"2023-1-TR01-KA171-HED-000164429" KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Study Mobility applications for students who wish to benefit from Erasmus+ Study Mobility will be accepted from **February 19 to March 10, 2025,** through the e-Government Turna Portal system (<u>https://turnaportal.ua.gov.tr/</u>).

FOREIGN LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE

Foreign Language Certificate: Erasmus+ Foreign Language Exam will be held between 18 - 20 March 2025 by Istanbul Gelisim University Foreign Languages School. The written part of the exam will be held on 18 March 2025. The speaking part of the exam will be held on 20 March 2025. Exam times will be announced on the IGU School of Foreign Languages website. Students who score 19 points or less on the written exam will not be assigned for speaking exam. Do not forget to take your student cards with you when you take the exam.

The exam consists of 2 parts: The test and speaking. The test section contains multiple-choice questions in 3 parts: grammar, vocabulary, and reading. Students are required to take the speaking test after the Testsection. If both parts (test and speaking) are not completed, your exam will be invalid.

You can access sample exam questions from the link <u>https://ydyo.gelisim.edu.tr/tr/akademik-icerik-ornek-sinavlar</u>. In order to be successful in the Erasmus+ Foreign Language exam, you must have at least 60 points from the relevant exam. Students who declare that they will take the Foreign Language Exam but do not take it will be deducted -5 points in their next application.

NOTE: YDS, YÖKDİL, and international exams accepted as equivalent by ÖSYM are also accepted. During the application, you will need to upload documents proving that you have obtained at least 60 out of 100 from the relevant exams. Students who upload the relevant document will be exempt from the Erasmus+ Foreign Language Exam. For details about the exam, you should follow the IGU Foreign Languages Web Page (https://ydyo.gelisim.edu.tr/tr/akademik-anapage).

To be eligible for Erasmus Education mobility, a minimum score of 60 points in the Erasmus+ Foreign Language Exam is required for the application.

* Within the framework of the <u>KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Study Mobility</u>, students who have been awarded grants are eligible to receive funding for a maximum of one academic term.

*KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Study Mobility can be held up to a total of 12 months at each level of education (first degree: associate degree, bachelor degree; second degree: Master's degree; third degree: doctorate, specialization in medicine). The total mobility period (study + internship) at each level cannot exceed 12 months.

Who Can't Apply?

1.Students <u>studying in</u> English Preparatory, Scientific Preparatory, Open and Distance Education Programs, <u>and programs other than</u> Economics and Finance (English-Turkish), Political Science International Relations (English-Turkish), Political Science and Public Administration, Tourism Guidance, Dentistry Child Development (English-Turkish), Business Administration (English-Turkish), Electrical and Electronics Engineering (English-Turkish), Sociology, Architecture (English-Turkish), Psychology (English-Turkish), Computer Engineering (English-Turkish), Nursing (English-Turkish), English Language and Literature <u>cannot apply for KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Study Mobility.</u>

2. Students of English Preparatory, Scientific Preparation, Open, and Distance Education Programs, and special students can not apply for Erasmus+ Study and Internship Mobility.

3. Final-year students can not apply for Erasmus+ Study Mobility.

4. Students can not apply from the minor program.

5. Students who continue their education at our University with any exchange program cannot apply.

6. Graduate students can not apply for study mobility.

7. Students enrolled in doctoral programs can not benefit from exchange programs at the following stages:

a) For doctoral students who have not taken the doctoral qualifying exam, in the last semester for which the doctoral qualifying exam must be taken,

b) In the last semester in which the thesis proposal defense must be entered,

c) If there is a term restriction that will prevent "at least 3 successful thesis follow-up periods" among the doctoral graduation requirements,

d) In the last semester of the maximum duration of the program.

8. Students enrolled in Master's programs with thesis cannot benefit from exchange programs at the following stages:

a) In the thesis stage and in the period when they are entitled to take their thesis defense,

b) In the last semester of the maximum duration of the program

9. Non-Thesis Master's Students can not benefit from Erasmus+ Study Mobility.

Students who continue their education at our University through any exchange program cannot apply.

KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Study Mobility Application Requirements

1- Within the scope of the higher education institution, the student; must be an active student enrolled in the above-mentioned departments

2- To have an academic grade point average (2.20/4.00)

3- To have a sufficient number of ECTS credits for study mobility,

4- The total duration of mobility that will benefit from the higher education mobility activities during the Erasmus+ and Lifelong Learning (LLP) period within the current education level cannot exceed 12 months.

