2025 Project Year Erasmus+ KA131 Results Announced: IGU Tops the List Among Foundation Universities!

The results of the 2025 Erasmus+ KA131 Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility Project applications have been announced. According to the announced results, Istanbul Gelişim University (IGU) has been awarded a total grant of €384,020. This amount is the highest KA131 budget the university has ever received. The grant is not only a tangible result of the university's efforts towards its internationalization vision but also represents an important milestone in providing more opportunities and support in the field of student and staff mobility.

IGU Tops the List Among Foundations Universities!

According to the 2025 results, İGÜ ranked among all foundation universities in Türkiye as follows:

Study Mobility Grant-1st place

Teaching Mobility Grant- 2nd place

Internship Mobility Grant- 3rd place

Total Grants Received- 3rd place

Learning Mobility Grant- 6th place

This success clearly demonstrates the effective use of academic and administrative capacity in the direction of internationalization, particularly in staff mobility.








Being a Designer in the Age of Artificial Intelligence: The Power of Imagination Is Still Ours

I've been teaching graphic design and video effects for 18 years. I've had hundreds of students, sat at the table with industry giants, and sometimes spent hours experimenting with a poster's font, sometimes making dozens of adjustments for a split-second video effect. That's why I know this: The only constant in the design world is change...

Today, this change is called Artificial Intelligence. When I first saw it, I was astonished. Imagine, you type a command, and a few seconds later, an image close to what you envisioned appears on the screen. Moreover, the lighting settings, composition, and even texture details are all perfectly aligned. At this point, the same question comes to everyone's mind: "If AI can design, do we still need it?"

Yes, more so than ever. Because AI produces "beautiful" images, but we still create the "right" design. Good design is one that fits the context, the target audience, cultural codes, and the spirit of the brand. This can only be achieved through human creativity, experience, and empathy.



Al: A Partner, Not a Competitor

Artificial intelligence doesn't eliminate the designer; it gives them brand new power.

- Speed: It reduces the time it takes to develop an idea to mere minutes.
- Alternative: It can generate dozens of different experiments from the same brief.
- Energy Saving: It takes on repetitive tasks and leaves us with room for creative thinking.

In the near future, a successful designer will be someone who can use AI like a co-pilot. Just as designers without Photoshop struggle today, designers without AI will be left behind tomorrow.





Pegasus Takes Flight Safety Step: Power Bank Use Banned

Following Turkish Airlines, Pegasus Airlines has also made a new decision to increase flight safety. As part of measures taken to address increasing battery-related safety risks, Pegasus announced that it is banning the use of portable chargers (power banks) during flights. The decision follows a recent incident that caused a flight from Istanbul to Seoul to return to Istanbul Airport via Kazakhstan. In the incident, a passenger dropped their power bank between the seats, creating a security risk, and the aircraft was forced to turn back.
