Istanbul Deputy Governor Mustafa Kaya made the following statements in his opening speech: "More than 300 thousand international students will serve their countries, our country and the world by getting the best education in Turkey, educating and developing themselves in the best way. The world is in great injustice. We live in a time when the strong are right, not the strong. Therefore, we need a fair world. As a matter of fact, our students who grow up in our country will achieve this in the future."

"WE HAVE ALWAYS BEEN AND WILL CONTINUE TO BE WITH YOU"

Abdülkadir Gayretli, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Istanbul Gelişim University, started his speech by saying "You, our esteemed students, are worthy of the most beautiful things. We want to make you feel the privilege of studying in Turkey. We always show that we are in unity and solidarity with you, our dear friends. We have always been and will continue to be with you. We know that Turkiye, all Turkish and Muslim states should be in unity and solidarity, and as a nation."

TURKIYE IS IN THE TOP 10 AMONG THE PREFERRED COUNTRIES

Stating that Turkey's education standard has become an important center of preference by international students, especially with the increase in the last two decades, Istanbul Gelisim University Political Science and International Relations Department Lecturer Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fatih Fuat Tuncer, "Turkiye has entered the top 10 among the countries preferred in international education. It has made a serious breakthrough in recent years. According to the figures of 2023, there are more than 300 thousand foreign students. This is a very important figure for Turkiye's public diplomacy power. Students who come to our country graduate as volunteer



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ambassadors and represent Turkey in their own countries. As a university, we are one of the universities that hosts the highest number of international students in Turkiye. We attach great importance to international education and studentship."

Stating that international studentship is also an important resource for the Turkish economy, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Fatih Fuat Tuncer added: "According to a recent study, an international student contributes an average of \$700 per month to the Turkish economy. This reaches a very serious figure annually when multiplied by the number of students."

Abdullah Muhammed İslam, President of the Federation of International Student Associations (UDEF), stated the following in his speech:

"Humanity has been in a state of mobility at all times. This mobility has had certain conditions in each period. There was a period for trade and economy and a period for religious and intellectual people to travel. Civilizations found themselves with this interaction. In modern times, human needs have also changed. Therefore, the conditions in terms of mobility have been updated again. One of the most dynamic aspects of this mobility right now is international student mobility. Since the 1990s, it has been increasing both in our country and in the world. With this mobility, it is clear that states contribute a lot in terms of public diplomacy, international trade and economy, evaluate it as a brain transfer and produce works that will benefit all societies."

The 5.1 magnitude Mudanya-based earthquake yesterday once again raised the questions of "Are we ready for an earthquake?" Recently, "AFAD Volunteer" trainings were carried out for academic-administrative staff and students within the framework of the protocol made by Istanbul Gelisim University with AFAD (Disaster and Emergency Management Presidency). Istanbul Gelisim University volunteers who successfully passed the exam at the end of the trainings were entitled to receive certificates and "AFAD Volunteer" identity cards.

The earthquake, which occurred in the magnitude of 5.1 and 4.5 at 3-minute intervals off Bursa, Mudanya, created fear in the surrounding provinces, especially in Bursa and Istanbul. Reminding us again that we should be ready for an earthquake, we should take precautions. "Support AFAD Volunteer" trainings of the social responsibility project organized by Lect. Yasemin Kılıç Erdim, from Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU) Head of Construction Department and IGU Disaster and Emergency Club were held between 27 November-1 December 2023. Participants who successfully completed the trainings were ready to take part as a support team in disasters by obtaining their certificates.

- Rescue on upper floors and wells, light search and rescue drill,
- -Tent installation,
- -First Aid
- -Humanitarian Aid
- -Psychosocial support training,
- -Fire response and extinguishing application.

GREENMETRIC 2023 SUCCESS FROM IGU, WHICH STANDS OUT WITH ITS SUSTAINABILITY STUDIES!

The list of "GreenMetric World University Rankings 2023" has been announced. Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU), which was included in the GreenMetric ranking for the first time last year, was ranked 14th in the list of Turkish foundation universities in the GreenMetric 2023 list this year. IGU, which attracts attention with its important studies in the field of environmental sustainability, proved its success once again.

The list of "UI GreenMetric World University Rankings 2023", which was established in Indonesia in 2010 and works on green campus and environmental sustainability, was announced. Aiming to create a global awareness about environmental awareness, GreenMetric evaluates the sustainability studies of universities, including campus settlement and infrastructure, energy and climate change, wastes, water resources, transportation, education and research, according to 6 criteria. Istanbul Gelisim University (IGU), which was included in the GreenMetric ranking for the first time last year, increased its score by 935 points in 2023 and ranked 674th in the world with a total score of 5635. Istanbul Gelisim University, one of the most preferred foundation universities in Turkey, stood out among the foundation universities by jumping 7 places in the Turkey ranking in the total score, where 6 criteria were taken into account. IGU ranked 14th among the foundation universities, rising 23 places from 37th place.

IGU, which stands out with its sustainability studies, achieved a significant success in the "Energy and Climate Change" category by being ranked 21st in Turkey.
