LATEST NEWS FROM IGU

Lect. Tuğçe Özdiñç from Istanbul Gelisim Vocational School Applied English Translation Program presented her paper titled “A Crimson Jane : Intertextuality of The Crimson Petal and the White and Jane Eyre” Yeditepe University Graduate Conference of Literary Studies: “Rethinking / Reapproaching the Home” conference.

Özdiñç analyzed the differences between Michel Faber’s 2002 Neo-Victorian novel “The Crimson Petal and the White” and Charlotte Brontë’s Victorian novel Jane Eyre published in 1847. Özdiñç stated the following in her analysis: Although Faber’s novel is labeled as a rewrite of Jane Eyre by some critics, there is no parallelism between the storyline or the main characters in the novel. It does not fall into the category of rewriting as the author does not claim that this is the case. The Crimson Petal bears traces of Julia Kristeva’s term “intertextuality”.

Asst. Prof. Dr. Sevda Polat, a faculty member at Istanbul Gelisim Vocational School Applied Russian and Translation Program, organized an online conference called “The World of Russian Language and Culture in the Field of Information Technology” with the Moscow State University Language Center. Scientists from universities of countries such as Russia, Turkey, China, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan and Egypt attended the conference.

Asst. Prof. Dr. Sevda Polat, who is on the conference organizing committee, gave information about the “Development of the Russian Language in Turkey”. She mentioned that the Russian language is one of the most preferred foreign languages in Turkey.

The 2021-2022 Istanbul Gelisim University graduation ceremony was held for the first time after the pandemic, with all students and their families brought together. During the two-day ceremony, 8,188 students graduated from undergraduate and associate degree programs.

This year's graduation ceremony—the first step for thousands of young people to enter business life—was held for the 13th time. Students from Istanbul Gelisim University graduated with ceremonies held at the Yahya Kemal Beyatli Conference Hall on June 21 and 22, 2022, after finishing their education and training with the knowledge and skills of the 21st century.

“BE AN EMPLOYER, NOT A JOB SEEKER”

The graduation ceremony started with the opening speeches of Abdülkadir Gayretli, Istanbul Gelisim University Chairman of the Board of Trustees, and Rector Prof. Dr. Bahri Şahin. Emphasizing that IGU students add value to Turkey, Gayretli continued his words as follows:

“We, as Istanbul Gelisim University, are a family. Just like in the family, we are always with you. We say to be an employer, not a job seeker. We support our students who want to set up their own businesses in many areas such as providing them with office furniture. In order for you to graduate equipped with the skills and competencies of the 21st century, we both support foreign language course fees in our undergraduate and associate degree departments and provide career opportunities within our university with the “New Graduate Development Program”. Turkey will be led by individuals like you. THE WEAKEST LINK IN CYBER ATTACKS IS COMPANY USERS

Ast. Prof. Dr. Serkan Gönen, a faculty member at Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU), stated that company employees should be made particularly aware of cyber attacks since anonymity, inexpensive and widespread availability of attack sources, and low rates of risk and punishment encourage cyber attackers.

The virtual environment is used for a variety of transactions, from shopping to health care, from education to citizenship. All activities that go from the physical world to the virtual environment now have a higher chance of running into cyberattacks. **Ast. Prof. Dr. Serkan Gönen** indicated that attackers are encouraged by the relatively low risk and punishment rate, as well as the inexpensive and ubiquitous availability of attack supplies.

WARNING TO CORPORATE COMPANIES TO AWARE EMPLOYEES AGAINST CYBER ATTACKS

Dr. Serkan Gönen, a faculty member at Istanbul Gelisim University Faculty of Engineering and Architecture, Computer Engineering Department, stated the following:

“Precautions that can be taken in the field of cyber security are generally considered in three basic dimensions. The first includes technical hardware and software such as firewall, end-user security (anti-virus, anti-spam etc.) and network access control. The second dimension is standards and policies. The last dimension, and often the least valued, is cybersecurity awareness. In other words, it is the user. Based on the principle that “a chain is only as strong as its weakest link,” the users, often known as the human factor, are the weakest link in the field of cyber security. Because the investments in question will be insufficient until users’ understanding of the significance of cyber security is improved, regardless of whether the most expensive cyber security hardware and software are delivered as required.”

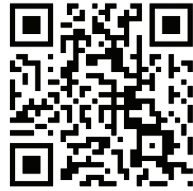
