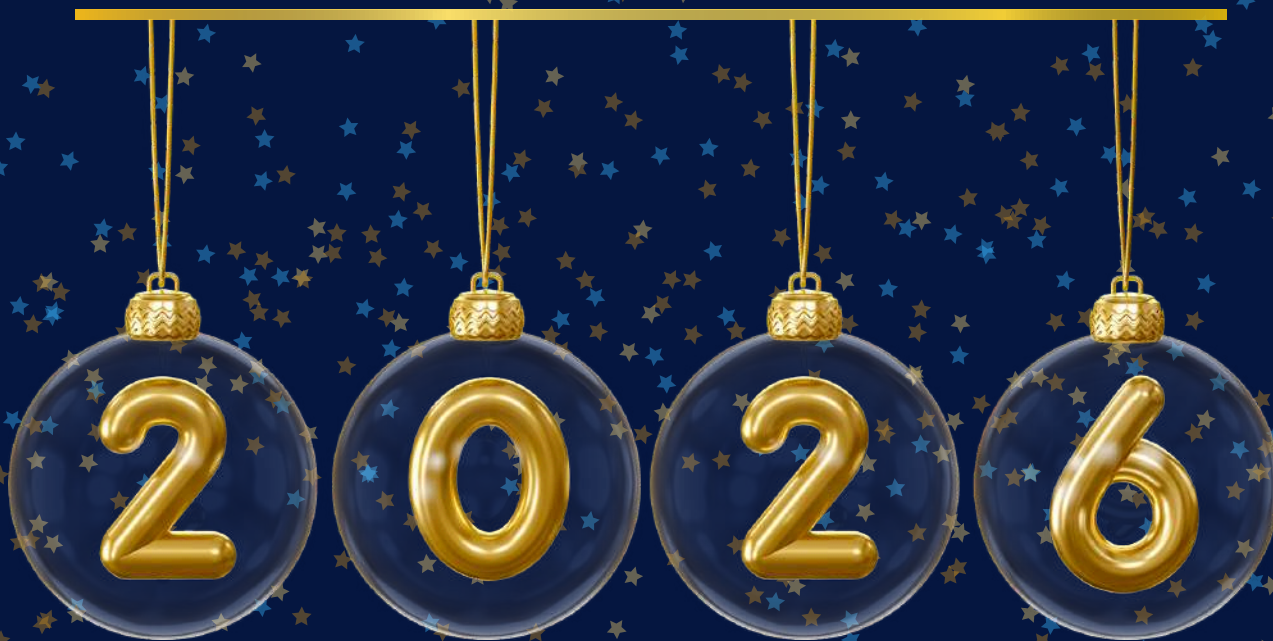

The meeting, hosted by IGU TTO on December 12, 2025, took place at the TTO Office and was attended by IGU Rector Prof. Dr. Bahri ŞAHİN, Vice Rectors Prof. Dr. Nuri KURUOĞLU, Prof. Dr. Necmettin MARAŞLI, and Prof. Dr. Seyfettin Arda ÖZTÜRKCAN, OTUAM Director Prof. Dr. Hamdi Alper ÖZYİĞİT, TTO Director Yahya Kemal KIRAN, and teams from both OTUAM and TTO.

During the meeting, Serhat ÇİFTÇİ, Research Assistant at the Department of Aviation Electrical and Electronics, Faculty of Applied Sciences, Istanbul Gelisim University, gave a presentation on OTUAM's activities and ongoing research. 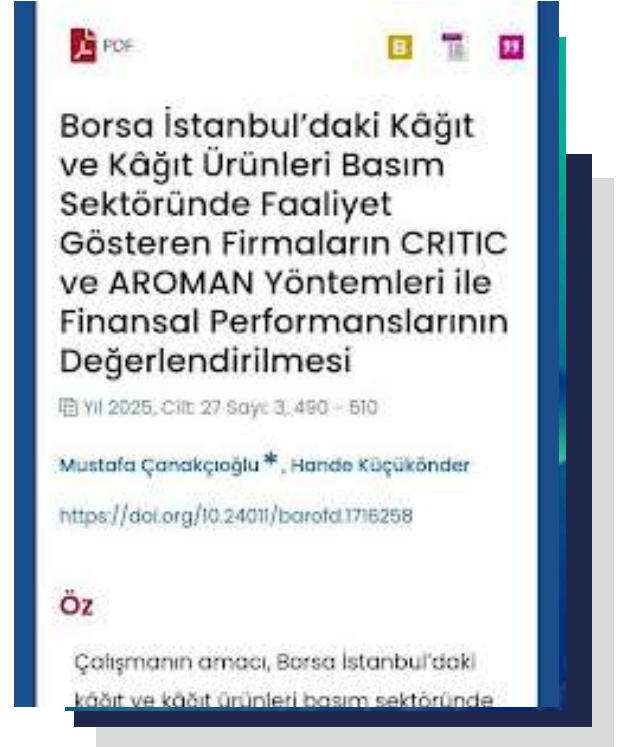

