Interest of exhibition curated by Graphic Design Department Prof. Dr. Erol Yıldır was quite high.






Research Assistant Gökçe Uzgören Attended the Training titled "Nature-Based Solutions for Resilient Cities"






Interview with Res. Asst. Ayşe Seray Çetin



What would you like to say about the new cultural center to be opened?

G&G Arts Center actually delayed its opening for a year due to the pandemic environment. It was ready for the opening last year. However, the pandemic conditions that affected us all caused the opening of this center to be postponed. Of course, it is important for all of us to come together in a healthy environment and breathe the air of art that gives us morale and healing. Under the leadership of Güher-Gürdal Elçiçek, the center, which was allocated to the art scene with significant material and moral sacrifices, is located in the Beyaz Köşk space in Göztepe-Çiftehavuzlar. In this four-floor space, two floors of gallery space are arranged on two floors as spaces that will provide opportunities for art workshops, conversations and art meetings. It was aimed to bring art lovers together by creating meeting areas in its large garden.

Can you give information about the mission of the art center?

First of all, G&G Art Center aims to be a light and morale to







its environment through art, without expecting any material return. It will be a center of attraction with the exhibitions, workshops and events of important artists. In addition, it aims to provide scholarships to students studying in the field of art and various opportunities for them to show themselves in the art environment.

What would you like to say about Devrim Erbil's 'Variations' exhibition organized for the opening of the G&G Art Center?

Devrim Erbil is an invaluable artist, educator and artisan who has left his mark on the adventure of Turkish painting for the last 60 years. You will see his name in every area where art is spoken and exists. I graduated from the Academy as his student. We have a special friendship beyond the teacher-student relationship. When the Art Center came to the fore as a project, the name Devrim Erbil naturally came to the fore. You know, Devrim teacher has been living in Bodrum for 1.5 years. We talked to him, and he supported us in holding an exhibition with selected works that he reserved for the 'museum' at this

opening, and we organized an exhibition of about 50 works under the theme of 'Variations'. I am the curator. With the catalog article I wrote, I made evaluations about my teacher's place in Turkish painting. As a student, it was an honor for me.

We invite all art lovers to the 'Variations' exhibition of Devrim Erbil together with the G&G Art Center.

Akyel "Serdengeç"
Is Out!



Our student Suat Akyel, who published his second book not long after his first book "Escape", answered our questions about his adventure as an author and his second book of poetry, "Serdengeç".

Hello Suat. First of all, congratulations on your second book. First of all, can you talk about the fact that you published your second book as a poem after the first book in the novel category, "Escape"? Why poetry?

Hello, thank you very much. Poetry is the tears or smile of literature... I can say that it is the expression of the emotions people experience. Of course, when you do this, you become independent of them, but when you cover the papers with those lines, you see the real meaning. Asking myself "Why poetry?" I didn't ask, of course, but I had a reason.

Where does the name Serdengeç come from? What kind of poems await the reader in the book?

As a matter of fact, our Turkish has the word "serdengeçti" rather than "Serdengeç". Its meaning is also defined as "fedai", that is, more "a person who can sacrifice himself for a purpose". But its meaning to me was derived from a completed poem of two lines, which I could not continue and which I actually thought was half. his book; These two lines that greet the reader right on the first page; I completed the lines that contain melancholy such as "You passed me by, I am serdengeç..." with poems I wrote before. In other words, those lines that I thought were half were actually integrated with my other writings, and thus Serdengeç emerged.

I would also like to ask about your adventure of writing a novel and a poetry book. Are there any differences or

compelling aspects between the two? How would you compare these two?

Novel and poetry... Two different ways, both meeting the same goal. Same letters, same words but different expressions. The lines in the novel must have a context, meaning and an ongoing event, but my definition of the poem is; "It is a whole formed by the coming together of independent lines, it is magic". In other words, while what is told in a line and what is said in the next or previous line can be independent of each other, in the end, they become a whole with a magic. Therefore, reading and writing poetry is another feeling.

You published your second book not long after your first book. Can you talk about the factors that affect your creativity and productivity in your writing journey? Where do you get your motivation and inspiration?

Actually, my only motivation is to produce. To turn it into a tangible asset. What accumulates inside of me stems from my wanting that it does not accumulate on the papers on my desk. What I write should touch the eyes and touch the hearts. That's the only purpose. Reading more and producing more...

Finally, what advice would you give to the students of Istanbul Gelişim University?

This is what I will say to the students and fellow students of my school; there is an organization behind you that is open to development and teaching and that makes you feel its support in every good thing you do. Strive to produce and develop in any field. Because there is Development behind you...

We congratulate our student and wish him continued success.




