NEWS FROM IGU

“GreenMetric 2023” Success from IGU, which stands out with its Sustainability Studies!

The "GreenMetric World University Rankings 2023" list has been announced. Istanbul Gelişim University (IGU), which was included in the GreenMetric rankings for the first time last year, was ranked 14th among Turkish foundation universities in the GreenMetric 2023 list this year. Drawing attention with its important work in the field of environmental sustainability, IGU has proven its success once again.

The list of "UI GreenMetric World University Rankings 2023", which was founded in Indonesia in 2010 and works on green campus and environmental sustainability, has been announced. GreenMetric aims to raise global awareness about environmental awareness; It evaluates the sustainability efforts of universities according to 6 criteria: campus settlement and infrastructure, energy and climate change, waste, water resources, transportation, education and research. Istanbul Gelişim University (IGU), which was included in the GreenMetric rankings for the first time last year, increased its score by 935 points in 2023 and ranked 674th in the world with a total of 5635 points. While it ranks 58th among all universities in Turkey, jumping 7 places compared to last year, in the total score where 6 criteria are taken into account; Istanbul Gelişim University, one of the most preferred foundation universities in Turkey, stood out among foundation universities in the GreenMetric 2023 ranking. IGU ranked 14th among foundation universities, rising 23 places from 37th place.

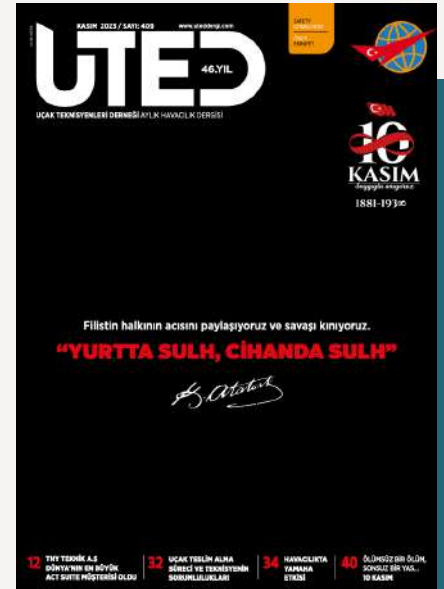
Asst. Prof. Dr. Rıza Haluk KUL Participated in the "World Civil Aviation Day, Pulse of High Altitude" Event!

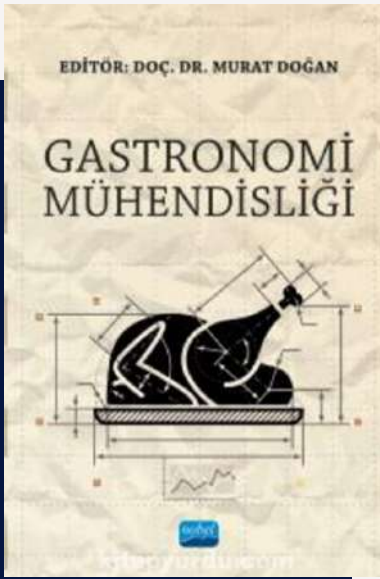

Metamorphosis - Franz Kafka

The book the Metamorphosis has a unique place in the world of literature. Franz Kafka's book The Metamorphosis, published in 1915, is a work in which Kafka reached the peak of his narrative art. The story, which is about the life of Gregor Samsa, who found himself transformed into an insect due to an existential questioning, can be considered the author's best-known work. The word Change instead of Transformation is also used for the title of the book.

The Metamorphosis, which consists of three chapters in total, describes the events from the transformation of marketer Gregor Samsa into an insect until his death. When the book is classified, it is seen that Gregor Samsa comes out of his room at the end of each three chapters. In the first chapter, when Gregor Samsa wakes up, he realizes that he has turned into an insect in his bed. He thinks that this situation is temporary and imagines that he will return to his old self again. The second part begins with Gregor Samsa waking up after fainting. The reason for this fainting is the powerful kick his father gave to Gregor Samsa, who came out of his room in the first episode, to get him back into his room. The third part consists of the events until the death of Gregor Samsa, who was seriously injured when one of the thrown apples buried itself in his back.

