EXCHANGE OPPORTUNITIES AT IGU

 Erasmus+ Programme, offering
 students and staff a wide range
 of opportunities for exchange,
 collaboration, and international
 experience. Erasmus+ is an EU
 initiative that supports education,
 training, youth, and mobility
 projects worldwide.

ERASMUS+ PROGRAMS

- KA131: Exchange mobility between Erasmus+ programme countries.
- IGU holds more than 400+ agreements with over 160 European universities, covering 20+ countries including Germany, Italy, France, and Spain. In 2025 alone, IGU was granted a budget of €384,000 to support this project.
- **KA171:** Exchange mobility between Erasmus+ programme countries and non-programme countries.
- IGU currently partners with universities in the USA, Canada, Japan, South Korea, and more, with a total of 24 global partners.

GLOBAL EXCHANGE AND FREE MOVER OPTIONS

Beyond Erasmus+, IGU also maintains an active Global Exchange network, built on bilateral agreements that allow students to spend a semester abroad with tuition fees waived.

For those without an exchange agreement, IGU offers a Free Mover Program, where students may study for one or two semesters by paying a reduced semester fee. Applicants can choose their preferred field of study directly, without the limitations of existing agreements.

STUDENT VISITS

IGU frequently hosts short-term visit programs. Recently, the university welcomed over 30 students and staff from Universiti Teknologi Malaysia through the OUTREACH program.

HOW TO APPLY FOR EXCHANGE AT IGU

- KA131: Requires an exchange agreement between IGU and the home university. Students and staff should contact their international office to confirm an agreement.
 Once nominated, IGU's International Exchange and Cooperation Office (IECO) provides guidance throughout the application process. (Note: Staff training mobility does not require an agreement.)
- KA171: Requires a jointly prepared and approved project. Students and staff should contact their international office to initiate a partnership with IGU. If selected, nominees will be guided through the process by IECO.
- Global Exchange: Requires a bilateral agreement. The home university nominates students to IGU, and IECO assists with applications.
- Free Mover: Requires no agreement.
 Students apply directly to IECO by submitting:
- Application Form (provided by IECO)
- Learning Agreement
- Transcript of Records
- Passport Copy
- Portrait Photograph

TRANSPORTATION

Istanbul Gelisim University is conveniently located near the Beylikdüzü D-100 highway on the European side of Istanbul.

- Easy Access: Just a short walk from the Metrobus station.
- Campus Shuttles: Regular ring services connect our faculties to the Metrobus line.
- By Car: Students who prefer driving can benefit from the free on-campus parking.

ACCOMMODATION

At Istanbul Gelisim University, students can choose from various housing options tailored to their needs and budgets. IGU does not operate its own dormitories. However, the university collaborates with private student residences and partner dormitories located close to campus. For those who prefer comfort and flexibility, nearby hotels are available for both short and long stays. Platforms such as Trivago, Enuygun, and Hotels.com make it easy to compare options. Students seeking independence may rent apartments ranging from studios (1+0) to family-sized flats (3+1), furnished or unfurnished. Shared apartments with roommates are also popular and cost-effective.