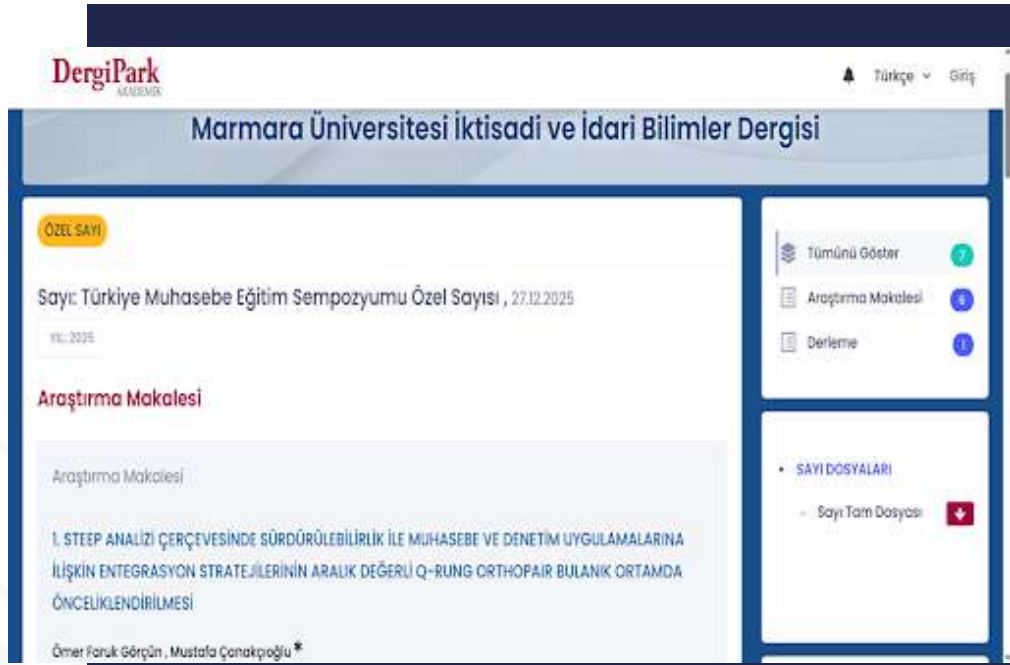

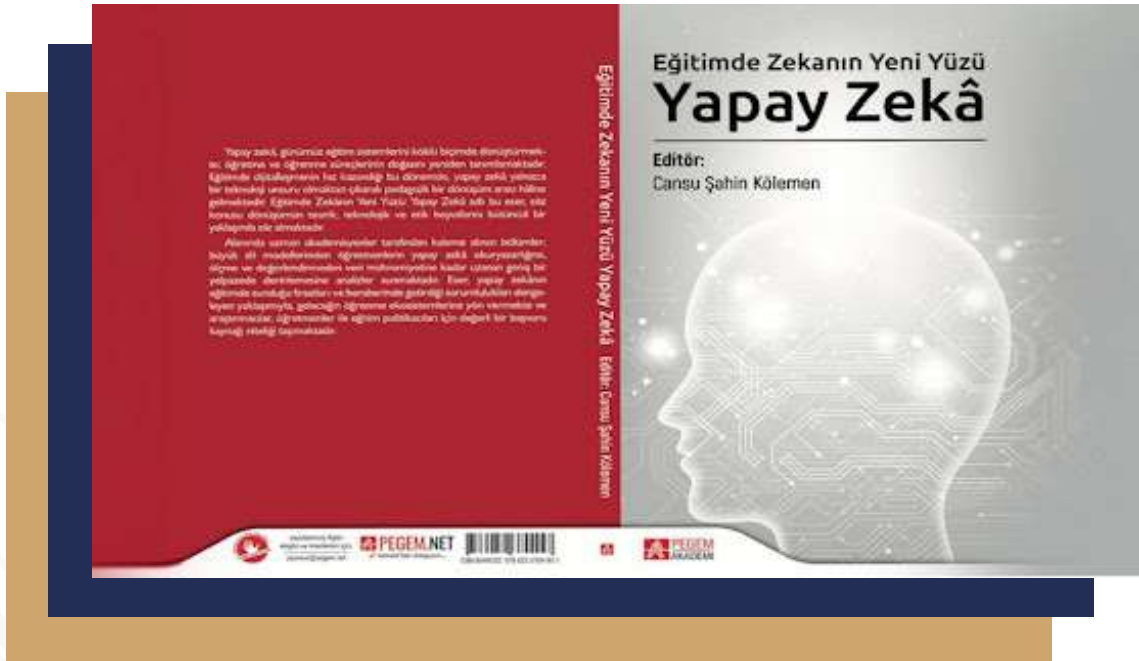
## ACADEMIC BOOKS

Istanbul Gelisim University continues to contribute to scientific production through the high-quality academic work of its faculty members and to lead the digital transformation processes in education.

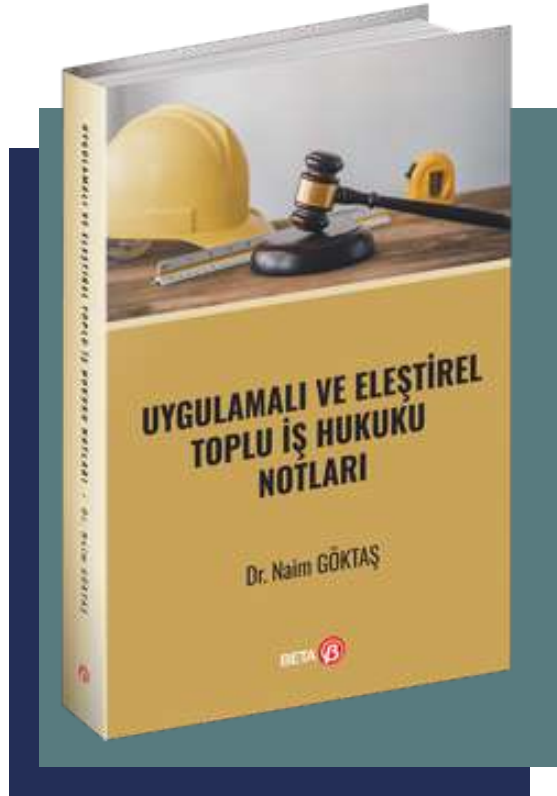

# UBF Department of English Translation and Interpreting – Talk/Event News 2025–2026 Fall Semester (December)

### **1) English Translation and Interpreting Department Holds Interview with ÇEVİİR Members!**

The interview titled “ÇEVİİR: How Did It Emerge, What Does It Do, How Does It Defend Translators' Rights?”, organized by the FAS English Translation and Interpreting Department, was held on Monday, December 8, 2025, between 11:00 and 12:00 in classroom E208 on the 2nd floor of Block A. The event, featuring Barış Gönülşen and Selen Birce Yılmaz, members of the Turkish Translators Association (ÇEVİİR), addressed the professional rights of translators, the structure of the translation industry, and professional support mechanisms for all department students. The founding process of ÇEVİİR, its role in the translation industry, translators' working conditions, rights, and the functions of translator communities were comprehensively shared within the framework of current professional practices.

### **2) A Talk Titled “Translation Studies from an Interdisciplinary Perspective: Sociological Approaches and the Sociology of Translation” Was Organized!