the project, the aim of the project, the innovative aspect of the project, the market and competition conditions, the intended output, and achievements at the end of the project. In the trainings that started on 05.10.2020, we receive mentorship by experts in the field for the development of our project, two days a week, in addition to trainings such as general information about entrepreneurship and start-up, entrepreneurship-related supports, business plan preparation, project management. In the project, we include the points that we did not think about before or the points that we know wrong, by benefiting from the experiences of our mentors. At the end of the camp, we will try to be among the top 5 projects by presenting the presentations about the final version of the project we have prepared to the jury. If we realize the project when we are in the top 5, we will receive a monetary award of 25,000 TRY and the right to use the office in Teknokent free of charge. Even if we do not rank in the top 5 in the camp, we will have the opportunity to use the projects we have prepared to apply for TÜBİTAK and KOSGEB supports."

The European Alliance for Innovation (EAI) held the conference, which it planned to hold at Antalya Bilim University, online due to the Covid-19 pandemic.



"Sustainability is no longer just the dreams of idealists and visionaries," said Hobbs, and shared his experiences ranging from popular walking tours in the Istanbul countryside to his long career in the international music industry.

60 WALKING ROUTES OUTSIDE THE METROPOLIS

Hobbs expressing that they focus on giving sustainable values to Istanbul's precious countryside, gave details about how the Hiking Istanbul started and how it turned into an online community with more than 5,000 followers, and about his book in the process of publication, which maps nearly 60 walking routes outside the metropolis.











"Sustainability is no longer just the dreams of idealists and visionaries," Hobbs said, and indicated that "We either put sustainable economics into practice immediately, or we accelerate the degradation of the planet's biosphere on which we depend and love, with dire, largely irreversible consequences that will plunge us into the darker visions of sci-fi."

Hobbs ended his speech with following statement:

"There should be no need for an additional reason to protect and preserve beautiful, historical and habitat-rich places. With imagination, a little effort and a modest expense, places that don't exist can be turned into natural and social assets, commonwealth where we trust each other and our futures."

Four scientists carrying out their academic studies in Turkey examined the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on faith tourism. The study sheds light on the history of the virus, its impact on the global economy, and crisis management measures involving holy sites.











In the study carried out by Prof. Dr. William Mosier, Dr. Tariq Elhadary, Dr. İsmail A. Elhaty and Dr. Mehdi Safaei, working at Istanbul Gelisim University, the subject of the COVID-19 pandemic was discussed from the perspective of medical science, chemistry, management science, economics, and religious sociology.

The American Prof. Dr. William Mosier stated that "The spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) has caused a worldwide wave of fear and a lot of misinformation that has left chaos behind. Sacred places hold a special place in the hearts and minds of many people. Mosques in Mecca and Medina have more than a hundred thousand Muslim visitors a day but they had to close their doors for health and safety reasons. The same situation is also valid for the City of Qom in Iran, Bethlehem in the West Bank and Vatican City. This study sheds light on the history of the virus, its impact on the global economy, and crisis management measures involving holy sites."

"IT CAN MAKE BELIEVERS MORE HESITANT"

Prof. Dr. William Mosier stating that the negative impact on faith tourism may affect pilgrimage visits in the future, indicated that "Due to health and safety concerns, visitors who feel that health risks remain may feel reluctant to continue their pilgrimage even after the pandemic has officially ended. The impact could potentially be serious for Islam, since the most important pilgrimage is the annual pilgrimage to densely populated Mecca. It is unclear whether the pilgrimage will be cancelled in 2021. The same uncertainty is experienced by Christian pilgrimages to Bethlehem in the West Bank, the Vatican, Camino or Santiago de Compostela and many other religious sites around the world in the coming months. Fears surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic could have a long-lasting impact on faith tourism and make believers more hesitant to go on pilgrimages."

"THE EPIDEMIC FLAVE THE REKINDLED"

Moiser saying that the COVID-19 pandemic has rekindled the spirituality and willingness of many to respect individual differences more and see the basic unity of all people, said that "The motives that drive millions of pilgrims to take the pilgrimage should not be underestimated. The future of religious tourism depends to some extent on these strong motives as a healing force."

