

The "Commemoration of Atatürk, the light that has not faded for 86 years" program was held at Istanbul Gelişim University!

Gazi Mustafa Kemal Atatürk was commemorated at IGU on the 86th anniversary of his passing. SÜRDÜRÜLEBİLİR KALKINMADA YEŞİL EKONOMİNİN ÖNEMİ

ÖZET

Yeşil ekonomi kavramı, Birleşmiş Milletler'in (BM) 1992 yılında Rio de Janeiro'da düzenlediği çevre ve kalkınma konferansında sürdürülebilir kalkınma kavramının resmen benimsenmesinden yaklaşık yirmi yıl sonra Rio+20'de resmen ortaya atıldı. Amaç, sürdürülemez ekonomik kalkınma ve çevresel bozulma ile ilgili sorunlarla başa çıkmaktı. 2008 mali krizinin ardından yeşil ekonomi, ekonomik tartışmalarda ana akıma girdi ve şu anda uluslararası örgütler ve hükümetler tarafından sürdürülebilir ekonomik kalkınmanın ilerlemesi için çağdaş kalkınma düşüncesinde bir paradigma değişimi olarak algılanmaktadır. Çünkü yeşil ekonomi, küresel krizin etkilerini hafifletme ve çevreyi iyileştirme rolünün yanı sıra, küresel yoksulluğu ortadan kaldırma ve sosyal ejitsizlikleri giderme aracı olarak da görülmektedir. Bu çalışmanın amacı, sürdürülebilirlik kavramı çerçevesinde yeşil ekonominin önemini vurgulamaktır. Bu kapsan dâhilinde çalışmada, yeşil ekonominin diğer çevre kavramı ile olan ilişkileri, yeşil ekonominin gelişim süreci, yeşil ekonomiye geçişin aşamaları, ilkeleri ve yeşil ekonomi dönüşümünün faydaları ele alınacaktır.



ERASMUS +

Hello, I am Ensar Macit, Research Assistant at the Department of English Translation and Interpreting.

In this section, I will share my visit to Düsseldorf, Germany within the scope of Erasmus+ Staff mobility and my experiences here.

Düsseldorf is located in the North Rhine-Westphalia region, which includes cities such as Cologne, Dortmund and Frankfurt. Therefore, before Düsseldorf, I had the opportunity to experience the historical texture, people and cultures of other cities. Germany is a country that suffered great destruction as a result of World War II, apart from cities such as Berlin and Hamburg. Despite the magnitude of this destruction in the Cologne and Düsseldorf area, I witnessed how Germany renewed itself not only economically but also architecturally with its post-war policies and built on top of it.



We attended the event organized by Smart Leap Education Research Consultancy within the scope of Erasmus+. A presentation was made at the event focusing on project management and project creation. Afterwards, we visited Heinrich Heine Düsseldorf University and met with the Erasmus+ coordinators there. In these meetings, they gave us information about Düsseldorf University, while we told them about Gelişim University and Erasmus+ opportunities. We exchanged ideas about the Erasmus+ agreement.

Düsseldorf and the North Rhine-Westphalia region in general are among the most developed regions of Germany, and therefore are among the preferred places for both staff and student Erasmus+ mobility. Since the school I mentioned also has an English Translation and Interpreting Department, I would also recommend our students to consider this place.

Artificial intelligence makes shopping possible even after death!

According to VML's "Future Shopper Report 2024", individuals will be able to shop after death thanks to artificial intelligence. While 47% of consumers are interested in this idea, this rate reaches 70% in countries such as India and the United Arab Emirates. National combat aircraft KAAN will take off again!

The 5th generation domestic fighter jet National Combat Aircraft KAAN, produced by the Turkish defense industry, is preparing to make its third flight by the end of this year. TUSAŞ General Manager Mehmet Demiroğlu stated that the flight date has not been finalized but they expect KAAN to take off again this year. Tests will be conducted for the P1 and P2 prototypes, which will start flying at the end of 2025, with a delivery target of 2028. In addition, the P4 and P5 prototypes are planned to be tested in 2026. It was stated that there is no delay in the project at the moment and that the work for the 2028 delivery is progressing as planned.