**

The English Translation and Interpreting Department of the Faculty of Translation and Interpreting held a talk titled “Translation Studies from an Interdisciplinary Perspective: Sociological Approaches and the Sociology of Translation” on Wednesday, December 10, 2025, between 3:00 PM and 4:00 PM in classroom E208 on the 2nd floor of Block A. Dr. Ulvican Yazar, a faculty member of the English Translation and Interpreting Department at IGU, participated as a speaker. The talk discussed how sociological theories and methods are applied to translation studies from an interdisciplinary perspective; the social position of the translator, the social context of translation practices, power relations between actors, and the new research horizons opened by sociological analyses in translation studies were emphasized.

### **3) A "Project Management in Translation" Talk Held at the English Translation and Interpreting Department!**

The talk titled "Project Management in Translation," organized by the English Translation and Interpreting Department, took place on Monday, December 15, 2025, between 13:00 and 14:00 in classroom E208 on the 2nd floor of Block A. Dr. Sinem Canım, a faculty member from the English Translation and Interpreting Department at Istanbul University's Faculty of Letters, participated as a speaker. The event addressed project management aspects of the translation process, including planning, time management, team coordination, quality assurance, and the use of technological tools. The role of the project manager, how the project workflow is structured from briefing to delivery, translator-editor-client relationships, terminology management, deadline pressure, and communication problems were discussed, and solution strategies for these sectoral challenges were shared with examples.

