


The Book Chapter Titled "Building Trust with Public Relations Studies in the Post-Truth Age: Examples and Evaluations" Was Published

It is the culture that makes the society a society. The culture formed within the framework of customs, traditions and traditions constitutes the basic values of the society. Art and artistic values are an important part of this culture. In this context, it is important to commemorate and keep alive those who have contributed to social values.

In our country, 2023 will be celebrated as the year of Aşık Veysel by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). Aşık Veysel, who made the art of minstrel popular all over Turkey and was recorded on the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity Representative List in 2009, will be remembered all over the world and in Turkey in relation to UNESCO in 2023, the 50th Anniversary of his death.

Aşık Veysel, one of the most important representatives of the minstrel tradition, is a folk poet who has an important place in the social structure with his life and works. In his works, which he put forward in plain Turkish, he presented precious verses to future generations on the joy of life, love of nature and people, friendship, unity and togetherness, as well as sadness. He influenced every part of the society with his words representing the people, describing the unchanging journey of culture from the past to the present.

The lands we live in are the cradle of traditional culture and universal past culture. Aşık Veysel has become a symbol of the culture that reaches from the past to the future. Cultural symbols aim to ensure the continuation of the society's values and the transfer of these values to future generations.

Walter Ong divides humanity into two cultural levels. Oral culture and written culture form the basis of human history. Oral culture includes the representation and basis of myths, legends, and all the elements that make the social social. Aşık Veysel, who was raised in the tradition of oral culture and fed from folk culture, is one of the cornerstones of our rich cultural heritage dating back centuries.

AŞIK VEYSEL

The master poet, known as Aşık Veysel and whose real name is Veysel Şatıroğlu, was born on October 25, 1894 in Sivas. Veysel, who got smallpox at the age of seven, lost both of his eyes due to this disease. With the encouragement of his father, he started playing the saz and singing poetry at the age of 10.

The poems of Aşık Veysel, who also worked as an instrument teacher in Village Institutes for a while, were collected in his books titled Sayings (1944), Voices from My Instrument (1950) and Friends Remember Me (1970). The great folk poet Aşık Veysel died in 1973 in the village of Sivrialan, where he was born.







ASST. PROF. DR. OĞUZ YILDIZ: ALUMNI AND MEMBERS COORDINATOR
OF ISTANBUL GELISIM UNIVERSITY

Dear Asst. Prof. Dr. Oğuz Yıldız, first of all, thank you for accepting our interview. Could you tell us about the work of Gelisim University Alumni and Members Coordinatorship?

Members Coordinatorship Alumni and established in 2021 and became operational. Our main goal is to establish an organic bond with our graduates, to cooperate and to contribute to their development by believing that we are with them even after they graduate. The ultimate goal of our coordinatorship is to gather students, employees and graduates under the umbrella of an association and turn them into a self-progressing NGO. Our coordinatorship works with Career Development Center experts on issues such as creating employment by establishing relationships with external stakeholders, preparing CVs, career counseling and using LinkedIn. It also cooperates with faculties and vocational schools and graduate education institutes to bring together graduates from different departments. With the assistant coordinator, efforts are being made to expand our team, which is currently compact, in the coming days. One of the projects that our coordination attaches importance to is the Alumni Tracking System (Metsis). Our coordinatorship mediates the sharing of job postings through the system by direct making agreements with external stakeholders.





What kind of activities can our graduates and members benefit from if they become members of the Alumni Tracking System (METSIS)?

METSIS is a job search platform that matches the qualifications of job seekers with those sought by employers. It was opened to determine the current status of our graduates such as employment and post-graduate education. Our graduates who are METSIS members can update their personal profiles, follow our job postings and apply for open positions. For example, after the negotiations with IGA, an agreement was reached on the sharing of advertisements.

Dear Yıldız, How does the work of the Alumni and Members Coordinatorship contribute to our graduates and members?


Basically, our coordinatorship offers employment opportunities to our graduates through cooperation with external stakeholders. Again, special advantages are provided to our graduates and members through external stakeholder agreements. For example, within the framework of cooperation with the Fitstation business, where our graduate is the manager, our graduates are offered employment and discount opportunities in fitness branches. In addition, our coordinatorship organizes many events in cooperation with the Career Development Center to bring our graduates together. Thus, bringing our alumni and current students together with various activities provides both alumni-student communication and the opportunity to meet with managers and employees in the sector. Most recently, a 360° Logistics event was held with the top managers of the import units of UPS Cargo, MNG Air Cargo, Ant Logistics, BASF, Johnson&Johnson and Nike. Finally, different training programs are organized by our experts in order to improve the skills of our graduates in preparing a CV and writing a motivation letter.


Dear Yıldız, why should our IGU graduate communicate with the Alumni and Members Coordinator?

"I, Robot" - Isaac Asimov

Science fiction is one of the most complex literary genres, if not the most distinguished by nature. On the other hand, we see that it is far from the respect it deserves among literary genres. Undoubtedly, the most important reason for this is the hegemony of today's inconsistent and populist science fiction novels in terms of quantity, which ignores the "science" aspect of the work and focuses entirely on the "fiction" side. On top of that, when fantastic movies produced by Hollywood, on which the science fiction label is attached, are added, it becomes inevitable to create an atmosphere of confusion and distrust about the genre.




Apart from their counterparts, Asimov's works, like real science fiction examples, are always based on logical assumptions and stay away from frivolity. The Foundation Series, in which the book "I, Robot" spawned, also makes significant contributions to the field of science fiction. The "Three Robot Laws", which is one of these contributions and used in various ways by many authors in the field, appears in this book as a concept introduced by Asimov and laid the foundations of all robot terminology in the field of science fiction.

"I, Robot", which includes 9 different robot stories, introduces the Three Robot Laws in order and allows the reader to digest it. However, by opening windows to the continuation of the story, the entrance also fulfills the task of being the first link of the universe. Regardless of the corpus that followed, "I, Robot" manages to take its place in the genre of science fiction alone, reaching its classic position as a well-founded and visionary work.

This story, which is one of the most original works of modern Turkish literature, is positioned right on the line between reality and fantasy, creating moments that are sometimes too real to be true and sometimes too real to be imagined. It is one of the most successful works of the magical realism movement in the field of literature, not only in our country but also all over the world.



On Fertile Lands - Orhan Kemal

It is an astonishing and powerful work that does not hesitate to shake the reader with the unusualness of the situations and characters that are occasionally presented to the reader, as well as offering the opportunity to meet the unfamiliar or ignored reality of Anatolian and Turkish people.



A Bite-Sized History of France - Stephane Henaut, Jeni Mitchell
