Erasmus+ Learning and Internship Opportunities Introduced to FAS Students

On Friday, March 27, 2026, a “Student Erasmus Mobility Information Meeting” was organized by FAS Erasmus Coordinator Assoc. Prof. Emel TOZLU ÖZTAY, with contributions from Research Assistants Dr. İlknur KÜLEKÇİ and Dr. Nuran AKDAĞ, in classroom E-209.

During the meeting, Mehmet Emir ÇETİNERK, Specialist from the University's International Exchange and Cooperation Coordination Office, gave a comprehensive presentation on the Erasmus+ Learning and Internship Mobility processes. The presentation covered the purpose of the Erasmus+ program, application requirements, evaluation criteria, and grant processes in detail. Information was provided on Erasmus+ learning mobility, internship mobility, application, and evaluation processes.

At the end of the meeting, students' questions regarding grant amounts, visa processes, accommodation options, and host institution selection were answered. Participants had the opportunity to receive detailed information, particularly about partner universities in Europe, internship opportunities, and post-mobility career advantages. Digital Transformation in Gastronomy Education: A First for Istanbul Gelisim University in the Erasmus+ VET Field!

Istanbul Gelisim University has achieved a significant success within the scope of Erasmus+, one of the most important programs of the European Union in the fields of education, youth, and innovation. The university has applied for a project for the first time as the coordinating institution in the KA220-VET program, a call for Cooperation Partnerships in Vocational Education and Training, focusing on Gastronomy and Culinary Arts education in the Faculty of Applied Sciences. This initiative offers an international cooperation model aimed at both supporting digitalization in gastronomy education and developing innovative solutions to infrastructure and cost problems encountered in vocational training processes.

Strong Collaboration with an International Consortium

The project team, led by Dr. Nevruz Berna Tatlısu, Head of the Gastronomy and Culinary Arts Department at Istanbul Gelisim University's Faculty of Applied Sciences, includes Istanbul Gelisim University Vice Rector Prof. Dr. Necmettin Maraşlı, IGU Erasmus Coordinator Dr. Alisa Usubova, and Head of the Software Engineering Department Assoc. Dr. Serkan Gönen is involved. The €250,000 project, which boasts a strong collaboration network not only on a national scale but also across Europe, includes institutions from Turkey, Italy, Spain, Germany, and Ireland in its consortium structure. Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University, a significant contributor from Turkey, participates as a partner, particularly in technology development and design, contributing to the development of virtual reality-based educational content.

An Innovative Approach to Structural Problems in Gastronomy Education

This project aims to develop an innovative solution model for the infrastructure, cost, and sustainability problems frequently encountered in gastronomy education. This model not only supports students' learning processes but also enables collaboration between educational institutions in different countries through a common digital education infrastructure. Furthermore, the modules to be developed aim to create a sustainable digital education resource for vocational training institutions, universities, and gastronomy training centers.

A Strategic Step for Istanbul Gelisim University

This project application marks the first time Istanbul Gelisim University's Faculty of Applied Sciences has applied to the KA220-VET program as a coordinating institution. In this context, IGU's role as a lead institution in international projects significantly contributes to strengthening its institutional capacity in research and education. This initiative, which combines gastronomy education with digital technologies, aims to lead the development of innovative approaches in vocational education while also contributing to the dissemination of sustainable and accessible education models. The project, notable for its international partnership structure, interdisciplinary approach, and technologically innovative content, increases Istanbul Gelisim University's visibility in the global academic network, demonstrates its commitment to developing sustainable vocational education models, and once again emphasizes that the university is an innovative, application-oriented, and internationalized higher education institution.

Finansal Oranların Kârlılık Üzerindeki Etkisinin Belirlenmesi: BIST 30 Endeksindeki İmalat Firmaları Üzerine Bir Araştırma

