Istanbul Gelisim University Faculty of Applied Sciences started its academic activities as School of Applied Sciences with 6 departments in the 2013-2014 academic year, and with the Presidential Decree published in the Official Gazette dated 25 June 2021 and numbered 31522, the School of Applied Sciences was closed and the Faculty of Applied Sciences was established and our faculty continues its education with 12 departments.



AQAS, which was established in Germany in 2002 and is a member of the European Quality Assurance Association, is an organisation that has evaluated more than 5000 programmes worldwide. More than 90 German universities have accredited educational programmes of which it is a member. The accreditation certifies that the accredited programme complies with European standards and principles.





Operating under the supervision and control of the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA), our institution provides theoretical and practical training within the scope of the Aircraft Maintenance Personnel Licence Instruction (SHT-66) and Maintenance Training and Examination Institutions Instruction (SHT-147). At the end of the trainings, "School Graduation Certificate" recognised by DGCA is given to the students who are successful in the theoretical exams and practical evaluations.

Gastronorm Laboratory

Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department kitchen laboratories are used for the practical courses in the curriculum. Basic culinary techniques, Turkish and World cuisine, a la carte applications, pastry techniques, cooking methods courses are taught in Block B Gastronomy laboratory with a capacity of 55 students. With a rich supply of equipment and materials, students have the chance to put into practice what they have learnt in theory.

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The Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department's kitchen laboratories are used for practical courses included in the curriculum. Pastry techniques, sauces and soups, baked goods, basic kitchen techniques, Turkish and world cuisine courses are taught in the Gastronomy and Culinary Arts laboratory in Block C, which has a capacity of 65 students. Unlike a traditional kitchen, this new department laboratory, equipped with a wide range of products and equipment specific to pastry making and ovens with different functional features, enables students to prepare themselves for the profession by applying the principles of gastronomy science.







Pilot Melike Kuvvet Aircraft Hangar

In the Melike Kuvvet Aircraft Hangar, there is a Cessna 340A model aircraft that has been separated from flight. Our students have the opportunity to apply the knowledge they have gained in theoretical courses and the experience they have gained in practical courses on real aircraft and aircraft parts. In the hangar, mainly mechanical works are carried out and partially avionic works are also included. Our students have the opportunity to practice in various subjects including riveting process and engine troubleshooting.









Aircraft Electronics / Avionics Laboratory

Aircraft Electronics/Avionics Laboratory is used for students to learn basic electronics, circuit analysis and logical circuits in practice. After receiving basic training on the use of digital devices such as oscilloscopes, signal generators and avometers, our students have the opportunity to practice on these devices. In addition, our technical instructors working in the laboratory are experienced and specialised in their fields.







Aircraft Avionics / B2 Laboratory

Aircraft Avionics B2 Laboratory is a laboratory used for the recognition of basic electrical circuit elements for aircraft, troubleshooting, learning aircraft electrical systems and components and understanding their working principles. It serves as a workshop where basic aircraft electronics, digital and navigation systems components are recognised, working principles are learned, troubleshooting and circuit monitoring skills are gained.









Aircraft Systems Laboratory I - II

In Aircraft Systems Laboratories, landing gear, turbine fuel and flight control systems are introduced and the working principles and operation of these systems are taught. In addition, trainings are given on the dismantling and assembly of faulty units.









Aircraft Engine Laboratory I - II

In the Aircraft Engine Laboratories, introduction of the parts of piston and gas turbine aircraft engines, teaching the working principles, disassembly and assembly operations, engine start-up and on-engine skill applications are carried out. In addition, trainings such as the working principles of turbofan engines, which are widely used in new generation aircraft, and disassembly and assembly of components on the engine are also provided.









Aircraft Structural/Mechanical Laboratory I - II

In the Aircraft Structural/Mechanical Laboratories, the basicelements of the aircraftare introduced, their functioning is explained, the disassembly and assembly of the main components are provided, and the related processes are monitored and controlled. In addition, trainings are provided on the elimination of structural problems that may occur in aircraft and components and on the operations that can be performed on aircraft or systems with existing components.











