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ISTANBUL GELISIM UNIVERSITY IS 16TH IN THE WORLD AND 1ST IN TURKEY IN THE FIELD OF "QUALITY EDUCATION"!

Times Higher Education (THE), the ranking institution of world universities, has been announced the Impact Ranking of 2022. Among the 1180 universities in the world, Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) increased its success ranking, which was 24 last year, to 16th place in the category of "Quality Education" by increasing 8 steps this year. It continued to maintain its success last year, ranking 1st among Turkish universities.

The success of Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) was ranked in five different categories in line with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, in the list of 1406 universities, which are listed in the 2022 ranking of the UK-based, world's leading higher education rating agency, Times Higher Education (THE). In the Impact Ranking 2022 list, Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) increased its degree from 24th to 16th among 1180 world universities in the "Quality Education" category, while maintaining its 1st place among Turkish universities.

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ACHIEVEMENTS FROM 5 DIFFERENT CATEGORIES

In the ranking carried out in line with the categories in 17 fields determined by the United Nations within the scope of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), Istanbul Gelişim University is among the universities of Turkey, with its studies in the field of education, innovative projects and its contributions to the society;

- SDG4: Ranked 1st in Turkey in the Quality Education category,
- SDG7: Ranked 4th in Turkey in Accessible and Clean Energy category,
- SDG3: Ranked 12th in Turkey in the category of Healthy and Quality Life,
- SDG6: Ranked 12th in Turkey in the category of Clean Water and Sanitation
- SDG17: Ranked 24th in Turkey in the Partnerships for Purposes category, it proved itself in many areas such as lifelong learning practices, communityoriented learning, personal development opportunities, quality and sustainability of the education provided.

Abdulkadir Gayretli, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU), who made a statement about the ranking in which the effects of ecological, economic and environmental sustainability practices on society according to the United Nations 17 Sustainable Development Goals are aimed, stated that while istanbul Gelisim University was among the top 100 universities in the "Quality Education" category in the past years but today it is in the 16th place in the world ranking and he said:

In the 2022 rating of Times Higher Education (THE), one of the most respected higher education rating institutions in the world, we moved up 8 places from our 24th place in the "Quality Education" category in the world ranking, to 16th this year. By hosting many national and international largescale projects within our university, we are shaping scientific achievements and the future."

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Among the Top 500 Universities Worldwide in the Field of Engineering and Ecological Sciences!



The Spain-based ranking organization, SCImago (SIR), which ranks the universities from the point of view of the social effect indicators on the basis of their research performances, innovation printouts and web visibilities, announced its ranking list of international universities for 2022. While the Istanbul Gelisim University ranked among the first 500 universities worldwide in the field of Engineering and Ecological Sciences, it succeeded to rank on the 721st best university among 4.364 universities in general ranking.

One of the leading ranking organizations internationally, SCImago (SIR), which evaluated the web visibilities for 2021 of the research and innovation activities of the universities between the years of 2016-2020, published and announced the list of the leading international universities for 2022. While the Istanbul Gelisim University ranked among the top 500 universities within the field of Engineering and Ecological Sciences, it took place on the 721st best university among a total number of 4.364 universities internationally.

On the 24th Rank in the Fields of Economics, Econometrics and Finance

140 universities from Turkey took place in the SCImago 2022 list where the scientific performances of the Universities were evaluated in 19 different fields. While the Istanbul Gelisim University was listed on the 24th rank among the universities in Turkey at the research and innovation printouts, made in the fields of Economics, Econometrics and Finance, it occupied the 33rd rank at the list in the field of Engineering. The IGU, listed on the 16th rank in Turkey at the field of Ecological Sciences, occupied the 58th rank among the Middle Eastern universities and 351st rank, however, among the OECD universities.

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OUR ACADEMICS WRITE

EDUCATION AND TRAINING IN THE FUTURE

In line with the possibilities of today's science and technology, education and training are carried out by using various materials and tools and by perception (seeing, hearing, feeling, tasting, smelling, etc.). For this, different periods are determined according to the subject of education and training. (Associate, undergraduate, graduate, doctorate, etc.).These periods may differ with the individual receiving education and training, the trainer and many other variables. However, one of the radical changes that will occur in all areas of life in the future will be the difference in the method of uploading information. This will be a radical change when information uploading to the living cell becomes active with the methods and tools to be used. All of the long-term labor, campus, trainer, transportation, laboratory, material and moral resources will be saved.



Perhaps there will be such a time that these values will be reset for education and training. The (relevant) information upload to an individual's organs will occur and will be a function of its main variable, time. Here, at the moment, only in the estimation phase, for example; 6 (six) years of medical education will be 4 (four) hours, 4 (four) years of engineering education will be 3 (three) hours, 2 (two) years of associate degree education will be like 1 (one) hour. At this stage, it would not be wrong to think that the determining effect of the exam, which is one of the evaluation criteria, will not change in general terms, only the way and method can change. In addition, the variation of the loading process in question may also depend on other variables. These may be, for example, the person's state of health, age. Again, at this stage, there may be a preliminary preparation period in this sense, since the products obtained with a lot of effort and push will be loaded. In addition, for those other than normal or compulsory loading (such as compulsory education and training period), these trainings may be paid, as in many universities today, masters and doctoral degrees are paid.