Turkish engineers have developed a microchip working with sound waves that will enable rapid diagnosis of many diseases, especially blood poisoning (sepsis) and cancer. Electrical and Electronics Engineer and Academic Member Dr. Alper Şişman, one of the members of the team carrying out the study, said, "The blood collection method requires a lot of devices, and you have to wait at least 2 hours to get results, we will reduce this time to 5 minutes."

Engineers at Marmara University and Istanbul Gelisim University have moved on to the experimental phase of the acoustic-based microchip project that will be used in RNA isolation, on which they have been working for 2 years. Thanks to the microchip, many diseases, especially blood poisoning (sepsis) and cancer, will be diagnosed quickly.











THE MICROCHIP WORKS WITH SOUND WAVES

Electrical and Electronics Engineer from Marmara University Engineering Faculty Academic Member Dr. Alper Şişman explaining the details and goals of the project, said that they produced the microchip by using sound waves.

Academic Member Dr. Şişman said, "The microchip first selects the blood droplet placed on it by producing micro vibrations, and then breaks it up. It decomposes and evaluates the lysed cells and reveals the RNA molecule. Our primary target is leukocytes, known as white blood cells, after we separate this blood group, which protects the body against infections, with a microchip, we perform the process to evaluate the genetic information in it by bursting the cell membrane and without damaging it."

2-HOUR PROCESS WILL BE DECREASED TO 5 MINUTES

Academic Member Dr. Şişman who explained that it accelerates the diagnosis of diseases such as cancer and sepsis and provides a chance for early intervention, said, "Thanks to the microchip, we get results in a very short time from blood or body fluid sample. The blood collection method currently used in hospitals, clinics and laboratories requires a large number of devices, and you have to wait at least 1-2 hours to get results, we will reduce this time to 5 minutes. This chip can also be used in fatal diseases that are difficult to diagnose. For example, it can reveal sepsis, which is known as cancer or blood poisoning among the people, in a very short time. We will ensure that the patient is intervened early with a microchip."

YOU WILL GET THE SAME RESULT WITH A DROP OF BLOOD

Academic Member Dr. Şişman said, "Today, it is required to take 10-20 milliliters of blood from people for making the devices work. Taking blood samples is a troublesome process, especially for children. With the device that we have produced, we will be able to obtain the same result by taking a sample of 20 microliters, that is, a drop of blood, from the finger. We have completed the laboratory tests; the results are very positive. Our decomposer and cell lysis system work well."

"NO CHEMICALS WILL BE NEEDED"

Şişman stating that they aim to produce a working prototype within 1.5 years, said, "After mass production, our priority is to ensure the use of microchips in clinics, hospitals and laboratories. Thanks to this device, many chemicals brought from abroad to break cells will not be needed, and it will make a great contribution to our country's economy. Chemicals can damage the valuable material that emerges after losing the cell and reduce our efficiency. Since we use sound waves with a microchip, we will get faster, more efficient, and effective results without damaging the target molecule.

WORKS CONTINUE ALL OVER THE WORLD

Stating that studies in this field continue around the world, Academic Member Dr. Alper Şişman said, "Microchips similar to ours are also used in some applications, but there are no microchips used worldwide in the area we will use. That's why we take initiatives for intellectual property rights."









AN EXPERIMENT WAS MADE

Biotechnologist Abbas Ali Husseini from Istanbul Gelisim University, who led the team that carried out the study, said, "We are planning to produce an acoustic-based microchip to be used in RNA isolation. We work with experts from different fields such as chemistry, electricity, electronics, and biology. We are doing our experiments with yeast and blood cells from animals. With the experiment we will do today, we will look at the effectiveness of the microchip in breaking down cells with sound waves."

