

PAY ATTENTION TO THE THUMBSUCKING HABIT IN CHILDREN!

As in any treatment, early diagnosis is of great importance in orthodontic treatment. Dentist Asst. Prof. Dr. Hatice Kübra Olkun mentioned that orthodontic treatment used to correct dental disorders must be done at an early age and habits such as thumbsucking cause orthodontic problems.

“MOST ORTHODONTIC PROBLEMS BEGIN IN EARLY CHILDHOOD”

A beautiful smile and aesthetically aligned teeth are the dreams of many. It is very important to start orthodontic treatment at an early age, which is used to correct dental disorders. Stating that if neglected, it may cause bigger problems in the future, Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU), Faculty of Dentistry, Dentist Hatice Kübra Olkun: “Most of the orthodontic problems we see in advanced ages start in early childhood and become increasingly severe. Orthodontic examination, which is carried out regularly every year from the age of 6, ensures that potential orthodontic problems are noticed and some precautions are taken. In cases such as early loss of milk teeth, caries, congenital permanent tooth deficiencies, bad habits such as thumb sucking and lower jaw prolapse due to genetic factors, starting treatment at an early age with removable or fixed appliances prevents the occurrence of bigger problems in the future.

“IT CAN CAUSE DETERIORATION OF THE FACIAL STRUCTURE”

While orthodontic disorders do not make children feel good psychologically, they also cause them to have difficulties in eating, drinking and speaking. Emphasizing that it should not be neglected, Olkun also added the following: “Problems related to the ear, nose and throat can also cause mouth breathing in children in the early stages, and accordingly upper jaw narrowing and deterioration of the facial structure. Early orthodontic treatment should not be neglected in order for children to have a balanced face and jaw structure and healthy teeth. Awareness must be raised in our society on this issue and families must be informed.”

The 14th term graduation ceremony started with the opening speeches of Istanbul Gelisim University Chairman of the Board of Trustees Abdülkadir Gayretli and Rector Prof. Dr. Bahri Şahin. Stating that they always stand by their graduates as the IGU family, Istanbul Gelisim University Board of Trustees Chairman Abdülkadir Gayretli said: “We want our students and graduates to be within universal values and become world people. CONVERSATION TITLED “JULY 15 COUP ATTEMPT WITH DIFFERENT ASPECTS” WAS HELD

Organized by the Faculty of Economics, Administrative and Social Sciences, the conversation titled "July 15 Coup Attempt with Different Aspects" was moderated by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fatih Fuat Tuncer from the Department of Political Science and International Relations, with the participation of Prof. Dr. Şenol Durgun from the Department of Political Science and Public Administration.

In the conversation held at Mehmet Akif Ersoy Conference Hall on July 18, 2023, the July 15 Coup Attempt was evaluated comparatively with the coup and coup attempts in the history of the Republic. Prof. Dr. Şenol Durgun stated that the interim periods encountered throughout the Republic started with the May 27, 1960 Coup, then there were coups or coup attempts almost every 10 years. This situation interfered with the functioning of Turkey's democratic politics and caused a break in democracy.

Prof. Dr. Durgun stated: "We can classify the interventions as 'Successful coups-unsuccessful coup attempts', 'Coup or coup attempts made or attempted to be carried out within the chain of command' and 'Coup or coup attempts not made within the chain of command'.

"WE CAN DESCRIBE THE JULY 15 COUP ATTEMPT AS A BLOODY ATTEMPT, EVEN AN INVASION OPERATION"

Prof. Dr. Durgun: "When we make a comparison in terms of the attitudes of the media, the judiciary, political parties and the public against the coup and coup attempts, we see that the July 15 Coup Attempt is very different from the coup and coup attempts experienced so far in terms of structure, staff and action. In particular, we can describe the July 15 Coup Attempt as a bloody attempt, even an invasion operation."

Prof. Dr. Durgun emphasized that, unlike previous coups, the initiative of the July 15 Coup Attempt was implemented by a group that took orders from outside the army, not inside the army institution.

Finally, Prof. Dr. Durgun finished his speech by referring to the attitude of the public. He concluded his speech by stating that the people claimed their own law with the July 15th Coup Attempt, that this attitude is important for the level of Turkish democracy and that those who will attempt such a coup from now on will not be able to ignore this attitude of the public.

GELİSİM TRADE CENTER IS OPENED!

Gelisim Trade Center, which is the application laboratory for the students of the Banking and Insurance Department and the Department of Business Administration, to be used together by the Faculty of Applied Sciences and the Faculty of Economics, Administrative and Social Sciences, opened on July 18, 2023.

Faculty of Applied Sciences Dean Prof. Dr. Kamil Kaya and Faculty of Economics, Administrative and Social Sciences Dean Prof. Dr. Kenan Aydın thanked everyone who contributed to the acquisition of Gelisim Trade Center, especially Chairman of the Board of Trustees Abdülkadir Gayretli and Şule Gayretli. Dean Prof. Dr. Kamil Kaya underlined that the understanding of gaining sectoral practices, which is a requirement of the Applied Sciences Education approach, will continue by being developed in every field.
