## **NEWS FROM IGU**

## YÖKAK Accreditation Evaluation Team Visited İstanbul Gelişim University

Within the scope of the "Institutional Accreditation Program" (KAP) implemented by the Higher Education Quality Board (YÖKAK) to increase the quality of higher education institutions and contribute to quality assurance, the YÖKAK Accreditation Evaluation Team visited İstanbul Gelişim University between November 25-27.

The field visit program, which was carried out to conduct external evaluations of higher education institutions and to ensure the internalization and dissemination of the quality assurance culture in higher education institutions, began with the YÖKAK Accreditation Evaluation Team visiting İGU Rector Prof. Dr. Bahri Şahin and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees Abdülkadir Gayretli in their offices. The office visits were carried out by Vice Rectors Prof. Dr. Nuri Kuruoğlu, Prof. Dr. Necmettin Maraşlı, Prof. Dr. Arda Öztürkcan and Quality Coordinator Prof. Dr. Hasan Hakan Bozkurt participated. Afterwards, a meeting was held with the Institutional Quality Commission Members and the Senate and Board of Directors.

The delegation visited the deans and directors of academic units in their offices and examined in detail the education-training, research activities, social contribution, national and international quality standards of faculties and colleges. Issues such as the dissemination of quality processes to units, the goals of the units and the place of these goals within the strategic goals of the institution, the participation of stakeholders in the processes, the learning outcomes of the programs within the units and continuous improvement studies were emphasized.

The YÖKAK Evaluation Team, which also met with faculty members and students, received detailed information about the relationships of faculty members with senior management, the role of the quality assurance system in the activities of faculty members, the internalization of the quality assurance system, the policies regarding the self-development and motivation of academic staff. The administrative unit managers also came together and focused on issues such as the dissemination of quality processes to units, the dissemination of quality culture to all units, the goals of the units and the place of these goals within the strategic goals of the institution, and the participation of stakeholders in the processes. The delegation also visited the university's facilities, laboratories, libraries and social areas.



An exit meeting was held on the last day of the evaluation with the participation of the Rector, Vice Rectors, Deans and Directors. In the meeting where IGU's strong and open-to-development aspects were expressed; general feedback was given on the 3-day inspection. The YÖKAK Evaluation Team described the university's quality system and processes within the scope of development and improvement with positive expressions; and expressed wishes in line with future strategies and plans.

A seminar titled "Youth's Impact on the Environment: Local Solutions, Climate Change" was organized in our university on 11.12.2024 at 10.30 in the A Section E210 classroom with the partnership of the Applied Sciences Faculty Environment Commission and Avcılar Municipality. Dr. Akgün İlhan participated in the seminar with his presentations titled "Water Management in Youth", Zeynep Gül Karamanlı with his presentations titled "Climate Change and Energy Policies" and Özcan Şahingözlü with his presentations titled "Recycling and Local Administrations". "Employment and Education for Individuals with Disabilities" Talk Was Held!

The "Employment and Education for Individuals with Disabilities" talk organized by the Faculty of Applied Sciences Disability Commission within the scope of creating social consciousness and awareness for individuals with disabilities on "December 3 World Disability Day" started with the opening of an exhibition consisting of paintings made by students with disabilities.

The talk held by the Faculty of Applied Sciences Disability Commission on December 4, 2024 at the K Block Firnas Auditorium was hosted by Silivri Abdullah Bilgingüllüoğlu Special Education Vocational School Principal Bünyamin Kurt. The event started with the exhibition of paintings made by students receiving special education at the school with the participation of Muhlis Yıldız, who serves as the deputy principal in the institution where Bünyamin Kurt is the founding director.

The talk drew attention to the social and societal obstacles that individuals with disabilities face in the field of education and employment. Kurt shared his experiences by talking about what can be done to ensure the development of structures that will support individuals with disabilities and to increase social awareness. The speech drew attention to the statistical data of individuals with special education needs and touched on what needs to be done for students to actively participate in education life in special education institutions. The speech also focused on employment issues and included early signs of autistic individuals and what can be done for their social integration. The event ended with the presentation of plaques by commission members Asst. Prof. İpek Gürkan and Asst. Prof. Hande Ayhan Gökcek.





The panel, which began with the opening speeches of the Dean of the Faculty of Applied Sciences Prof. Dr. Kamil KAYA, came together with its participants in three separate sessions. The first session titled (New) Media and Disinformation was moderated by the Head of the Television Journalism and Programming Department Assoc. Prof. Uğur BALOĞLU, while Prof. Dr. Nilüfer TİMİSİ NALÇAOĞLU from Istanbul University and Erkan SAKA from Istanbul Bilgi University honored us with their participation.

The second session, which began with Assoc. Prof. Nihal KOCABAY ŞENER from Istanbul Commerce University as moderator, progressed within the framework of "Politics and Disinformation". Prof. Dr. Rabia KARAKAYA POLAT from Işık University, Prof. Dr. Barış ÇOBAN from Doğuş University and Assoc. Prof. Suncem KOÇER from Koç University discussed the current effects of media and disinformation and their reflections in politics.





In the student session held within the scope of the (New) Media and Disinformation: Current Issues panel, the TUBITAK 2209-A project titled "Disaster Journalism and Disinformation: A Research on News Verification Platforms' News Regarding the February 6 Earthquakes", which was carried out under the consultancy of Asst. Prof. Hande ULUSOY from the Department of Television Journalism and Programming, was carried out by our graduate student Ecem Ceylan, who took part in the project as a researcher.

The panel, which hosted expert academicians from various universities, yielded important outputs for both students and academicians.









## FoAS Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department Organized "Istanbul Indoor Vertical Agriculture Application Center Tour"

Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department students and faculty members visited the Istanbul Indoor Vertical Agriculture Application Center, which was implemented in cooperation with the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry and the private sector, on December 6, 2024.

The department team, who were welcomed by the relevant people from the center, were first given general information about the establishment and facilities of the facility. It was learned that the New Cultural Center Complex, which has a budget of 4 million 100 thousand TL and is located in the Kağıthane district, was built on a total of 700 square meters of parking area. It was shared that the first seeds were planted and production started as of September 30, 2022 in the center, which was completed on September 28, 2022. The center, which was implemented with the aim of developing new nature-friendly technologies in the face of the increasing population and climate crisis, draws attention as a facility where plant production is carried out with artificial light at a depth of 30 meters. Located on the minus eighth floor of the parking lot, at a depth of minus 30 meters, this facility makes significant contributions to sustainable agriculture with its advanced technology solutions. After the general information, the center's application rooms were toured with the instructor and detailed information was shared. It was shared that the vertical farming technology used in the center, which is the second deepest agricultural production unit in the world, can yield 10-40 times more products than traditional methods. During the technical tour, where the application rooms, preparation stages and production were explained in detail, the students' questions were answered with interest. At the end of the event, the instructors were thanked and promotion bags were presented. The department faculty members left a note in the center's memory book expressing their gratitude for the event. This event provided students with a valuable perspective on future technologies for sustainable agriculture.





## The Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department Hosted Gökkuşağı College Students at the Gastronorm Kitchen Laboratory!



#### The era of video production with artificial intelligence begins with OpenAl's Sora

OpenAI introduced Sora, an artificial intelligence model that converts text into video. Users can create 20-second videos in 1080p resolution by entering text with Sora. It also offers features such as converting static photos into animations and remixing existing videos. Sora provides more flexibility with different format options and scenario board support. As part of security measures, restrictions have been imposed on videos and deepfake content featuring real people. Sora is currently only available to Plus and Pro users.