THERE IS FINANCIAL SUPPORT NEED

Emphasizing that all analyses to be performed with RNA in genetics or clinical laboratories will be done with microchip, faster, with less sample volume and with less cost, Husseini said, "Thanks to the device, analyses can be performed in the field, at the bedside, without the need for a laboratory. We are happy with the results we have achieved so far; we are doing well. We will apply to TÜBİTAK with our project, we need financial support."

The production phase of the microchip has been completed; the experimental work continues. It is aimed to start mass production and put it on the market 1.5 years later.

The Ministry of Culture and Tourism took the necessary decisions and announced that it was done and shared with the authorities related to ugly appearance and damage of Yarımburgaz cave, which dates back 300 thousand years, Vlora Inn which was built in the 1800s, and St. Polyeuktos Church, which was built in 520, among the cultural heritages of Istanbul. Examining the destroyed works on site, Cultural Heritage Management Specialist Academic Member Dr. İlknur Türkoğlu said, "Our citizens need to know and own their history."

While the 300 thousand-year-old Yarımburgaz Cave, one of the important historical and cultural assets of Istanbul, turned into a garbage dump, Saint Polyeuktos Church, which dates back to 1500 years ago, and Vlora Inn, which was built in the 1800s, were also damaged because the necessary attention was not paid. Stating that historical artifacts should be preserved in order to be passed on to future generations, Cultural Heritage Management Specialist Academic Member Dr. İlknur Türkoğlu examined the damaged works on site and answered the questions of DHA. Türkoğlu said, "The important thing here is that the citizens know and own their history. Our citizens should think that these structures are my cultural heritage."

"YARIMBURGAZ CAVE IS NOW ABANDONED TO ITS FATE"

Cultural Heritage Management Specialist Academic Member Dr. İlknur Türkoğlu providing information about the history and current situation of Yarımburgaz Cave, said, "The Yarımburgaz Cave, whose history dates back 300 thousand years, is one of the oldest known settlements in Istanbul. Excavations were made in this cave by Istanbul University in the 60s and it was revealed that people lived here in the Palaeolithic (Old Stone Age) period.











Then it became one of the settlements of people in Neolithic (Polished Stone Age) period. In the Byzantine period, a small chapel was built inside Yarımburgaz cave. However, such a historically valuable cave is now abandoned to its fate. It was desired to produce projects about the cave in time. But so far, no project has been realized."

"THE CAVE IS FULL OF WASTE"

Academic Member Dr. Türkoğlu stating that the cave is inhabited by thinners, said, "When we come to the front of Yarımburgaz Cave, we don't even see an information board. The cave has suffered great damage over years. It was used for bad purposes as it was not known by the citizens. Even today, the front of the cave is full of garbage".

"THERE MUST BE INFORMATION SIGNS ON THE ROAD"

Academic Member Dr. Türkoğlu making a call to the citizens, said, "It is very sad for us that this structure only attracts the attention of treasure hunters. Nowadays, it is very easy to access information. We all have cell phones in our hands. Our citizens can access publications about Yarımburgaz Cave from their mobile phones. Or at least, there should be an information sign on the road. Thus, when the citizens come, they can understand that this place is not an ordinary rock. We have things to do. "People should know the historical value of this building".

"VLORA INN HAS BEEN FULLY COVERED WITH SIGNS, VENTS AND AIR CONDITIONERS"

Academic Member Dr. Türkoğlu stating that the situation is not much different in Vlora Han, which was built at the end of the 1800s, said, "Vlora Inn is one of the most important examples of its era and its kind. It is not known exactly who the architect of the building was. This inn was built as a business inn. In the early 1900s, our famous architect Kemalettin also had an office in this inn. But for 30 years, a restoration work could not be done on this building. This inn is one of the symbolic structures of Istanbul. When I look at the building, we see that it is completely covered with signs, ventilation, and air conditioners. The precious decorations on the building were covered by pipes and the building was pierced in many places."

"VLORA INN'S EXTERIOR DECORATIONS ARE VERY VALUABLE"

Academic Member Dr. Türkoğlu emphasizing that it is of great importance that the restoration work of Vlora Inn is carried out according to scientific rules, said, "Sirkeci and Eminönü are a place that we can call the heart of Istanbul. Especially the exterior decorations of this inn are very valuable from a historical point of view.











