Istanbul Gelisim University held a "Bilateral Cooperation Protocol Signing Ceremony" with 3 reputable universities in Malaysia. Malaysian Minister of Higher Education H.E. Dato' Seri Mohamed Khaled bin Nordin and Malaysian Consul General in Istanbul Tengku Mohd Dzaraif Bin Raja Abdul Kadir attended the ceremony.

"Bilateral Cooperation Protocol Signature Ceremony" was held between University Malaya, University Sains Malaysia and University Teknologi Malaysia and Istanbul Gelisim University, which are 3 reputable universities in Malaysia included in the list announced by the UK-based higher education rating agency QS (Quacquarelli Symond). In the "Global University Ranking: Europe 2024" published by QS, IGU, which is the best 432nd university in Europe, achieved a significant success by ranking 13th in Turkey. IGU, which is frequently mentioned on international platforms, added another one to its bilateral cooperation at the ceremony held with the participation of Malaysian Minister of Higher Education H.E. Dato' Seri Mohamed Khaled bin Nordin, Malaysian Consul General in Istanbul Tengku Mohd Dzaraif Bin Raja Abdul Kadir. Referring to the history of the establishment of IGU, Abdulkadir Gayretli, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of IGU, talked about the achievements of the university; Prof. Dr. Bahri Sahin, the Rector of IGU, stated that they were pleased to host Malaysia's Minister of Higher Education and respected universities at IGU.

## ISTANBUL GELISIM UNIVERSITY HAS BEEN AWARDED THE "SHT-147 B1.1 APPROVAL CERTIFICATE"!

Istanbul Gelisim University Faculty of Applied Sciences has been entitled to receive the "SHT-147 Maintenance Training and Examination Organization Approval Certificate".

Istanbul Gelisim University Faculty of Applied Sciences Aircraft Maintenance and Repair Department students will start to receive aircraft maintenance training as of the 2023-2024 Academic Year with the authorization of B1.1 (Turbine Engine Aircraft) approved by the General Directorate of Civil Aviation. Graduated students who successfully complete their education will be able to benefit from various privileges in their job applications by having the "Recognized School" graduation certificate. In addition, they will have a great advantage in the relevant SHT-66 module exam exemptions and experience requirement criteria in the recruitment of aircraft maintenance personnel in need of intensive employment.

Since 2018-2019, Istanbul Gelisim University Faculty of Applied Sciences has been providing accreditation and standards-based trainings on the training of civil aviation approved human resources in A1 (Turbine Engine Aircraft) -B2 (Avionics) categories.

### **TUBITAK SUPPORT FOR 43 PROJECTS OF IGU STUDENTS**

Within the scope of the 2209-A University Students Research Projects Support Program conducted by the TUBITAK Scientist Support Programs Presidency, 43 projects of Istanbul Gelisim University students were eligible for support.

Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) advances with the vision of "Research University" and enables its students to work in scientific, technological, research and development. According to the results of the call for the 2209-A University Students Research Projects Support Program 2023/1st term, conducted by the TUBITAK









Directorate of Scientist Support Programs (BIDEB), 43 projects of IGU students were eligible for support.

### FACULTIES ELIGIBLE FOR SUPPORT

The program aims to encourage undergraduate and associate degree students studying at universities to conduct research through projects. In the program where the projects developed by faculty members and students are supported, Istanbul Gelisim University's;

- 18 projects from the Faculty of Health Sciences
- 8 projects from the Faculty of Fine Arts
- 6 projects from Istanbul Gelisim Vocational School
- 5 projects from the Faculty of Applied Sciences
- 2 projects from Vocational School of Health Services
- 2 projects from the Faculty of Economics, Administrative and Social Sciences
- 1 project from the School of Physical Education and Sports
- 1 project from the Faculty of Engineering and Architecture and a total of 43 projects developed by students and academicians were eligible for being supported by TUBITAK.
