TOOTH INFLAMMATION CAN CAUSE DEATH IF NOT TREATED PROMPTLY!

The inability of people with a toothache to do their daily work and to experience sleepless nights negatively affects their quality of life. With inflammation in the aching tooth, most of the time, the person needs to use antibiotics. Stating that inflammation can become chronic and cause different health problems if not treated, Prof. Dr. Seref Ezirganlı pointed out that the inflammation should be dried.

Inflammation is a response of the body's defense system to foreign substances, trauma, harmful chemicals, microorganisms such as bacteria and viruses. Inflammation plays an important role in the control of infectious diseases and healing of wounds. Inflammation occurs in two different forms, acute and chronic. While acute inflammation develops rapidly within a few hours or a few days, chronic inflammation develops slowly, taking weeks. If acute inflammations are not treated, they become chronic over time.

INFLAMMATORY NEED TO BE INTERVENTION

If inflammatory conditions are not intervened, it pierces the jawbone and spreads to the soft tissue. This causes swelling inside and outside the mouth. As a result, heat, redness, swelling, pain, and loss of chewing function of the patient, which are the 5 symptoms of acute inflammation, occur. Prof. Dr. Seref Ezirganlı, from Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) Faculty of Dentistry, stated the following: "When left untreated or if adequate and effective treatment is not applied, acute inflammations become chronic and flow into or out of the mouth through a channel for weeks without getting better. As a result, the pain is also reduced. However, sometimes it can be activated and a reaction can occur. It can also mix with the blood and cause a serious bloodstream infection, which we call "septicemia."









This situation damages the tissues and organs. Expressing that it can cause death by spreading to vital organs such as the brain, heart and heart valve, Ezirganlı drew attention to the importance of drying the inflammation.

IF YOU HAVE THESE SYMPTOMS, YOU MUST USE ANTIBIOTICS

Antibiotic resistance has developed in society due to the unconscious consumption of antibiotics. Therefore, it is not sold without a prescription. There is a common belief among people that inflamed teeth cannot be extracted. Prof. Dr. Seref Ezirganlı indicated, "If there is acute inflammation and local redness, temperature increase, swelling, pain and loss of function, which are the 5 main symptoms of acute inflammation, the patient should be given antibiotics before tooth extraction. However, if the tooth inflammation is chronic, extraction can be done. Nevertheless, if the patient has a second infection that suppresses the immune system (such as flu or caries-related fever, malaise, etc.), it would be more appropriate to extract the tooth after the patient recovers."

NEW TREND: NEWBORN NURSING

Parents who had just a baby are worried about the baby's care, particularly after leaving the hospital. Mothers and fathers who want to take care of their baby without harming it receive home newborn care services after birth. Asst. Prof. Dr. Bahar Nur Kanbur, a faculty member in the Department of Nursing at Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU), gave information about how to care for a newborn baby and newborn nursing.

Newborn care is a very difficult process for both parents and babies. The newborn nurses provide support on how to meet all the needs of the baby and the mother during the first 28-day period, starting with the postpartum hospitalization and the mothers and fathers being alone with the baby.

THE FIRST 28 DAYS AFTER BIRTH IS VERY SIGNIFICANT!

The first month after birth is the most significant period in which communication between the mother and the baby is established. During this period, the most intense changes occur in both the physical and emotional state of the mother, as well as in the home environment and social life. Especially during this period, women need the support of those around them. Asst. Prof. Dr. Bahar Nur Kanbur, Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU), Faculty of Health Sciences, Department of Nursing, stated the following:

"In a study conducted in 2018, it was determined that mothers needed support for infant care and nutrition in the postpartum period. There are periods when families cannot receive comprehensive service during the postpartum hospitalization period. Moreover, newborn nurses provide support to the family, considering the situations such as the mother resting at home after birth and the baby adapting to the family."

Newborn nurses, who help identify possible problems of the baby and produce solutions, assist the mother with breastfeeding, baby care and health follow-up as they have practical experience in newborns.









THEY SUPPORT THE NUTRITION, CARE AND DEVELOPMENT PROCESS OF THE BABY!

Sleep patterns, full and adequate sucking are of great importance in newborn care. Newborn nurses ensure that the appropriate home environment (room temperature, humidity, determination of needs) is prepared for the mother and the baby. They help to keep track of the baby's weight, height, head circumference and vaccination during the development process. At the same time, they give practical information to the family about the baby's feeding, bathing, massages, gas and diaper rash care and what to do in an emergency. Asst. Prof. Dr. Bahar Nur Kanbur also indicated: "Newborn nurses help the mother to master the feeding, care and development processes of the baby. Hence, families can get help from newborn nurses who are trained in this job to get informed support".

ISTANBUL GELISIM UNIVERSITY FACULTY OF FINE ARTS BROUGHT "SPECIAL EDUCATION STUDENTS" TOGETHER WITH CINEMA EVENT

A new social responsibility project which is organized by Istanbul Gelisim University Fine Arts Faculty, Radio, Television and Cinema Department, has started. Aforementioned social responsibility project implemented with the cooperation of Istanbul Gelisim University and Samyeli Private Educational Institutions, special education students will have a cinema experience and enter social interactive environments.

In the social responsibility project aimed at reaching special education students, a cinema event was organized in three different sessions with the student group with down syndrome, the 0-6 age group and the learning disability groups.

THE FIRST SESSION OF THE SPECIAL EDUCATION CINEMA DAYS SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY PROJECT WAS HELD!

The first session of the Special Education Cinema Days project was held on July 26, 2022 in the screening room hall of the Radio, Television and Cinema Department of Istanbul Gelisim University Fine Arts Faculty. Samyeli Special Educational Institution teachers, special education student group with down syndrome and parents participated in the event.

The first of the events, which was supervised by Asst. Prof. Dr. Sezgin Savaş, Vice Dean of the Faculty of Fine Arts, and coordinated by Prof. Dr. Şükran Güzin Ilıcak Aydınalp, Dean of the Faculty of Fine Arts, and Asst. Prof. Dr. Rabiya Saltik, from the Department of Radio, Television and Cinema, started with Aydınalp's opening speech. A conversation was held with the participation of Samyeli Special Educational Institutions teacher Ali Atlı and Lect. Kadriye Yıldız, lecturer in Special Education Department at Istanbul Sabahattin Zaim University. In the conversation, the importance and requirements of social responsibility projects for special education students and social responsibility projects that can be organized in the future were discussed.