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It is certain that the process cannot be completed with the approach only in terms of installation. There are also values in question here. These; experience, ability, capacity, experience, practicality, etc. many things can happen. For example; After the information is loaded for an individual to play any instrument, will the shape and structure of the use of the instrument in guestion be included in the same loading or will it take place with another loading? There are answers to such questions. If the practicality of using the wrist (while shooting, dribbling, rebounding, etc.) can be achieved by uploading information or another method for which there is no answer at the moment, after an individual has been given the knowledge of how to play basketball, the practices up to that time will either be completely invalid or it may turn into the formation of results such as the decrease of its effect with certain percentages.



As with any innovation or new thing, there will be opposition to such formations. For example: such as the way the virus emerged, which is the subject of debate today. (Like the argument that these are caused by base stations.). The situation that we are trying to talk about will bring very high changes in the lives of living things, especially people, compared to the past. This fundamental change will cause many things that regulate life to be reconstructed with new references. These are naturally positive gains and returns. However, as much as the improvement in a subject brings benefits, it will certainly bring with it negativities. For example; during uploading information to the live, in addition to the information that needs to be loaded, such as the loading of "unintentional" information. Just like hackers do today, but with a different logic of approach. With the information to be loaded in an approach in this sense, it may be possible for living things to be fixed-minded and thoughtful. Even the encounters of live groups in terms of negativity. (Existence of the same living things in an intellectual sense.) For the "information loading" approach that is tried to be stated, in which environment and in which state (except for health, etc.) the living thing is may not be in question. For example; If an electromagnetic wave or a similar loading approach is used in a particular frequency band, there may be an independent (unaffected) situation, whether the creature is sleeping, walking, running or drinking water.



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FOOD WASTE

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CAREER IN BANKS CALL CENTERS

Call centers are one of the most used technology tools in customer relationship management as well as interaction centers where technology is used the most. In Turkey, the call center sector is changing rapidly and competition is increasing. Call centers are aware of the importance of being customer-oriented in order to keep up with change, develop new strategies and implement them.

Bank call center staff recruitment is among the most searched and applied for career sites. Although banks do not conduct a written interview, the candidates to be recruited to this unit are subject to an oral interview. Candidates who successfully pass the oral interviews are trained before recruitment. In this training, trainings are given on how call center personnel should communicate with customers, how to approach customer-related problems, and how to reach a solution in the most effective way. At the same time, training is given on computer systems used by banks. In this way, the personnel can approach the customer problem in a more focused way and successfully perform the sales and marketing of products and services.



After completing the necessary training in the call center, the candidate who starts work is responsible for answering the calls from the customers. For this reason, banks seek candidates who have effective communication skills, high persuasiveness, friendly and sincere personnel. Candidates who find creative solutions to customers' problems and show high performance are rewarded in various ways by the bank.

Bank call center personnel, who are in direct contact with customers, should learn about customer relations and the system if they want to advance in the banking profession. Learning how it works allows you to climb the career ladder quickly.

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In bank call centers, just like in call centers in all other sectors, it is checked how many customers are answered during the working hours and whether the problems of the customers are resolved. The success of call center officials is also evaluated at this rate. For this reason, it is very important to use time effectively and to adopt a solution-oriented working style. People who adopt this way of working can make progress in the positions in the call center unit over time.

Our vision:





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WTHINGS TO KNOW

ABOUT NEW CORONAVIRUS

All necessary measures are taken for the **coronavirus** revealed in Turkey and the World at **istanbul Gelisim University. Things to know about coronavirus are as follows:**

What are the new coronavirus symptoms?

- The most common symptoms are fever, cough and respiratory distress.
- In severe cases, pneumonia, severe respiratory failure, kidney failure and death may occur
- Incubation period is between 2 and 14 days.

How is the virus transmitted?

It can be transmitted by the contact of the droplets caused by coughing and sneezing with the contact of the mouth, nose and eyes of other individuals in certain environment and by touching the surfaces where the droplets adhere and taking hands into the mouth, nose or eyes.

What to do to be protected from the virus?

When **coughing or sneezing**, the mouth and nose should be covered with a **disposable tissue**, if there is no handkerchief, the mouth should be closed with the **upper sleeve or elbow**, not with the palms.

- Handshaking and hugging should be avoided.
- Mouth, nose and eyes should not be touched with dirty hands.

Hands must be washed for **at least 20 seconds** in accordance with the **Handwashing Instructions** found in the toilets. In the absence of water and soap, **alcohol-containing hand antiseptics** should be used. **Cologne of 70-80 degrees** also serve as disinfectants.

Offices and classrooms must be ventilated hourly.

Places frequently used by many people such as common areas and door handles should be disinfected every 2 hours.

Hands must be washed after using public transportation.

Because the virus progresses faster in people with low immune system; a balanced and healthy diet is required. Foods must be washed thoroughly before consumption.

What to do if there are symptoms?

- If you have come from countries with infections in the past 14 days, apply to the nearest healthcare facility by wearing a surgical mask.
- If you are **coughing, have a fever and have difficulty at breathing**, apply to the **nearest healthcare facility** by wearing **a surgical mask**.
- Always wear your mask when you are in the same room with a person who is recommended insulation at home.
