

Future of the Program

In the Fashion Design Program, in addition to acquiring the necessary knowledge in the field of art and design; it is aimed to provide students with pattern, sewing and production skills. In order for our students to find job opportunities in every field of the fashion industry, to develop themselves or to create their own brands, we aim to train future fashion designers who have succeeded in developing their designer identity by giving hand and computer drawing and pattern courses; production courses so that they can bring the clothes they design to life; textile technology courses where they can obtain fabric, accessory and material information that should be selected in accordance with the design while producing; fashion marketing courses where they can express what they produce both verbally and creatively.



The normal education period to complete the Istanbul Gelişim University, Istanbul Gelişim Vocational School Logistics Program is two academic years, and the total minimum credit amount to be completed depending on the student workload is 120 ECTS.

In the first two semesters, our students take common courses at our vocational school and basic introduction courses to the field in a professional sense. Starting from the third semester, the focus is on vocational courses and our students begin to take elective courses in addition to the compulsory courses that are required in the professional sense.

Students who graduate from the Fashion Design Program can work as fashion designer (stylist), pattern specialist (modelist), accessory designer, textile designer (pattern, fabric designer), product and brand manager, collection planning, purchasing specialist, production planning, quality control manager in the sector or they can open their own ateliers and fashion houses and design and produce personalized clothing. In addition to their own field; they can work as fashion editor for fashion magazines, fashion photography, fashion and style consultancy. They can also work as a fashion marketer and visual / window dresser for the merchandising sector, category manager for online as merchandising, and as a costume designer in the performing arts sector.

Double Major Opportunities

The purpose of the double major program is to enable students who have successfully completed their major program to study in a second major program free of charge. Students who have a cumulative grade point average of 2.90 out of 4.00 in their major program and who are in the top 20% of their undergraduate/graduate program can start the second major diploma program free of charge.







With Erasmus+, the European Union's (EU) grant program in education, youth, and sports opportunities, our students can access various opportunities such as education, training, internship, professional development, non-formal learning-based youth activities abroad.





Innovative, technological and sociological studies are carried out in many different branches with 20 different application and research centers within our university. In addition, thematic research groups carry out studies that will contribute to science in 10 different fields from food to construction, automotive to health.