Even when our citizens come here for business, they should raise their heads and look around. Here, each building is like a jewel."

"IT HAS BECOME A PLACE WHERE PEOPLE SET FIRE AND LEAVE THEIR WASTE"

Academic Member Dr. Türkoğlu stating the following about the Church of St. Polyeuktos, which was built in 520, said, "Our third place, St. Polyeuktos Church, has been destroyed over time. This summer, a cleaning work was carried out in the church. But we see that this place needs urgent protection. Again, this place has become a place where people go and sit, set a fire and leave their garbage. Again, an information sign should be placed in front of this place for citizens because thousands of people pass by this building every day. But in passing, no one can get any information about this structure. The important thing here is that the citizen knows and owns his history. Our citizens should be proud of saying these structures are my cultural heritage, Turkey's cultural heritage."

MINISTRY: STUDY ON HISTORICAL ARTICLES WERE SENT TO AUTHORITIES

In the written statement made by Ministry of Culture and Tourism, it was stated that "Necessary decisions have been taken regarding Yarımburgaz Cave, Vlora Inn and St. Polyeuktos Church, studies have been carried out on these historical artifacts and they have been shared with the authorities."

In the continuation of the statement, the following statements were made about Vlora Inn, St. Polieuktos Church and Yarımburgaz Cave:

"The area in which Yarımburgaz Cave is located has been registered as a 1st degree Archaeological Site with the decision of the Board dated 16.07.1991. With the board decisions dated 16.11.2017 and 02.02.2019, it was decided to take the necessary security measures by the relevant persons. With our letter dated 10.11.2020, considering the ownership status of the area, related to landscaping project, on-site examination of which parts of the cave can be included in the project and the coordinated map was requested by General Directorate of Assets and Museums of our Ministry of Culture. Studies on ensuring the security of the area and making a landscaping project are still in progress. Privately owned "Vlora Inn" located in Hobyar Quarter in Fatih district of Istanbul, remains in the "Historical Peninsula Urban and Historical Site" determined by the Board decision dated 12.07.1995. In summary, with the letter dated 14.08.2020 of Istanbul Regional Board of Protection of Cultural Heritage No. 4; It has been requested that the issues related to Vlora Inn (neglected appearance, ugly signboard visuals, etc.) be determined and that the necessary safety measures for life, property and environment should be taken immediately by the relevant persons, and the Board Directorate should be informed





immediately about the work and transactions.







With the decision of the Board dated 09.07.2019, it was decided to carry out the excavation works to be carried out in the park of St. Polieuktos Church under the supervision of the relevant Museum Directorate. The aforementioned decision was sent to the Istanbul Governorship Provincial Directorate of Culture and Tourism, Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality and Fatih Municipality. For the distribution of the decision, it was sent to the Fatih Municipality and to the Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality and the Istanbul Foundations 1st Regional Directorate, which are the property owners."

"IT WILL BE BETTER FOR ECONOMY OF THE COUNTRY"

Stating that they will bring entrepreneurial young people together with sector representatives, Gayretli said, "I believe that the cooperation protocol to be signed will be beneficial for our university, our industry and the country's economy."

Academic Member Dr. Leyla Bektaş Ata was awarded the İlhan Tekeli Urban Culture Foundation 2019 Doctoral Thesis Award with her doctoral thesis completed in 2019. Academic Member Dr. Leyla Bektaş Ata from Istanbul Gelisim University, Faculty of Health Sciences, Department of Social Work has been the winner of İlhan Tekeli Urban Culture Foundation 2019 Doctoral Thesis Award, which has been given every year since 1996.

Ata, who gave information about the actors who are the subject of his doctoral thesis titled 'House, Neighborhood and Urban Experience on the Threshold of Urban Transformation: The Example of Limontepe', said, "The one who immigrated from different points of Turkey in the 1970s and established a shantytown in the Limontepe district of İzmir, lived in the second half of the 1990s. They are the urban poor, who have struggled for access to basic services until recently, and whose neighborhoods have been officially declared as urban transformation zones in 2012".

