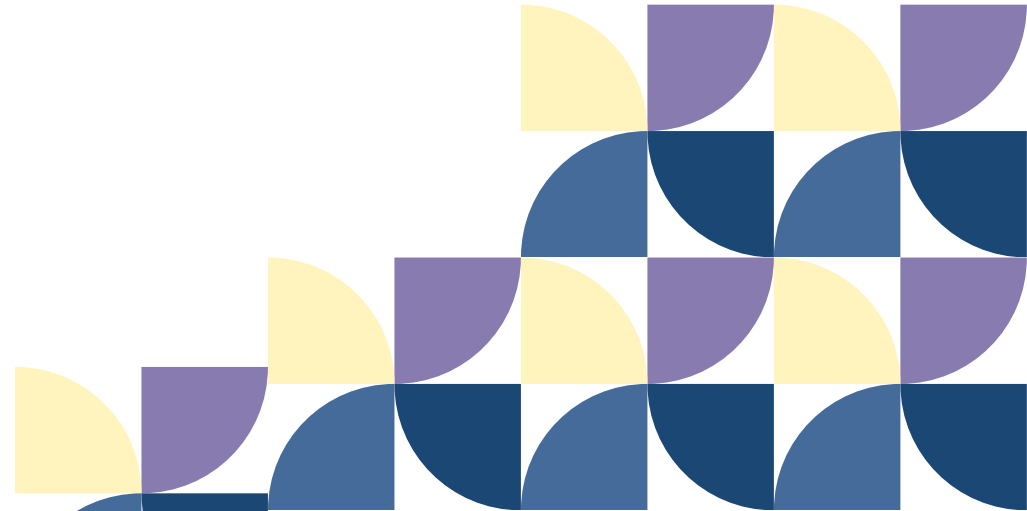

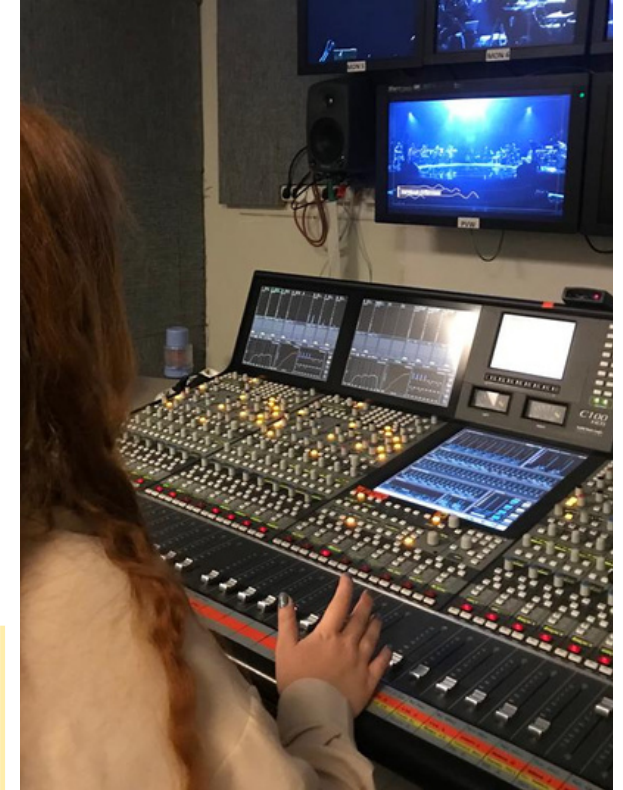


The Birthplace of the Real Filmmaker

Program and Curriculum Information

In order to graduate from Istanbul Gelişim University, Faculty of Fine Arts, Department of Radio, Television and Cinema, it is necessary to complete a total course load of 123 credits and 256 ECTS.

In the first two years, our students take the basic courses required to enter the field of art and design, which are taught jointly in all departments of the Faculty of Fine Arts. Starting from the third year, our students begin to take elective courses in addition to the compulsory courses required for this branch. Even though the Department of Radio, Television and Cinema has a curriculum focused mainly on cinema, it has a flexible structure that students can shape according to their own interests.