Öz

Bu çalışmada BIST 30 endeksinde yer alan 11 imalat firmasının kârlılıklarını etkileyen faktörlerin incelenmesi amaçlanmıştır. 2011-2023 yılları arasındaki çeyreklik verileri kullanılarak gerçekleştirilen çalışmada panel veri analizi yöntemi kullanılmıştır. Borsa İstanbul'da hisseleri alınıp satılan firmalar arasında piyasa değeri ve işlem hacimlerinin en yüksek olan firmalardan oluşan bu endekste yer alan imalat firmalarının kârlılık belirleyicileri üzerine yapılan araştırmaların beklenenden az olduğu gözlenmiştir. Literatürdeki bu boşluğu doldurmak adına yapılan bu çalışmada bağımlı değişkenler olarak aktif kârlılığı ve özsermaye kârlılığı belirlenmiştir. Çalışmadaki bağımsız değişkenler ise cari oran, kaldıraç oranı, maddi duran varlıkların aktif toplama oranı, aktif devir hızı, alacak devir hızı ve stok devir hızı olarak tespit edilmiştir. Araştırmanın sonuçlarına göre aktif devir hızı hem aktif kârlılığını hem de özsermaye kârlılığını olumlu yönde etkilerken, cari oran, kaldıraç oranı ve maddi duran varlıklardaki artış aktif kârlılığını, cari oran ve kaldıraç oranındaki artış özsermaye kârlılığını olumsuz yönde etkilemektedir.

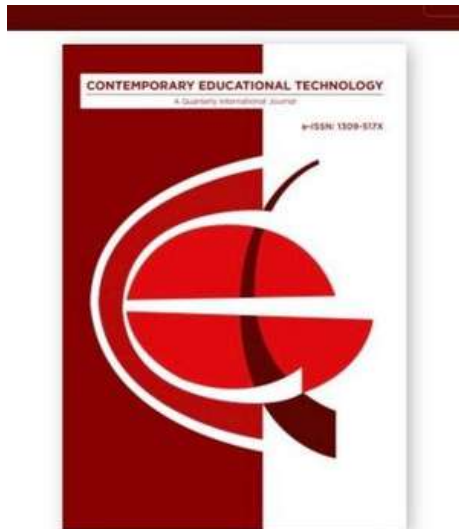

Primary school teachers' readiness for generation Alpha learning environments

ABSTRACT
This study examined primary school teachers' readiness for the learning environments of generation Alpha, who are greatly influenced by technological advancements and globalization. Although teachers need to be prepared for this new learning ecosystem, existing research offers limited insight into elementary school teacher's preparedness to address the technologically and pedagogically evolving learning needs of generation Alpha in a globalizing context. Using a qualitative case study approach, we conducted semi-structured interviews with 14 teachers in Turkey. The findings revealed four key dimensions of readiness for generation Alpha learning environments: (1) student development guidance, (2) teacher characteristics, (3) learning environment development, and (4) technology in education. Pre-experienced teachers showed advanced competence in promoting 21st century skills, adopting alternative assessment practices, and using learner-centered classroom management. They integrated diverse instructional techniques beyond content delivery and used diverse teaching strategies. Conversely, teachers without project experience showed limited technology integration and relied more on traditional classroom practices. Furthermore, digital citizenship awareness (online ethics and safety) was underdeveloped across all participants, highlighting an overlooked area in teacher preparedness for generation Alpha learners. This study contributes to the literature by identifying the key components of teacher readiness for generation Alpha and highlighting how project-based learning experience enhances pedagogical and technological competencies. The findings have implications for teacher training and educational policy reforms focused on equipping educators for 21st century learning environments.

ÖZ

Çalışmanın amacı, Borsa İstanbul'da Banka Endeksinde hisse senetleri alınıp satılan mevduat bankalarının finansal performanslarının değerlendirilmesidir. 2022-2024 yılları arasında bankaların yayınladığı mali tablolarından elde edilen 12 adet finansal oranlar ile yapılan incelemede ilk önce kriterlerin ağırlıklarının belirlenmesi için Entropi yöntemi kullanılmıştır. Belirlenen ağırlıklara göre çalışmada yer alan sekiz mevduat bankasının finansal performans sıralaması içinde TOPSIS (Technique for Order Preference by Similarity to Ideal Solution) yöntemi kullanılmıştır. Elde edilen bulgulara göre belirlenen finansal oranlar arasında “Alınan Krediler / Toplam Vartıklar” oranı en önemli kriter olarak belirlenirken en başarılı bankanın ise 2022 ve 2023 yıllarında Türkiye Vakıflar Bankası T.A.O. 2024 yılında ise Türkiye Halk Bankası A.Ş. olduğunu tespit edilmiştir.

