
NEWS FROM IGU

Departments of Aircraft Maintenance and Repair and Avionics Passed the DGCA Inspection Successfully!

Aircraft Maintenance and Repair and Avionics departments of the Faculty of Applied Sciences within the body of Istanbul Gelisim University successfully passed the inspection of the General Directorate of Civil Aviation.

FoAS Aircraft Maintenance and Repair Department started education and training under the name Aircraft Body and Engine Maintenance in the 2016-2017 academic year. Since the 2019-2020 academic year, it has been continuing its education and training under the name of Aircraft Maintenance and Repair. They applied for the SHT-147 Recognized School Status to the General Directorate of Civil Aviation and they were entitled to receive the SHT-147 Recognized School Status in the "Al Turbine Aircraft" category on 25.04.2018.

FoAS Avionics Department applied to the General Directorate of Civil Aviation for SHT-147 Recognized School Status and was entitled to receive SHT-147 Recognized School Status in the "B2 Avionics" category on 09.04.2021.

Within this framework, Aircraft Maintenance and Repair Department and Avionics Department of our faculty were subject to inspection by the General Directorate of Civil Aviation between 12.04.2023 and 14.04.2023. Our departments, which have successfully passed the inspection process carried out by SHGM, are entitled to maintain the validity of the SHT-147 Recognized School Status.

In addition, during this inspection process, controls were made regarding the follow-up and operation of the process related to the "B1.1 Turbine Airplanes" category application made by our Aircraft Maintenance and Repair Department to the General Directorate of Civil Aviation in the 2022-2023 academic year, and the controls regarding the existing infrastructure and equipment were positive. In this context, the process is currently ongoing.

103RD ANNIVERSARY OF THE OPENING OF THE GRAND NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF TÜRKİYE...

This year, the 103rd anniversary of the opening of the Grand National Assembly of Türkiye, which constitutes the cornerstones of the Republic of Türkiye, was celebrated.

The 17-month period between October 30, 1918 -April 23, 1920, which is the period between the Armistice of Mudros and the opening of the Turkish Grand National Assembly, is called the "Congress Period". During this process, the Amasya Circular (18-22 June 1922) was published, respectively, and important decisions were taken, such as the Erzurum Congress and the Sivas Congress, where the foundations of the Turkish Grand National Assembly were laid.

Seeing the problematic environment in Istanbul, Mustafa Kemal Pasha immediately started his activities in Anatolia for political liberation and published the Amasya Circular on 22 June 1919. In the Amasya Circular, which is one of the important turning points of the Turkish National Struggle, the principles of the National Struggle were prepared as a protocol for the first time and signed by the leaders of the National Struggle, who promised to cooperate to ensure the independence and territorial integrity of the Turkish homeland.

The first place of application of the decisions taken in the Amasya Circular was the Erzurum Congress. At the end of the congress, Mustafa Kemal Pasha was elected as the chairman of the committee by forming a Representative Committee in accordance with the statute. The duty of this committee was to represent the eastern provinces in the congress to be held in Sivas, as well as to represent the National Struggle inside and outside. In addition, the Representative Committee worked almost like a government until the Turkish Grand National Assembly to be opened in Ankara.

Thousands of people gathered around the building in Ankara Ulus on April 23, 1920, eagerly awaiting the opening of the Turkish Grand National Assembly. Mustafa Kemal Pasha described the meeting of the Grand National Assembly in his Nutuk as follows:

"Gentlemans, we will come across such events on a larger scale from now on. ...I was in a hurry to open the Assembly for this reason, finally, we decided to open the Assembly on Friday, the 23rd of April, being content with the deputies who were able to come."

The Assembly, which opened with an enthsiastic ceremony after the Friday prayer at the Hacı Bayram-ı Veli Mosque, held its first meeting with 115 representatives. After the opening speech of Retired National Education Director Sinop Deputy Şerif (Avkan), born in 1845, who assumed the temporary presidency as the oldest member at 13.45, Ankara Deputy Mustafa Kemal Pasha took the floor and made the following statement:

"It is in his high knowledge that your Supreme Council is composed of venerable deputies who were re-elected with extraordinary powers, and venerable deputies who came here to save their lives from the attacked Sultanate Center. The establishment of a supreme assembly with the deputies who could come and save them was only in question in the newly adopted election method. At this time, our council is in a meeting. I think this would be appropriate since even the previously elected deputies to serve with the same degree of authority is more comprehensive than the method of electing deputies (ie re-election). I would like to point out this subject (appropriate voices)" (Parliament Minutes, p.2, date: 23 April 1920).

