

THE EXPECTED ISTANBUL EARTHQUAKE MAY OCCUR UNTIL 2026

Stating that the North Anatolian Fault has 2 unbroken segments and that this situation threatens the Marmara and Eastern Anatolia Regions, Neotectonics and Earthquake Specialist **Prof. Dr. Haluk Selim** said that the expected Istanbul earthquake could occur until 2026. Selim also emphasized the importance of urban transformation projects by saying that the buildings on the Anatolian side of Istanbul carry a risk of 40% and the buildings on the European side have a risk of 60%.

On the 22nd anniversary of the 17 August earthquake, Dean of Engineering and Architecture Faculty in Istanbul Gelisim University, Neotectonics and Earthquake Specialist Prof. Dr. Haluk Selim said that there are 2 unbroken segments of the North Anatolian Fault and this carries a great risk. Noting

that the Marmara Sea and the Eastern Anatolia Region are under threat in this situation, Selim stated that "The North Anatolian Fault affected the region with two earthquakes that occurred in 1999. The North Anatolian Fault, which started in 1939, had a great impact in this geography, where we live, with approximately 11 earthquakes greater than 7.0 intensity in 60 years. The fault reached as far west as the 1999 earthquakes. But what happened next? Although it should have moved further west, it returned to Düzce and the second earthquake occurred. Currently, it still poses risks in the Marmara Sea."

Stating that especially babies, children, pregnant women, the elderly and individuals with weakened immune systems are more susceptible to foodborne diseases, Public Health expert **Dr. Nurten Elkin said**, "Although food poisoning is mostly a mild and short-term illness, it can cause severe and even death due to factors related to the individual."

"Food poisoning is an important public health problem that increases especially in summer," said Public Health Expert Dr. Nurten Elkin and made statements on the subject.

CORRUPTION OF THE COMMANDING SYSTEM DEMORALIZED AFGHAN FORCES

What will happen after the Taliban's taking control of Kabul arouses curiosity. International Relations Specialist Dr. Bahlul Aliyev said "Although Afghan government forces were quite ahead of the Taliban militias in both numbers and equipment, the rapid withdrawal of American forces, the lack of central will, corruption in the command system and the prevalent chaos and fear in the society demoralized the Afghan forces."

Stating that the USA's hasty retreat from Afghanistan is related to the new reality of international relations, Sociologist and International Relations Specialist at Istanbul Gelisim University, Asst. Prof. Bahlul Aliyev said, "The war waged by the USA against the Taliban and other fundamentalist organizations in Afghanistan is the longest-running war in the history of the USA, but also

attracted attention with its very high cost. When we examine the US military presence, which ended with a balance sheet of 2 trillion dollars, there is no geopolitical success or perspective for the US. Even if it wasn't fully formed when getting USA forces to systematically retreat from the country it plays a key role in the new system of international relations that is emerging more and more prominently. The current system is no longer compatible with the military operations carried out in the 2000s. Although the USA was supported by other geopolitical actors at the beginning of the operation, the same support could not be provided for a long time in the changing order. This made the American presence in Afghanistan anachronistic."

1 MILLION PEOPLE DIE EVERY YEAR FROM VACCINE-PREVENTABLE DISEASES

Stating that vaccines protect not only the individuals but also the society, Public Health Specialist **Dr. Nurten Elkin said**, "More than one million people still die every year from vaccine-preventable diseases worldwide. Many of these diseases are not seen at all or rare in Turkey thanks to our vaccination programs." Dr. Nurten Elkin made further statements on the issue.

"SMALLPOX WAS ERADICATED BY DIVERSE VACCINATION"

Implying that such diseases are almost never seen in Turkey thanks to vaccination programs, Public Health Specialist Dr. Nurten Elkin said, "Vaccines can prevent infectious diseases that kill or harm many infants, children and adults. Widespread vaccination has eradicated smallpox, and a 99 percent

reduction succeeded in polio. If your child is unvaccinated, he or she is at risk of many vaccine-preventable diseases such as measles, polio, meningitis, tetanus, jaundice as well as the disability and death they may cause.

ABOUT NEW CORONAVIRUS



All necessary measures are taken for the **coronavirus** revealed in Turkey and the World at **Istanbul Gelisim University. Things to know about coronavirus are as follows:**

What are the new coronavirus symptoms?

- The most common symptoms are fever, cough and respiratory distress.
- In severe cases, pneumonia, severe respiratory failure, kidney failure and death may occur
- Incubation period is between 2 and 14 days.

How is the virus transmitted?

It can be transmitted by the contact of the droplets caused by coughing and sneezing with the contact of the mouth, nose and eyes of other individuals in certain environment and by touching the surfaces where the droplets adhere and taking hands into the mouth, nose or eyes.

What to do to be protected from the virus?

- When coughing or sneezing, the mouth and nose should be covered with a disposable tissue, if there is no handkerchief, the mouth should be closed with the upper sleeve or elbow, not with the palms.
- Handshaking and hugging should be avoided.
- Mouth, nose and eyes should not be touched with dirty hands.
- Hands must be washed for at least 20 seconds in accordance with the Handwashing Instructions found in the toilets. In the absence of water and soap, alcohol-containing hand antiseptics should be used. Cologne of 70-80 degrees also serve as disinfectants.
- Offices and classrooms must be ventilated hourly.
- Places frequently used by many people such as common areas and door handles should be disinfected every 2 hours.
- Hands must be washed after using public transportation.
- Because the virus progresses faster in people with low immune system; a balanced and healthy diet is required. Foods must be washed thoroughly before consumption.

What to do if there are symptoms?

- If you have come from countries with infections in the past 14 days, apply to the nearest healthcare facility by wearing a surgical mask.
- If you are coughing, have a fever and have difficulty at breathing, apply to the nearest healthcare facility by wearing a surgical mask.
- Always wear your mask when you are in the same room with a person who is recommended insulation at home.