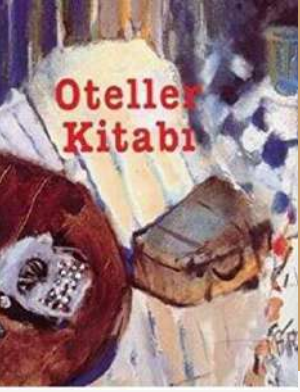


The father, who also has an important place in Franz Kafka's normal life, is criticized very severely in the book. In the book, it is emphasized that father Samsa is the person who uses Gregor the most financially. After Gregor turned into an insect, father Samsa was disturbed and the burden fell on his own shoulders. That's why he's angry at his son. In fact, the fact that he kicked him and then threw the apple that caused his son's death is an indication of his lethal personality.

This book examines very carefully the family ties that have become corrupt in petty bourgeois circles. The contradictions between the individual and society that cause social exclusion have been tried to be revealed by analyzing the words of the heroes of the novel. Although at first the transformation in the book The Transformation is perceived as only Gregor turning into an insect, it is seen that the family members also undergo a transformation in the later parts of the book.

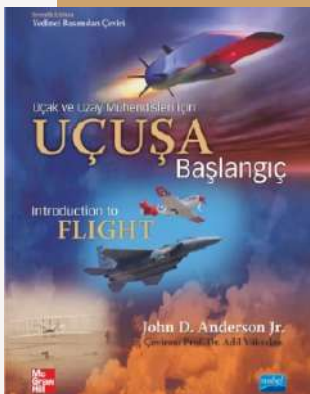
Book of Hotels - Ferhan ŞENSOY

The book examines union movements in three chapters. In the first chapter, the short history of the Turkish working class is mentioned and class struggles in the mining sector are examined. In the second part, Underground Maden-İş Union was examined from different points of view and the union understanding was revealed. In the third chapter, union organization in Yeni Çeltek was examined.



Introduction to Flight - John. D: Anderson Jr. - (Çeviren: Prof. Dr. Adil YÜKSELEN)

There are almost no Turkish sources on aviation. Therefore, it is very important that this book be presented in Turkish. The Beginning Flight book has been carefully written with readers who are not trained in aviation in mind, including topics such as topic selection and organization, the order in which topics are presented, and how they are explained. 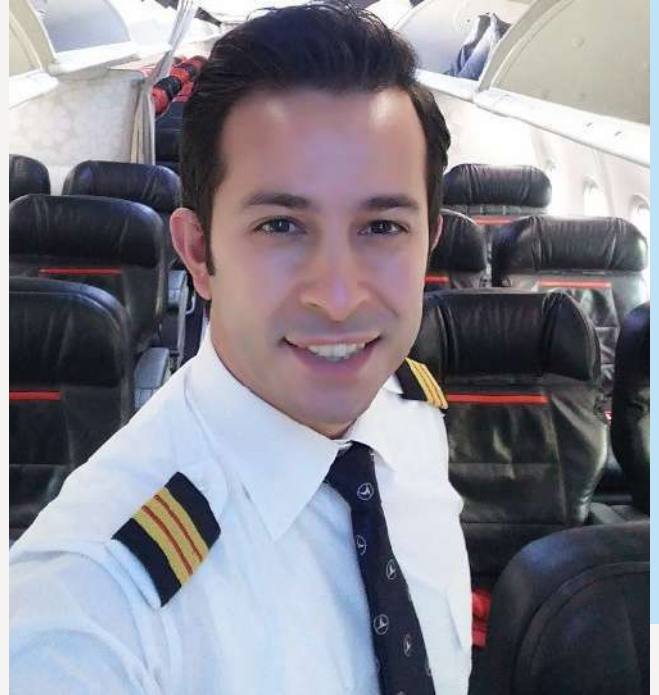
INTERVIEW

MUSTAFA ONUR ÖZDEMİR:

“My first and most important advice to students would be to constantly improve themselves. Our self-educated students are now getting jobs with very good income in our country, Europe, Middle Eastern countries and the Arabian peninsula.”

Dear Mr. Mustafa Onur Özdemir, thank you for accepting our UBF Monthly E-Bulletin interview request. Can you explain the process to those who want to become aircraft maintenance technicians?

First of all, it should be noted that the process is long and requires patience. School life, which will consist mostly of theoretical knowledge, where we will first learn the basics of aviation; Then, we blend business life with practical training and theoretical knowledge. We need to successfully complete type courses for different aircraft in order to operate the aircraft maintenance license we will receive after achieving appropriate maintenance experience and completing our module exams. Afterwards, after becoming an authorized B1-B2, we continue our business life with an endless learning life to become a self-confident aircraft maintenance technician.