In this context, it provides interdisciplinary education with elective courses opened to the entire faculty. In addition, they can receive training on different subjects along with social elective courses aimed at strengthening the student's world view and gaining additional skills.

In the fourth year, our student, having decided on the field in which he will specialize, puts forward a graduation project in the light of all the information he has learned in four years, together with the Graduation Project course.

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The fundamental strength of our curriculum is its potential to change society and lead cultural transformation. We support brave and innovative students, encouraging them to explore their inner world and experience unlimited creativity.

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Department Accreditation

Istanbul Gelişim University, which attaches great importance to internationalization in education, offers education opportunities to its students and graduates with international accreditation and protocols signed with foreign universities.

IGU, which has made significant investments in its physical capacity, human resources and opportunities provided to its students in order to become a "Respected World University", started a very ambitious breakthrough process in 2017.

These studies started in 2017, and the Departments of the Faculty of Fine Arts were found suitable to be accredited by the AQAS organization, which is a member of the European Quality Assurance Association, and received their accreditation documents. Founded in Germany in 2002 and a member of the European Quality Assurance Association, AQAS is an organization that has evaluated more than 5000 programs around the world. It has accredited the educational programs of which more than 90 German universities are members. The accreditation it grants certifies that the accredited program complies with European standards and principles.

The Department of Radio, Television and Cinema is also an accredited program and its compliance with European standards is documented. The department is accredited until 2024.

Our academics, who are specialized in the sector and have in-depth knowledge in the fields of radio, television and cinema, offer our students a comprehensive education.

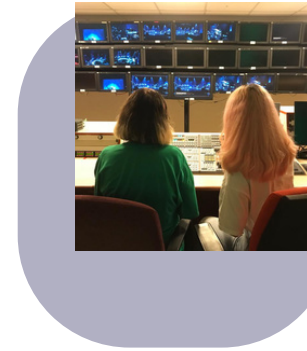

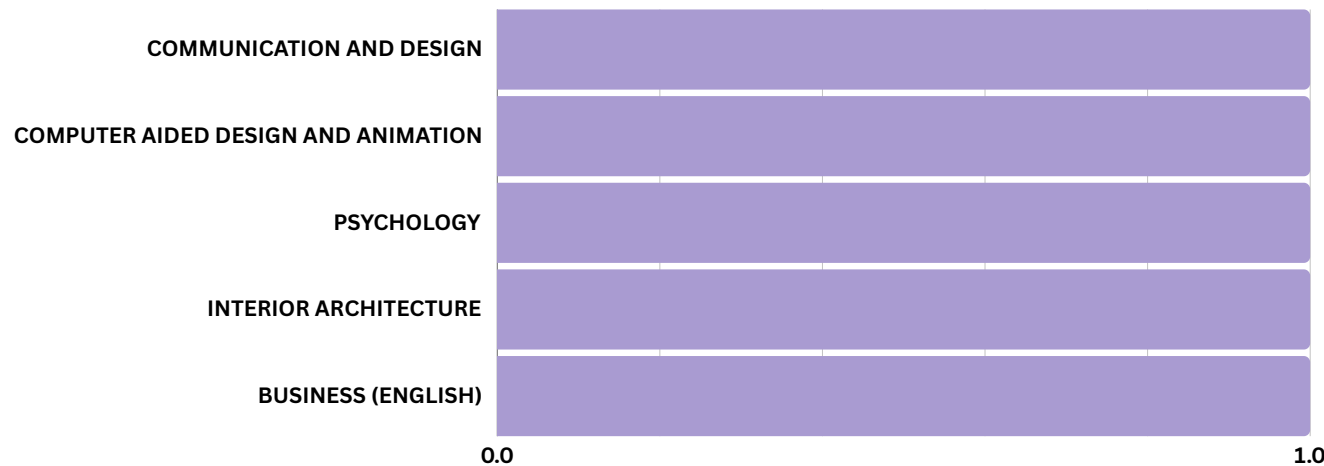
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Double Major Opportunity

Students who have a GPA of 2.90 out of 4.00 in their major program and who are in the 20% success bracket in their undergraduate/associate degree program can start their second major diploma program free of charge.