"DYNAMICS ARE RELATED TO THE MACRO SOCIAL PLANE"

Speaking about the purpose of his doctoral thesis research, which was awarded the award, Ata said, "The aim of the research is to analyse the effects of the transformation geography on the use of the slum residents, to examine shanty houses and the ones living in shanty houses through the current sociality, and to reveal the tensions, struggle methods, reconciliation and separation situations of this situation."

Ata continued her words as follows:

"The steps taken by the residents of the shantytown, which cannot gain a deep-rooted place in the city's memory and archive with its transience, continuity and uncertainty, are made visible in their spatial experiences and imaginations. While it is based on the study of daily life conducted with a multi-method (life stories, ethnography and autoethnography) and an interdisciplinary perspective, the dynamics of the said daily are associated with the macrosocial and political plane."

"MIGRATION CONTINUES"

Stating that immigration continues for those living in shantytowns, Ata said, "Those who migrated from different rural regions of Turkey and established shantytowns face the possibility of relocating with the impact of urban transformation projects that have taken place intensively in recent years."

Stating that the slums are mostly closed to people other than the residents, Ata said, "They do not have the socio-economic opportunities to be visited by those who are not from the neighbourhood. This situation brings about the fact that the diversity of city life is not observed in the slums.









Anonymity gained in urban life cannot be achieved in shanty houses. This situation triggers surveillance and pressure mechanisms especially on young women. Sincere relations arising from living together in the same region for a long time cause the neighbours to become relatives, added that this situation would legitimize the pressure on the neighbourhood.

Emphasizing that it is difficult for the second generation to grow up in the neighbourhood to gain class mobility through education, Ata said, "In this case, the lack of role models, the inadequacy of the regional schools, and the limitation of families in orientation are important factors."

Working on the disaster and accessibility of streets with stairs in Istanbul, Faculty Members Gül Yücel and İlke Ciritci examined 26 examples from different districts.

From Istanbul Gelisim University Department of Architecture, Academic Member Dr. Gül Yücel and Academic Member Dr. İlke Ciritci, examined 26 samples selected over 100 steps from different districts. In the on-site detection and examination, the relationship of the streets with stairs with the topography, landscape, building connections, step structure, purpose of use, density and disaster and emergency risks such as earthquake, flood, fire were evaluated.

"THE STREETS WITH STAIRS ARE DIFFERENT ACCORDING TO THE DISTRICT USED"

Stating that they are working on streets with many stairs in different districts of Istanbul, Academic Member Dr. Gül Yücel said, "One of the most important problems of streets with stairs is accessibility in emergencies. The fact that both the social life and the needs are different in residential areas with different textures bring about differences in the use of streets with stairs."

"STREETS WITH STAIRS ARE A PART OF YOUR SOCIAL LIFE"

Pointing out that they made inspections on many stairs within the scope of the research, Yücel said that in addition to the characteristics of the stairs, they also looked at the physical structure of the surrounding buildings, the number of floors, the risk factors on their facades and the width of the streets.

Explaining that the streets with stairs have been a part of the social life of Istanbul from history to this day, Yücel said, "We held meetings with the Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality Fire Brigade Department and AFAD Istanbul Provincial Directorate to determine the risks of those living on the streets with stairs in case of disasters or emergencies. Of course, our main goal was to find the basic elements of how people living in the buildings around the street with stairs can be easily evacuated from the area they are in to a safer place in case of disaster and emergency. We have also made important findings in this regard."

"LATER ADDITIONS OF BUILDINGS CAN CAUSE RISK FOR OUTDOOR LIFE SAFETY"

Pointing out that pedestrianized streets and the stairs leading to these streets are generally used frequently, Istanbul Gelisim University Academic Member Dr. İlke Ciritci, on the other hand, said, "Asmalı Mescit District and Algeria Street in Beyoğlu can be given as examples. It is important that people living in that area have clean and non-hazardous escape routes in case of a disaster. Later additions to the buildings on these streets and stairs may create the danger of falling on people on the street during an earthquake and increase the risk of life safety outside the building.