Aircraft Cabin Services Laboratory

In the Aircraft Cabin Services Laboratory, task/practice based trainings are provided for the in-cabin maintenance needs of aircraft.



Hi, I'm Tuana Evening.







Simultaneous Translation Laboratory

In the Simultaneous Interpreting Laboratory, students are provided with an environment where they can practice both consecutive and immediate interpreting with a focus on interpreting. To this end, there are three booths in the laboratory that enable interpreting practice. Each of these booths allows two interpreters to interpret simultaneously in different language pairs. On the other hand, thanks to the table microphone and mobile microphone in the laboratory, seminar, interview and interview environments can be simulated and consecutive interpreting can be performed. Students, who have the opportunity to put theory into practice, seek solutions to translation problems that may arise during translation with these simulations.

The Simultaneous Interpreting Laboratory uses the state-of-the-art DICENTIS system developed by Bosch, a multinational technology and engineering company. This system is a conference system designed to facilitate communication and co-operation between participants in meetings and conferences. DICENTIS conference system consists of various components such as wired and wireless interpreting units (Interpreter Headsets, Digital Modulator, Audio Processor and Switch Unit) and multimedia devices (8-Channel Digital Infrared Pocket Signal Receiver, Radiators). The conference units are equipped with high quality microphones and speakers that provide clear sound for the participants in the meeting. 52 students can listen to the translations in the booths through mobile signal receivers and headphones.







Pilot Melike Kuvvet Aircraft Hangar


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In the Melike Kuvvet Aircraft Hangar, there is a Cessna 340A model aircraft that has been separated from flight. Our students have the opportunity to apply the knowledge they have gained in theoretical courses and the experience they have gained in practical courses on real aircraft and aircraft parts. In the hangar, mainly mechanical works are carried out and partially avionic works are also included. Our students have the opportunity to practice in various subjects including riveting process and engine troubleshooting.







Aircraft Electronics / Avionics Laboratory

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Aircraft Electronics/Avionics Laboratory is used for students to learn basic electronics, circuit analysis and logical circuits in practice. After receiving basic training on the use of digital devices such as oscilloscopes, signal generators and avometers, our students have the opportunity to practice on these devices. In addition, our technical instructors working in the laboratory are experienced and specialised in their fields.



Aircraft Systems Laboratory I - II

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In Aircraft Systems Laboratories, landing gear, turbine fuel and flight control systems are introduced and the working principles and operation of these systems are taught. In addition, trainings are given on the dismantling and assembly of faulty units.





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In the Aircraft Engine Laboratories, introduction of the parts of piston and gas turbine aircraft engines, teaching the working principles, disassembly and assembly operations, engine start-up and on-engine skill applications are carried out. In addition, trainings such as the working principles of turbofan engines, which are widely used in new generation aircraft, and disassembly and assembly of components on the engine are also provided.





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Aircraft Structural/Mechanical Laboratory I - II

In the Aircraft Structural/Mechanical Laboratories, the basic elements of the aircraft are introduced, their functioning is explained, the disassembly and assembly practice of the main components is gained and the related processes are monitored and controlled. In addition, trainings are provided on the elimination of structural problems that may occur in aircraft and components and on the operations that can be performed on aircraft or systems with existing components.





Aircraft Cabin Services Laboratory

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In the Aircraft Cabin Services Laboratory, task/practice based trainings are provided for the in-cabin maintenance needs of the aircraft.





MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEMS SEMINAR

Res. Asst. Berika Akçay from our Department of Management Information Systems gave a seminar to 11th and 12th grade students at Şile Anatolian High School. Thus, the seminar provided a productive learning environment where the foundations of supportive relationships within the student community were laid.

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QUALITY MANAGEMENT IN ENTERPRISES

The interview event on "Quality Management in Businesses", organised for the students of the Faculty of Applied Sciences, Department of Management Information Systems, was very productive in terms of both reinforcing the theoretical knowledge of the students and meeting the sectoral practices. In the interview, topics such as the historical development of the concept of quality, total quality management approach, process improvement techniques and the effects of digitalisation on quality were discussed. 