Continuing his speech after this oral proposal was approved, Mustafa Kemal Pasha suggested the establishment of commissions to examine the election minutes of the deputies. This proposal was accepted and the Minutes Review Committee was formed. These commissions were established by reading aloud the names drawn from a bag (TBMM Official Report Gazette, 23 April 1920) as cited in Erdem, 2021).

In the second meeting of the Assembly held on April 24, 1920, Mustafa Kemal Pasha, who was unanimously elected as the Speaker of the Assembly, made a longer and more meaningful speech, emphasizing the importance of the Assembly with the words "There is no power above the Supreme Assembly any longer."

The War of Independence resulted in victory as a result of the successful administration of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk and the important decisions taken in the First Grand National Assembly. Moreover; On January 20, 1921, the first Constitution of the Republic of Turkey, the Organization Act, the Turkish National Anthem on March 12, 1921, and the Abolition of the Sultanate on November 1, 1922 were adopted in this Assembly. On the other hand, the resolutions of the Lausanne Peace Treaty on July 24, 1923, the Capitalization of Ankara on October 13, 1923, and the Declaration of the Republic on October 29, 1923 were also taken under the roof of this Assembly; Also, Gazi Mustafa Kemal Pasha was elected President in this Assembly.



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Chief Erkan Kıyıcıoğlu:

"Even if you are a very talented chef, you should not stop working to improve yourself, getting new training and doing research..."

Thank you for accepting our FoAS Monthly E-Bulletin interview request. Can you tell us about your introduction to the field of gastronomy and your process of becoming a chef?

I took the first step into cooking when I started my education at Bolu Mengen Anatolian Culinary High School in 1988. In 1993 and 1994, I gained my first sector experience with my school internships. After graduating in 1995, I worked in the sector for 1.5 years and then I completed my education in Gazi University, **Department of Family Economy and Nutrition** Education in 1996-2001. Then, I was appointed as a Food and Beverage Services teacher. During my university years and teaching period, I carried out personnel training, menu development, architectural analysis and concept consultancy of many restaurants.



How should the master-apprentice relationship be in the kitchen?

Knowledge and skill development in the kitchen progresses in parallel with the process. The more you cook a dish, the more skillful you become. Therefore, it is a part of this training that you benefit from the experience of a master who has cooked the dishes prepared in a business much more than you do, and that you apprentice him. How well the work (food) is done here and the knowledge, talent and vision of the master offer the apprentices much more chance to learn. However, in some businesses and masters, this can also cause unbearable bad experiences. Although there are no harsh environments like in the first years of my career; Hierarchy in the kitchen, work environment and order in the workflow is a very important part of the work environment.



For this reason, it is the first duty of an apprentice to fulfill the tasks given by the master in a timely and correct manner. His next task is to transfer what he has learned to the new apprentices correctly. In addition, correct communication, respect and morality are the most important criteria that should be between the master and the apprentice.

Is gastronomy a job of talent? Or can it be learned through training?

It would not be wrong to say that chefs who have been highly successful in the field of gastronomy are also very talented chefs. But there are many different business lines in the field of gastronomy. There are also many sub-sections in the kitchen. There are millions of different dishes in the world and it is not possible for even the most talented chef to know and cook them all. But even in a less skilled employee, you can train a staff who is very expert in one subject. A cook can only be a doner. He can continue his working life by preparing döner for a lifetime without even needing to know how to cook soup. One person can only be a griller, and one person can only be a fryer at a fryer. These sub-unit tasks can be easily taught over time even to people who do not have the skills. But if you want to be an excellent, creative, exemplary chef; should be talented and should focus on studies that will improve your skills in many areas. Even if you are a very talented chef, you should not stop working to improve yourself, getting new training and doing research.

What roles do our chefs and chef candidates have in promoting the use of local and geographically marked products in restaurants?

Geographically indicated foods need to be known first. The correct entry of geographically indicated foods into the supply chain in our country and the increase in their use will increase the preference of these products by our chefs. We have many food products and local delicacies that have received geographical indications. Our chefs should taste these dishes in their own geography and try to learn the cooking tricks from those masters. At least, they should visit https://ci.turkpatent.gov.tr/ while preparing the regional dishes with geographical indications and examine the patent documents of these dishes and search for the patent criteria related to the dishes. Correct recipe and use of ingredients is important to preserve the taste and standards of these dishes.



How important is gastronomy tourism in Turkey? Which of our regional cuisines stand out more in the field of gastronomy?

Turkey is rich in gastronomy tourism due to its geographical location, being home to many civilizations in the past, being on trade routes, preserving and keeping rich cultural values alive. But he does not say that he sees the value he deserves. In recent years, it can be said that tourist perception and knowledge of Anatolian culinary culture has gradually increased. However, some of our provinces (Hatay, Gaziantep, Afyonkarahisar) develop themselves in the field of gastronomy as members of the UNESCO creative cities network and host more and more local and foreign tourists, the number of which is increasing day by day. The food culture and recognition of the country they will visit in the destination choices of domestic and foreign tourists are gaining more and more importance. For this reason, we should develop and promote our cuisines in classical and modern ways (specific to the region).