Emphasizing that he has many observations on this subject, Dr. Ciritci said, "Maybe restorations can be made with the right methods by experts on these determinations. Thanks to these measures, disaster resistance can be increased, and loss of life can be prevented."


36. Developments in Breast Cancer

Fight Against Drugs event was organized by Berk Efe Altınal on May 19. In the event, where the harms of the body and immune system were discussed, the participants were informed.














39. Symptoms of Depression








41. Covid-19 Vaccines



A meeting was held with Rıza Çelen, Chairman of the Board of Public Oversight, Accounting and Auditing Standards, regarding the training programs planned for independent auditors. During the meeting, it was decided to authorize IGUSEM for the trainings given to independent auditors by the KGK. Pointing out that the agreement with KGK is important, IGUSEM Director Academic Member Dr. Fatih Fuat Tuncer said, "The authorization, which is not done with every educational institution, was made with IGUSEM. This is a very happy decision for us. As of March, we have started our continuous training for independent auditors."



3. International Yoga Expertise Training Was Provided.

With the International Yoga Expertise training, it was aimed that 73 participants could have a one-hour yoga practice and have the expertise to convey basic information about yoga.













4. Patient Admission and Medical Secretarial Training

15 people participated in the training, which was aimed at providing medical secretaries with the knowledge of all types of medical documents, their areas of use and the legal regulations about the documents, and the knowledge and skills necessary for the creation and organization of the hospital archive.

5. Family Counseling Training

It was aimed to identify the current problems experienced in the family and to combat these problems scientifically, psychologically, and culturally, and to equip the participants who want to become family counsellors with counselling skills. Although the program lasts 450 hours, it consists of 300 hours of distance education and theoretical education, 120 hours of practice, 30 hours of supervision. 46 people attended the training.



6. Aircraft Maintenance English

Aircraft Maintenance English training is suitable for pilots, air traffic controllers, aircraft engineers, aircraft maintenance technicians, cabin crew, airport/airline personnel, associate, undergraduate and graduate students.











At the end of the training, they will be entitled to receive a certificate with an exam. Aircraft Maintenance English is basically a system created to gain English comprehension and communication skills; the training was conducted with 30 participants.



7. Trainer Training

The aim of the training is to provide the participants with educational skills by teaching the basic concepts and principles of education and group and one-to-one teaching methods, to determine the basic principles of adult education and to develop their educational qualifications. In the training, it is aimed to convey basic and application examples with the expert academic staff of Istanbul Gelisim University and 68 people attended the training.

It is aimed that an individual be able to recognize effective and speedy reading techniques, to demonstrate knowledge, skills and attitudes regarding reading comprehension, recall, interpretation, evaluation, to analyze paragraphs and texts, to read appropriately in printed and electronic media, advertisement, news, etc., to criticize media texts, use their prior knowledge and experience in reading comprehension, to make comparisons between the texts they read (story, essay, newspaper, magazine, etc.), to use time efficiently in exams such as LGS, YKS, DGS, KPSS, ALES, YDS, YDT. 16 persons attended to the training.

General English Trainings were given by Istanbul Gelisim University Continuing Education Center. Each course lasts 7 weeks and takes a total of 140 hours. D. Social Support Activities Conducted Off-Campus

With the vision of supporting Quality Education, one of 17 Global Goals determined by United Nations (UN), Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) continues to produce projects that will ensure quality education in regions where access to opportunities is limited.

An informatics class was founded in Çakıllı Primary School and Çakıllı Secondary School and Üsküp Secondary School under the direction of Kırklareli Provincial Directorate of National Education within the scope of the project which they set out to support equal opportunities in education and to leave a sustainable environment for future generations studying in village schools with limited opportunities, with the "Ecological, Economic and Social Sustainability" perspective.