### **4) A Talk Titled "It Took 60 Tears to Look This Good! The Development of Cognitive Translation & Interpreting Studies" Was Held!**

Organized by the Department of English Translation and Interpreting, the talk titled "It took 60 years to look this good! The development of Cognitive Translation & Interpreting Studies" was held on Monday, December 15, 2025, between 12:00 and 13:00 in classroom E208 on the 2nd floor of Block A. The event, featuring Professor Dr. Ricardo Muñoz Martín from Alma Mater Studiorum Università di Bologna as the speaker, addressed the development of Cognitive Translation Studies and Simultaneous Interpreting Studies over the last sixty years; the transformation process of the field from speculative approaches to a scientific discipline based on empirical data, how the workings of the translator's mind are made visible through the "black box" metaphor, and the methodological maturity reached by the discipline were comprehensively evaluated.

### **5) The English Translation and Interpreting Department Student Club (İGÜÇEV) Held a Talk and Music Performance Titled "Melic Translation - Art or Craft?"**

The talk and music performance titled "Melic Translation - Art or Craft?", jointly organized by the İGÜ Translation Club (İGÜÇEV) and the İGÜ Music Club, took place on Friday, December 19, 2025, between 13:30 and 16:00 in the K Block Firnas Auditorium. The event, featuring Aleksandra Agaciak, a faculty member from Adam Mickiewicz University (Poznan, Poland), addressed the historical and current state of song translation, discussing its commercialization process, artistic qualities, and its status as one of the most challenging types of translation art. The structural features distinguishing song translation from other artistic translation types were examined, and the question of whether a song translator is a craftsman or an artist was evaluated from translation studies and aesthetic perspectives.

### A Technical Field Trip to Istanbul Airport Was Conducted!

On December 18, 2025, members of the **SKYNET** student club from the **Aviation Management Department of Istanbul Gelisim University's Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences**, along with their advisor, **Dr. Mehmet Emin Keke**, conducted a technical field trip to Istanbul Airport.

The purpose of this trip was for SKYNET Club members to examine firsthand the operational intelligence, advanced technology, and engineering applications behind a global mega-hub like **Istanbul Airport (IGA)**. Our visit aimed to see how critical systems such as the **APOC (Operations Center)**, which manages flight traffic and crisis management, and the automated BHS (Baggage Handling System) successfully apply the concepts of logistics, automation, and information technology that we learned in theory to the real world.

Furthermore, by observing the ground operations in **the Apron Area**, the most advanced point of airport security, and the high-standard emergency management and safety protocols undertaken by the **ARFF (Rescue and Fire Fighting)** unit, we gained a close understanding of the complex, 24/7 operational structure and career opportunities in the aviation sector.

### REINSURANCE BROKERAGE, MGA STRUCTURES, HUMAN RESOURCES, AND IMPORTANT ASSESSMENTS ON THE FUTURE OF THE INSURANCE SECTOR

Yüksekbilgili, with her years of experience, provided comprehensive assessments on many issues ranging from the functioning of the reinsurance market to the value that brokerage adds to the sector, from human resources to sustainability. “Reinsurance brokerage is not just about finding capacity”

Ebru Yüksekbiğili, stating that she continued her career on the brokerage side after a short experience in an insurance company, emphasized that her area of expertise is global markets, facultative reinsurance, and placement. Stating that reinsurance brokerage is not as simple as it seems from the outside, Yüksekbiğili said:

“Reinsurance brokerage is not just about finding capacity from abroad and finishing the job with a piece of paper. This job starts with risk management, continues with consultancy, and is completed with trust.”

Yüksekbilgili stated that treaty reinsurance creates a safety net in the local market, while facultative reinsurance fills the gaps where this structure is insufficient. He noted that facultative reinsurance plays a critical role, especially for products not available in Turkey, high-capacity and complex risks.

#### WHY IS FACULTATIVE REINSURANCE MORE FLEXIBLE?

Reminding that each risk is evaluated individually in facultative reinsurance, Yüksekbiğili said that this model offers insurance companies both flexibility and the opportunity to develop new products. He stated that facultative reinsurance stands out particularly in earthquakes, major industrial risks, and new generation insurance products, adding:

“Facultative reinsurance allows for the addition of special conditions on top of general conditions and the transfer of know-how from abroad to Turkey.” She said that this structure is decisive in the entry of niche products such as cyber risks, financial risks, parametric insurance, and “after-event insurance” into Turkey.