Students who haven't met these criteria <u>cannot apply</u>. It doesn't prevent them from taking part in KA-171 Project Study Mobility if the students have failed courses.

¹According to the ECTS Guide of the European Commission, the sufficient number of credits is 60 ECTS credits for one academic year. If the completion of 30 ECTS credits for one semester is not fulfilled by the partner institution, even if you have gained eligibility, you cannot participate in the mobility.

² Participation in similar programs under Mevlana, TÜBİTAK, and the Presidency for Turks Abroad and Related Communities is not included.

KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Study Mobility Application Particular Points

The application period for the KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Learning Mobility will be open from **February 19th to March 10th, 2025**.

Even if eligibility is achieved, mobility cannot be utilized if **30 ECTS** credits cannot be matched with courses at the partner institution. There should be a sufficient number of ECTS credits for study mobility, and for graduate and doctoral students who are in a thesis period without a course load, such as transitioning to the thesis phase, a learning agreement can be arranged based on a workload that does not necessarily consist of 30 ECTS credits in an academic semester

IMPORTANT NOTE:

ATTENTION!

If you qualify for mobility within the scope of the KA-171 Project Study Mobility Applications, you will be able to carry out your mobility during the 2025/2026 Academic Year in either the Fall or Spring semesters.

Evaluation Criteria

It will be taken into consideration 50% of the English Language Score and 50% of the General Weighted Grade Point Average (GPA). The sum of these points constitutes the final score (Erasmus+ Score).

According to the evaluation criteria specified below, for a student to be considered successful in the KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Learning Mobility, the final score (Erasmus+ Score) must be a minimum of 60 points. *The selection criteria and weighted scores to be used in the evaluation of applications are as follows:*

Additional Grant Support for Student/New Graduate Mobility

Additional Grant Support may be provided to participants with limited opportunities, in addition to the grant they deserve. Participants with limited opportunities are defined as individuals falling into the following subcategories:

1) Those subject to Law No. 2828 (Individuals with protection, care, or accommodation decisions under Law No. 2828 by the Ministry of Family and Social Services)

2) Students with protection, care, and accommodation decisions under the Child Protection Law No. 5395

3) Individuals who do not have other parental income but receive an orphan's allowance

4) Children of martyrs/veterans (Only for participants who are citizens of the Republic of Türkiye)

5) Individuals or their families receiving financial aid from municipalities, public institutions, and organizations (Ministries, Social Solidarity, and Assistance Foundations, General Directorate of Foundations, Red Crescent, AFAD, etc., during the Erasmus application, proving that they received financial support at the time of the application is sufficient.)

6) Disabled individuals (Individuals documented with a disability health board report indicating a minimum of 50% disability rate, as per the "Regulation on Disability Assessment for Adults" published in the Official Gazette on February 20, 2019)

7) Students receiving a monthly allowance under Law No. 2022, dated July 1, 1976, which covers disabled or needy students under the age of 65, and needy, weak, and orphaned Turkish citizens over the age of 65 (https://www.mevzuat.gov.tr/MevzuatMetin/1.5.2022.pdf)

8) Those whom themselves or their first-degree relatives receive aid from AFAD.

Qualified students falling into the above categories, upon request and documentation of their situations, may be eligible for Additional Grant Support in the following amounts based on the type of mobility:

Green Travel Support for Students/New Graduates

For students/new graduates who opt for green travel, in addition to the green travel support amount, individual support grants of up to 4 days may be provided. In order to receive green travel support, green travel must be used on departure and return and more than half of the entire journey must be made using green vehicles.

Erasmus+ Program Inclusion Support

The Erasmus+ Program encourages the participation of individuals with special needs. A person with special needs is a potential participant whose personal physical, mental, or health condition, in the absence of additional financial support, would hinder their participation in the project/mobility activity. Additional grants may be provided within the Erasmus+ project to support the effective involvement of disabled students in educational fields. *KA-171 Project Erasmus+ Study Mobility applications will be accepted between January 22nd to February 19th, 2024. Applications will not be considered after the specified dates."

*In academic matters, students should contact Erasmus Department Coordinators for all questions related to the Erasmus program.

*For technical issues related to applications, you can send an email to erasmus@gelisim.edu.tr. Students who submit incorrect or incomplete applications do not have the right to modify their applications. Therefore, it is important to be careful when applying.

* For students who are selected but decide not to participate in Erasmus mobility, a waiver notification period will be provided. If no waiver notification is made within this period, a deduction of -10 points will be applied to the student's subsequent Erasmus mobility applications.