Among our prominent regional cuisines, the Southeastern Anatolian regional cuisine takes the first place. But each region has its own unique flavors. I think that especially Aegean cuisine and then the Marmara region (with Ottoman cuisine, palace cuisines) and Central Anatolia cuisine (with historical Anatolian civilizations) will gain more value over time.

What are the job opportunities for students of the Department of Gastronomy and newly graduated chef candidates? What would you recommend to our students in this process?

The sector has become more attractive in terms of job opportunities after the pandemic and has increased job opportunities. Our students, especially those who have developed themselves in foreign languages, have the opportunity to work all over the world. With the accreditation opportunities of the diplomas they have received from our university, they can also have the opportunity to work in European Union countries.





It should not be forgotten that the culinary profession requires practical skills. Students who improve their skills as they work can progress much faster in the sector. There is a lot to be learned from every business and every master, but; the true business, a good master contributes more to your professional development and you can be much more successful in the sector with the vision it brings to you. Doing their compulsory internship during the summer break of the 2nd academic year during the university education period allows them to have the opportunity to work for a fee during the summer vacation next year.

The social and professional network you will gain with good communication will increase your success. Keeping in touch with your friends will benefit your development together.

During this time, she worked part-time as a lecturer in the Cookery program of Arel University and as a trainer chef at Istanbul Culinary Institute.

Various restaurants and food businesses; he provided consultancy on menu development, quality management, opening menu and personnel training.

Establishing a Concentric Center with the Logistics Industry! Experiencing the University of Klaipeda with Erasmus+

Hello, I am Asst. Prof. Dr. Onur Türker from Istanbul Gelisim University Electronic Commerce and Management Department. In this part of the FoAS Monthly E-Bulletin, I would like to share my visit to Klaipeda State University in Klaipeda, Lithuania as part of Erasmus+ staff training mobility and the experiences I gained there.

When I arrived at Klaipeda University, we had a conversation with the dean of the faculty about both Erasmus+ mobility and the university; he talked about the university opportunities, the projects of the university and the opportunities of the students of the Logistics Department. The simulation laboratory, which not only the students of the Logistics Department, but also all departments at the university started to use during the pandemic period and still continues to use, and which carries the education-teaching habits to an innovative place, was remarkable.

Since Klaipeda is one of the port cities on the Baltic Sea, the Logistics Department carries out some activities in this port. One of them was the application developed by the Logistics Department, which tracks all the goods leaving the port of Klaipeda to the port of destination.



Thanks to Erasmus+ mobility, I expanded the boundaries of the story of my academy journey by seeing one of the cities related to logistics, one of my areas of expertise. In this context, I recommend that those who want to gain experience abroad by taking advantage of mobility-staff, academics, students-prefer countries that can touch their lives.


Concert: Brazzavile (May 5, 2023)



The Third Wave (1980), Alvin Toffler

The cold war was still going on when Alvin Toffler wrote this book in 1980. Information Technologies was a privilege available only to those who had access to centralized computing and mainframe computers. Despite all this, the author, as a futurologist in the true sense of the word, makes correct predictions about the transformations brought about by the evolution of DARPA-NET, BIT-NET and INTERNET. These projections do not only address technological transformations. The predictions about the business world, social life, politics and institutionalization almost describe the concepts listed in a Management Information Systems book written at the beginning of the 21st century, without giving their names.



Alvin Toffler, in this book, explains the three main formations of the development journey of humanity, which has settled down, in the term wave. It depicts the first wave agricultural civilization. The second wave, on the other hand, is the basis of the Industrial Revolution and the civilization after it, where the use of controllable high-level energy has become widespread. The third wave, on the other hand, deals with the impact of information technologies at all levels, which enable the acquisition, processing, sending or dissemination of information (information/information). For example, while products or services in production and consumption were in a similar situation in the first and second waves, there was a great change in the third wave.

The effect of the third wave, especially the widespread use of computers, integration with phones, and the fact that data can be accessed and sent from anywhere and at any time with a great speed and size, ultimately leads to a paradigmatic change in every aspect of life. Distance learning, internet banking, listening to TV, videos, music wherever and whenever we want, accessing lecture notes and accessing all kinds of informatics show the paradigm shift in our lives as described in the book.

For example, the book predicted that the need for literacy would decrease in 1980 and that minorities would have power. We can see this situation nowadays with the use of emoji and the requirements to accept the wishes of relatively small communities to cross the balance point in certain choices.



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