### **"MGA MODEL ON THE RISE**

Yüksekbilgili also explained the MGA (Managing General Agent) model. While the regulatory framework in Turkey is not yet clear, Yüksekbiigili stated that MGAs provide speed, operational efficiency, and additional capacity in the global insurance market. "MGAs offer the possibility of quick decision-making without getting caught up in the larger mechanisms. Their ability to work with underwriting authority on behalf of reinsurers or insurance companies provides significant advantages, especially in niche products."

Yüksekbilgili noted that MGA models make significant contributions to the sector in areas such as parametric insurance, cyber risks, and financial risks, stating that this structure is beneficial for the development of insurance and holds significant potential for Turkey.

Reinsurance brokerage is not just about 'finding paperwork'

Yüksekbilgili stated that reinsurance brokerage is often misunderstood, emphasizing that this field is not simply about finding collateral from abroad.

"This business starts with risk management. You need to tell the underwriter a story. Not just the report, but also the history of that risk, the experience with claims, and its future prospects are put on the table."

Yüksekbilgili stated that claims consulting, wording skills, negotiation ability, and analytical thinking are indispensable elements of reinsurance brokerage, adding that sometimes negotiations are conducted with dozens of reinsurers simultaneously for a single placement. "This business is entirely based on trust."

Yüksekbilgili emphasized that reinsurance is built on a large-scale relationship of trust:

"A reinsurer at the other end of the world accepts a multi-million dollar risk without ever seeing you or the client you represent. Trust is the most fundamental element here."

Therefore, he stated that the broker should closely monitor not only the price but also the financial soundness of the markets they work in.

### **FACTORS THAT MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN BROKERAGE**

High-level knowledge, analytical thinking, negotiation skills, and composure are as important as technical knowledge for a reinsurance broker to create value, and High-level knowledge reminded that difficult placements are usually completed in the last days:

"Bringing everyone together on the same terms in a placement with 50 reinsurers requires serious analytical and negotiation skills. You cannot do this job if you are not calm."

High-level knowledge also pointed out that claims management is a critical area in brokerage, and said that wording knowledge and past claims experience are decisive, especially in complex claims.

### **“THE ROLE OF THE INSURANCE BROKERS ASSOCIATION**

High-level knowledge, who is also the Vice President of the Insurance Brokers Association, touched upon the association's work and reminded that the association was established in 1991 with the aim of protecting the profession. He stated that the association plays an active role in many areas today, from licensing processes to legislative studies, from training to intra-sector coordination. Yüksekbilgili stated that there are 228 brokers throughout Turkey, the vast majority of whom are members of the association, and that the Broker Academy project provides systematic training for young broker candidates.

### **EMPHASIS ON HUMAN RESOURCES AND TRAINING**

Highlighting that the biggest problem in the insurance sector is human resources, Yüksekbilgili stated that the profession is learned through experience, not formal training:

“Insurance is not a profession you can practice immediately after graduating from school. Who you sit next to, who you observe, and what kind of work you learn by seeing are very important.”

He said that they aim to bring qualified people to the sector through collaborations with universities, internship programs, and training activities, and stated that continuous investment in this area is necessary.

### **EMPOWERING WOMEN IN THE SECTOR**

Referring to the Women's Committee established within the association, Yüksekbilgili said that they aim to increase the visibility of women insurance professionals and encourage the sharing of experiences. “I don't like to discriminate between men and women, but as you climb the ladder, it becomes harder to make your voice heard. These platforms are important for women to express themselves more comfortably.” Stating that women professionals are supported through YouTube programs, interviews, and mentoring activities, Yüksekbilgili noted that these efforts will continue.

### **ADVICE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE: VISION, EXPERTISE, AND TRUST**

At the end of the program, Yüksekbilgili gave advice to young insurance professionals, emphasizing the importance of vision and strategic thinking as much as technical expertise:

“Those who want to advance in this sector must specialize in something, build trust, and establish open communication. Insurance is still a business driven by relationships.”

### **SUSTAINABILITY AND CLIMATE RISK AT THE CENTER OF INSURANCE**

At the end of the speech, Yüksekbilgili emphasized that sustainability and climate change have become an unavoidable agenda, especially in terms of industrial risks, and said that reinsurance brokerage plays a key role in this transformation.

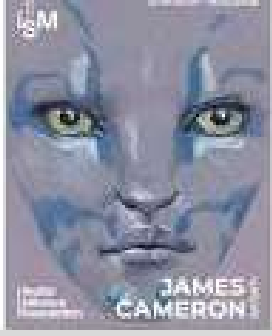