INTERVIEW

What should be taken into consideration to become an aircraft maintenance technician?

Being careful is an essential rule of this business. Must be able to make quick decisions, have good time management, but be able to work quickly without endangering your own health, your friend or the plane. Another point is that no matter how much experience you have, it is important to be careful and carry out every job with the same care and attention.

Which chronic diseases prevent us from becoming aircraft maintenance technicians?

Orthopedic disorders, color blindness, hearing impairments, severe eye disorders, and musculoskeletal diseases may prevent you from becoming an aircraft maintenance technician. Even though your work life continues as a result of these illnesses that you may have later, your authority is restricted and the jobs you can work in are restricted. In addition, work accidents such as head injuries and falls from height are common in working life. Unfortunately, as a result of serious injuries, our colleagues may have to continue their work lives in other units.

Can aircraft maintenance technicians trained in Turkey work abroad?

In our country, the number of EASA licensed aircraft maintenance technicians is more than the number of DGCA licensed aircraft maintenance technicians. Nowadays, many of our friends who have improved their foreign language have gone abroad, especially England and Germany. This number is increasing exponentially every year. If you only have a Turkish Civil Aviation License, you cannot work as an authorized person in Europe with this license, but you will have the chance to continue as an authorized person in countries such as Qatar, Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates.

Aircraft maintenance technician is basically divided into two: mechanics and avionics. Can you tell our students about the advantages and disadvantages of these fields?

Our friends who will be B1 are always more sought after in the industry. If 10 B1s are required proportionally for C maintenance of an aircraft in the hangar environment, 2 or 3 B2s will be needed. While experts in the B1 field become more physically tired, B2 colleagues may become more mentally tired due to avionics tests and troubleshooting. While B1 experts work actively in areas such as mechanical and interior structural in all zones and systems, B2 experts are responsible for fewer departments and have more detailed knowledge and equipment.

INTERVIEW

How do you evaluate the aviation industry in Türkiye and the world? What advice would you give to our students?

After the COVID epidemic, the sector not only returned to its old days with incredible momentum in our country, as in the world, but also raised the bar even higher. My first and most important advice to students would be to constantly improve themselves. Our self-educated friends are now getting jobs with very good income in our country, Europe, Middle Eastern countries and the Arabian peninsula.

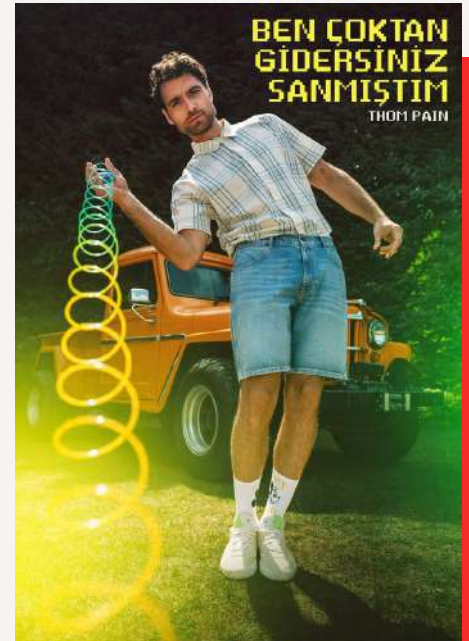

New Era in Internet Shopping: Consumer Will Pay the Return Shipping Fee!

A change has been made in the return process for online purchases. With the change that will start on January 1, 2025, the consumer will pay the shipping fee for the return of products purchased online. As online shopping has become more widespread in recent years, the return process has been changed as a result of the increasing return transactions at cargo branches causing problems. With the change that will start on January 1, 2025, the consumer will pay the shipping fee for the return of products purchased online. With the decision of the Ministry of Commerce on the 'Regulation on Amendments to the Distance Contracts Regulation', the consumer will be able to exercise his right of withdrawal regarding the product he purchased within 14 days from the delivery date. The consumer will be responsible for covering the return costs. If the product is defective, the consumer will not be held responsible for the costs of returning it. If the consumer requests, the return cost will be offset against the cost of the goods or services to be returned to him/her and the delivery costs.