Leadership Psychology

Leadership psychology is a multidimensional field of study that attempts to explain the processes by which individuals influence, direct, and achieve collective goals. In this sense, leadership is not only a behavioral practice but also a complex concept encompassing cognitive, emotional, and social processes. Therefore, understanding leadership psychology requires a systematic analysis of a broad framework, ranging from the leader's individual characteristics to group dynamics, from the source of power to power distance, from motivational processes to decision-making mechanisms.

First and foremost, personality traits, which form the basis of leadership psychology, emerge as determining factors in the leader's sphere of influence/power. In particular, traits such as self-confidence, vision, sense of responsibility, and determination enable the leader to navigate even in uncertain conditions/crisis situations. However, the mere existence of these traits is not sufficient; how these traits are functionalized within a social context is also critically important. At this point, empathy comes into play, enabling the leader to act not only based on their own individual thoughts but also considering the emotional and mental states of their followers/those within their sphere of influence.

Furthermore, a leader's effectiveness depends not only on their ability to direct their sphere of influence but also on their ability to activate the intrinsic motivations of individuals. In fact, a leader analyzes the needs, expectations, and value systems of their followers, offering a framework of meaning that integrates them around a common purpose and vision. Thus, motivation transcends external rewards and punishments, transforming into an internalized commitment.

Another concept directly related to motivation is emotional intelligence. Emotional intelligence encompasses a leader's ability to regulate their own emotions and to correctly understand, interpret, and control the emotional responses of others. This skill plays a crucial role in establishing trust, particularly in group interactions. Indeed, leaders with high emotional intelligence can manage conflict situations more effectively and create a sustainable collaborative environment among team members. This demonstrates that leadership psychology has not only an individual but also a relational dimension.

However, another indispensable component of leadership processes is decision-making mechanisms. Leaders often have to make decisions under pressure from uncertainty, risk, speed, and time. In this process, cognitive biases, intuitive judgments, and analytical thinking styles function together. Therefore, the psychology of leadership examines not only what constitutes the right decision, but also the mental processes that produce that decision. This understanding reveals that a leader is an actor with limited cognitive capacities, as well as being rational.

How all the psychological factors mentioned above are embodied in practice will essentially play a significant role in determining the leadership styles that will be exhibited in real life. For example, authoritarian leadership is characterized by an emphasis on control and hierarchy; while democratic leadership relies on participation and the generation of collective intelligence. Transformational leadership aims to transform the values of followers, guiding them towards higher goals. In contrast, the "laissez-faire" leadership style prioritizes individual autonomy with minimal intervention. Each leadership style produces different psychological dynamics, and the impact of these dynamics varies depending on the context.

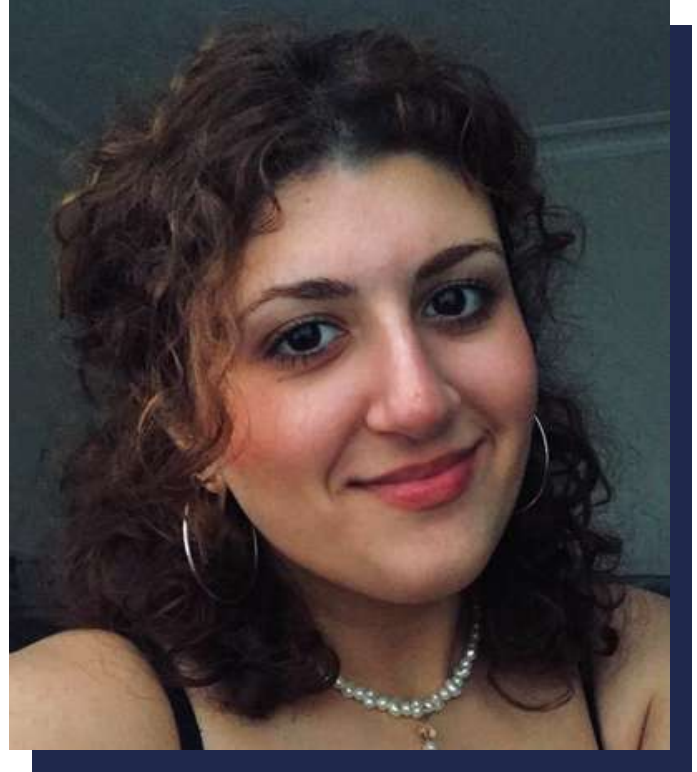
