The first session was held with the theme of "Champion Women of the Republic" with the participation of National Wrestler Buse Tosun Çavuşoğlu and National Volleyball Player Neslihan Demir. Referring to the difficulties of being an athlete as a woman, National Wrestler Buse Tosun Çavuşoğlu remarked: "I can say that being an athlete as a woman is difficult, being a wrestler is even more difficult. We are exposed to incredibly tiring training. Each branch has its own difficulties, but in wrestling there are moments when our pulse rises to 180-200. Wrestling is the branch of sports that brings the most medals to Turkey. We are fighting for a single goal and flag for our country." National Volleyball Player Neslihan Demir, on the other hand, "I owe a great debt to Turkish sports. If I'm here today, it's thanks to volleyball. I am who I am thanks to my discipline and patience."

## IGU TTO COMPETED WITH 3 DIFFERENT PROJECTS IN BAŞAKŞEHİR LIVING LAB INNOVATION COMPETITION

Istanbul Gelisim University Technology Transfer Office (IGU TTO), which applied to the Innovation Competition with 4 projects, reached the final with 3 projects in 10th Başakşehir Living Lab Innovation Competition organized by Başakşehir Municipality.

IGU TTO, which stands out with its projects designed by Turkish engineers and students, continues to produce innovative, scientific and technological projects every day with the R&D studies of food, energy, aviation, cyber security, health, robotics, materials and artificial intelligence technology groups. IGU TTO participated with 4 projects into the Başakşehir Living Lab Innovation Competition, which was held at the Başakşehir Living Lab Innovation Center. The goal of the competition is to support and encourage secondary school, high school, college, undergraduate, graduate, and teacher/academician entrepreneurs who generate innovative projects. The IGU TTO team, which reached the final with 3 projects, participated in the final presentation and represented our university.

The projects competing in the final are as follows:

- Unmanned Aerial Vehicle with Electric Fan Motor (EDF) capable of vertical landing and take-off (VTOL)
- -Sistech (autonomous disinfection tool for mapping agricultural lands and pesticides with UAV)
- Artificial intelligence assisted intrusion detection system in the safety of unmanned aerial vehicles
